MUMBAI: 20-YEAR-OLD FOUND KILLED IN BANDRA: GANG RIVALRY SUSPECTED

ON WEDNESDAY MORNING, A PASSERBY SAW THE DECEASED LYING IN A POOL OF BLOOD AT A PLAYGROUND IN BANDRA AND ALERTED POLICE, AN OFFICIAL FROM MUMBAI POLICE SAID ON WEDNESDAY

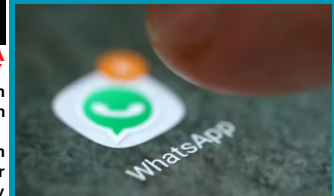
A 20 year-old man was found dead with his throat slit on a playground in suburban Bandra in Mumbai early Wednesday morning, the police said, reported the PTI. The deceased was identified as Ibrahim Shaikh. He was reportedly close to a man arrested in connection with another recent murder in the area and the attack on Shaikh is suspected to be part of a



feud between two gangs, however, "We are scanning the footage of CCTV cameras the police is probing the matter from all possible angles, said an official. On Wednesday morning, a passerby saw the deceased lying in a pool of blood and alerted police, according to the PTI. Shaikh was a resident of Patel Nagari in Bandra (West), Mumbai. He had been missing since Tuesday night but it was not clear how he ended up at the playground, the official said,

according to the PTI. "We are scanning the footage of CCTV cameras installed near his house and the murder spot to get some clues," the official told the PTI. Around three weeks ago, a 23 year-old man was allegedly murdered in Bandra over an old dispute, and a person was arrested in the case, the official said. Shaikh was apparently very close to the suspect arrested in this case, he said, adding that further probe was going on. In another incident, the police arrested a 23-year-old man from Uttar Pradesh in connection with

the shooting of a man in the western suburb of Kandivali, an official said on Tuesday. The victim identified as Manoj Chavan (32) was shot dead in Ganesh Nagar locality of Kandivali on Sunday morning, the official said. The accused was apprehended from Prayagraj railway station in Uttar Pradesh within 24 hours of the crime that took place on Monday, he said. The accused was allegedly having an affair with the victim's wife and wished to separate the couple. He had met the couple during their stay in Jaunpur, the official said. The accused had bought the weapon in Uttar Pradesh and had practised to use it before coming to Mumbai to allegedly carry out the murder, he said. The accused boarded a train to Uttar Pradesh after committing the crime.

Android users alert: This WhatsApp link can crash the app immediately, do not click on it

A new bug has been reported on the WhatsApp Android app which is triggered by a link. The bug crashes the app as soon as a user opens an individual or group chat which has a link related to WhatsApp's settings. In Short

- The bug is on a legitimate WhatsApp link which causes its Android app to crash.
- The bug is attached to a shortened link for WhatsApp's settings page.
- WhatsApp is reportedly fixing the bug.

IIT STUDENT'S SUICIDE: DARSHAN TOLD FAMILY MEMBERS ABOUT CASTE DISCRIMINATION, SAYS CHARGESHEET

In one of the conversations between Darshan and his sister, Jhanvi, he said that despite facing such hurdles, he would focus and complete his education at the institute, the chargesheet said. IN The chargesheet filed by the Mumbai police Special Investigation Team (SIT) in the abetment of suicide case of IIT-Bombay student Darshan Solanki, the statements of Darshan's family members, including his sister, state that Darshan had spoken about caste-based discrimination on campus.

Delhi Rohini court of the metropolitan magistrate on Thursday extended the police remand of Sahil, who is accused of stabbing a 16-year-old to death on Sunday evening at E-block in Shahbad Dairy area, for three days.



In Multiple statements, the family members stated that Darshan had told his sister over phone in December 2022 and during his visit to his home in Ahmedabad in January this year, that students at the institute would taunt him about reserved category students getting "free education". In one of the conversations between Darshan and his sister, Jhanvi, he said that despite facing such hurdles, he would focus and complete his education at the institute, the chargesheet said. The SIT has booked fellow student Arman Khatri under sections including abetment of suicide, criminal intimidation and Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities Act). The statements part of the chargesheet do not specifically mention who had made the discriminatory comments. Darshan's family members had sought for a probe into this while the SIT and initially the Powai police were investigating the case.

