

BREAKING NEWS WOMAN SCAMMED FOR MONEY ON TINDER FINDS JUSTICE THROUGH DEBO RESCUE FOUNDATION

A short altercation that turned into a gory road rage incident led to the death of Amazon manager Harpreet Gill in Delhi. The prime accused in the murder case, Mohammad Sameer aka Maya, is a teenager who is also the master mind of a gangster group, named 'Maya'. His Instagram account is mushrooming with videos and reels featuring guns and filmy dialogues. A look at his social media account reveals how massively he romanticise crime. Four more murder charges against him reflects his fascination with the world of crime. His Instagram profile reads, "Naam badnaam, pata Kabristan, umra jeene ki, shauk marne ka", which means 'I am infamous, the graveyard is my address. My age is to live, but I wish to die,' reports NDTV. According to the report, his Instagram profile is filled with photographs



posing with guns, and even prison. One of his reels, captioned as 'jail', showcases many youngsters standing behind bars. In another reel, Maya is seen posing with firing guns. In another reel captioned "Maya is seen posing with firing guns. In another reel captioned 'Maya Gang', a group of teenagers can be seen. Definitely, the teenagers are the members of a gang that became infamous in Delhi for its crimes. According to police, 'Maya gang has terrorised Northeast Delhi' with its crimes, reported NDTV. The teenage criminal leads a group, that calls itself as "Maya Gang". Maya and his 18-year-old associate Bilal Gani have been arrested in

connection with the murder of Amazon manager. The police have arrested him and are searching for other accused. Maya was also charged in four other murder cases as a juvenile. His 18-year-old associate, Gani, was also involved in a murder case and a robber case in 2022. He was sent to a Children's Observation home and then he managed to come out, later he started working at a welding shop. How many people have been arrested in Amazon Manager murder case? Till now four people have been arrested in the case including Maya and Bilal. The police arrested two more people associated with the murder on Thursday. The arrested accused are identified as Sohail and Jubair and they were apprehended near Burari in New Delhi, when they were trying to escape to Punjab. Another teenager, Adnan, is still absconding.

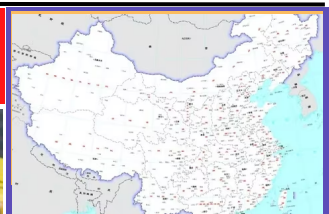
DELHI: MAN FOUND DEAD WITH SLIT THROAT IN JAMIA NAGAR, POLICE PROBE UNDERWAY

Delhi crime news: Shortly after the police received the information of a dead man in the house located on the second floor of Batla House in Jamia Nagar, crime teams from the Forensic Science Laboratory and local police reached the spot. Delhi crime news: A 27-year-old man was found dead with deep injuries on his neck in a house in southeast Delhi's Jamia Nagar on Wednesday (August 30), police said. After India, three other nations reject China's 'baseless' new map

China released the map of its famous U-shaped line covering about 90% of South China Sea, a source of many disputes in one of world's most contested waterways. The Philippines, Malaysia, Taiwan and Vietnam have rejected as baseless a map released by China that denotes its claims to sovereignty including in the South China Sea and which Beijing said on Thursday should be viewed rationally and objectively. China's U-shaped line loops as far as 1,500 km (932 miles) south of its Hainan island and cuts into the exclusive economic zones (EEZs) of Vietnam, the Philippines, Malaysia, Brunei and Indonesia. (Twitter) China released the map on Monday of its famous U-shaped line covering about 90% of the South China Sea, a source of many of the disputes in one of the world's most contested waterways, where more than \$3 trillion of trade passes each year. The Philippines called on China on Thursday "to act responsibly and abide by its obligations" under international law and a 2016 arbitral ruling that had declared the line had no legal grounds. Malaysia said it had filed a diplomatic protest over the map.

CENTRE FORMS PANEL ON 'ONE NATION, ONE ELECTION', EX PRESIDENT TO HEAD IT

The committee will be headed by former President Ram Nath Kovind. New Delhi: Whether India can have a "one nation, one election" system, or simultaneous national and state elections countrywide, will be examined by a new committee headed by former President Ram Nath Kovind, sources said today, signalling a big step forward on the long-debated proposal discussed by multiple panels. The move comes a day after the Centre announced a special session of the parliament from September 18 to 22, without revealing the agenda. The surprise announcement was followed by intense speculation that a bill on 'one nation, one election' would be tabled during the session, but no one from the government has confirmed this. 'One nation, one election' refers to holding the Lok Sabha and state assembly polls simultaneously across the country, like it was in the first few rounds of elections in India. The BJP and Prime Minister Narendra Modi have spoken on the issue on several occasions, and it was also a part of the party's manifesto for the 2014 Lok Sabha polls.

'SON'S PISTOL USED BUT HE WASN'T THERE': UNION MINISTER KAUSHAL KISHORE REACTS AFTER MAN KILLED AT HIS LUCKNOW HOME

Body of a youth has been found under suspicious circumstances at the house of Union minister Kaushal Kishore. The deceased, identified as Vinay Srivastava, was allegedly shot with a pistol that reportedly belongs to minister's son, Vikas Kishore.

The incident took place at 4.15am on Friday at Kaushal Kishore's Begaria village residence under Thakurganj police station area. Police have taken three people into custody and started investigation after Srivastava's family filed a complaint alleging murder.

An official said that police reached the spot after getting the information. Heavy police force is present at the site of the incident along with Western DCP Rahul Raj and ADCP Chiranjeevi Nath Sinha. Police have recovered the pistol from the incident site. Meanwhile, the body has been sent for postmortem. Reacting to the development later in the day, BJP MP Kaushal Kishore said that his son was not present when the firing took place.

Unhappy with her decision, Prakash Chinchwad resorted to harassment, leading Kamakshi to lodge a formal complaint at the Mapusa police station.

A 30-year-old woman named Kamakshi from Porvorim has been allegedly murdered by an ex-lover and her body dumped at Amboli Ghat after she refused to continue the relationship with him. The accused in question is Prakash Chinchwad, 22, who runs a garage in Porvorim.

Trouble in the relationship emerged when Kamakshi decided to end the love affair due to escalating arguments. Prakash, evidently unhappy with her decision, resorted to harassment, leading Kamakshi to lodge a formal complaint at the Mapusa police station.

The police summoned Prakash and explained the consequences of his actions, securing a written guarantee from him. Following this intervention, Prakash was released from custody. However, the situation took a turn when Kamakshi vanished without a trace shortly thereafter.

The family immediately informed the police, and filed a complaint on August 30. After two days of investigation, her mobile location was found at Amboli Ghat in Sindhudurg district. So the police will take the suspected boyfriend to Amboli on Friday evening to search for her.

RUSSIA'S LUNA-25 CRASH LEFT 10-METER WIDE CRATER ON MOON'S SURFACE: NASA SHARES IMAGES

Russia's failed bid to land on the South Pole of the moon through its Luna-25 spacecraft has left a 10-meter-wide crater on the lunar surface, as per US Space Agency NASA. Luna-25 crashed on the moon's surface after entering an unintended orbit and spinning out of control. NASA made these revelations through its Lunar Reconnaissance Orbiter (LRO) spacecraft which shared images of a new crater on the surface of the moon.

LRO's most recent "before" image of the area was captured in June 2022 thus, the crater formed sometime after that date. Since this new crater is close to the Luna-25 estimated impact point, the LRO team concludes it is likely to be from that mission, rather than a natural impactor. NASA informed that the new crater is about 10 meters in diameter and is located at 57.865 degrees south latitude and 61.360 degrees east longitude at an elevation of about minus 360 meters.