Deputy commissioner of police (DCP) (outer north) Ravi Kumar Singh said the investigator produced Sahil before a duty metropolitan magistrate's residence on Thursday morning with a request to extend his police remand for three more days for his further interrogation. "Due to security reasons, Sahil was produced in the early court instead of the regular court. Considering our request, the court extended his police custody till Saturday," said the DCP. Singh said that Sahil has so far given many contradictory

statements about the incidents and weapons used in the commission of crime, to mislead the police investigation. A fire incident was reported at approximately 00:18 hrs on June 1, 2023, in a building located on MIDC Central Road in SEEPZ, Andheri (E), Mumbai. The fire, categorized as Level 3, originated in the part basement of a multi-storey building and involved cardboard stocks and other stored materials. Prompt action was taken by the Mumbai Fire Brigade (MFB) and the situation is currently being brought under control. Firefighting Operations

level of severity. Rescue Operations During the incident, two security guards were stranded on the building's second floor due to heavy smoke. Firefighters successfully rescued them using angus' ladder, ensuring their safety. Agencies and Personnel Deployed Multiple agencies, including the MFB, were mobilized to the scene. A total of 12 fire engines, 8 jumbo tankers, 1 aerial water tower tender, 2 breathing apparatus vans, 1 quick response vehicle, 2 rescue vans, 1 control post, and a fitter were deployed to manage the situation. Additionally, one assistant engineer, one junior engineer, and 11 laborers were present at the site.

As of the latest update at 08:12 hrs, five small hose lines, including one from MIDC and four from MFB, were actively combating the flames. Twelve motor pumps were deployed to support the firefighting efforts, while firefighters wearing breathing apparatus sets worked on breaking the flooring to gain access to the basement area and extinguish the fire. POCSO, SEXUAL HARASSMENT NORMS VIOLATED FOR WFI CHIEF BRIJ BHUSHAN SHARAN SINGH

Police say report on wrestlers' allegations to be submitted to court New Delhi, May 31.



More than a month after the Delhi Police lodged an FIR against Wrestling Federation of India (WFI) president Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh on women wrestlers' complaint of sexual harassment, the grapplers are still agitating to press for his arrest.

allegations raises questions over the manner in which the probe is being carried out. Generally, under the POCSO Act, the FIR and arrest happen immediately as there is a presumption of guilt," said Supreme Court senior advocate Vikas Singh.

Slamming the government over the alleged inaction in arresting the WFI president, Rajya Sabha MP and senior advocate Kapil Sibal on Wednesday wondered if the POCSO Act and the immediate arrest under it applied to all accused other than Brij Bhushan because he belonged to the BJP.

Police sources, however, said Brij Bhushan was not immediately arrested as they first needed to verify and confirm the age of the "minor" wrestler, who happened to be one of the complainants. The investigators have already taken into possession some documents related to the date of birth of the "minor" wrestler, they added.

Legal experts are of the view that in POCSO cases, the norm is that the accused is arrested for questioning. "The fact that the FIR was registered against Brij Bhushan on April 28 only after the women wrestlers went to the Supreme Court and that he has not been arrested despite such serious

RAJASTHAN POLITICS: CONGRESS CHIEF MALLIKARJUN KHARGE TO MEET ASHOK GEHLOT, SACHIN PILOT TODAY



The Mumbai police have arrested a 42-year-old man for allegedly raping his minor daughter for the last three years. The accused, who is a carpenter by profession, would rape the daughter, who studies in Class 8, whenever her mother was out at work. According to the police, the man had threatened his daughter, 13, that if she would tell anyone about the rape, he would defame her by telling false things about her to her mother. He had been raping the girl for the past three years by threatening her, added the police.

Rajasthan Chief Minister Ashok Gehlot and his bete noire Sachin Pilot will meet Congress President Mallikarjun Kharge separately in the national capital Delhi on Monday as the tussle between the two has escalated to a new level.

On Tuesday, the girl managed to tell her mother about the sexual assault after which the woman approached the police. The police then arrested the accused from his house early Wednesday.

45-year-old Pilot has given an ultimatum to Rajasthan Congress in-charge Sukhjinder Singh Randhawa if three demands he made from the state government were not met by the end of this month, he would launch a state-wide agitation. Pilot has asked for a high-level inquiry into the alleged scams that took place during the tenure of the former Chief Minister Vasundhara Raje government, as one of his demands.

The accused has been arrested under relevant sections of the Indian Penal Code (IPC) and the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (Pocso) Act.

However, Randhawa on Thursday said dissident Congress leader Pilot has not given any "ultimatum" for statewide protest to him.

The police will record the girl's statement before a magistrate to build a strong case against the accused, an officer said.

Randhawa also said that a party is like a house where people have different opinions and there are fights also. If there is any fighting within the party then it will be controlled, he said.

The top brass of Congress will meet the two-party veterans as elections are due in Rajasthan this year.

A Congress senior leader said that Kharge was successful in bringing Siddaramaiah and D K Shivakumar together in Karnataka and the party now wants to try the same formula in Rajasthan.

Last month Pilot observed a fast demanding action from his own government over cases of alleged corruption during the BJP's term.

VIDEO SHOWS FUNGUS-LADEN LASSI IN TETRA PACKS, AMUL TWEETS IN RESPONSE

Recently, a video has been circulating on social media showing a man buying packets of Amul tetra pack lassi, opening them with a knife, and claiming that they contained green, filthy liquid which he said was fungus. Amul quickly responded to the video, posting a clarification on their Twitter page that the video was fake. As of now, no other video contradicting this claim has been found.



Amul has clarified its stance that the video in question was fake and was only made to scare people away from buying Amul products, be it lassi, dahi, or any other milk product. The company also confirmed that the video falsely claimed that there was fungus contamination inside the box since the tetra packs are always sealed and airtight.

EX-MANAGER BOOKED FOR SIPHONING OFF RS 4.41 CRORE FROM MUMBAI FIRM'S BANK ACCOUNT

The crime came to light after Ashok Jadhav resigned and a new manager took over his position.

An assistant general manager who looked after a Mumbai private firm's finances has been booked for allegedly siphoning off Rs 4.41 crore from its bank account over the course of three years.

Police said the accused, Ashok Jadhav, was booked on Tuesday under Indian Penal Code sections related to criminal breach of trust, cheating and forgery. Jadhav, who worked with the company for 16 years, allegedly transferred the money to another account after forging the signature of the company's director. "He would show them as expenses of the company and divert the money to a bank account that he had opened in the name of a company named Excel Exim," said a police officer.

Police said the crime took place between April 2019 and July 2021 but came to light only in 2022 after Jadhav resigned from the company and a new manager took over his position.

"The newly appointed individual saw some discrepancies in the company's bank account, after which he informed his seniors," said the officer. This was followed by an inquiry and an audit, which revealed the swindle.

MAN ARRESTED FOR SETTING 20-YEAR-OLD WOMAN ON FIRE IN MUMBAI'S DHARAVI



MUMBAI: Angry that the woman who used to stay with him in live-in relationship was not giving importance to him, a man allegedly set her 20-year-old adopted daughter on fire in Mumbai's Dharavi on Tuesday.

Mohini Ramjit, who suffered 70% burns, is struggling for life in an ICU at Sion hospital.

Dharavi police on Wednesday arrested Nandkishore Patel, the accused, under IPC section 307 (attempt to murder).

On Tuesday morning, Nandkishore took up a fight with Mohini who was sitting outside her house at Rajiv Gandhi Nagar. He poured kerosene on her and set her on fire.

Mohini's mother Kajal and other people took her to Sion hospital and video recorded her statement.

"Nandkishore felt that Kajal and Mohini were not giving importance to him though he was taking care of them and hence he got angry and decided to teach them a lesson," said Vijay Khandalgaonkar, senior inspector of Dharavi police.
