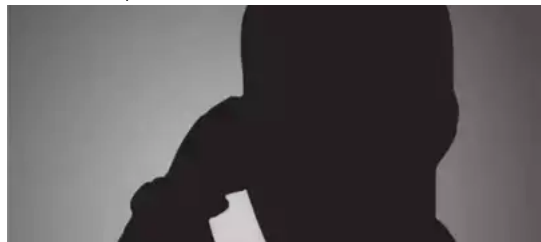

MUMBAI POLICE RECEIVE YET ANOTHER HOAX BOMB CALL

In yet another incident, a man made a hoax terror call to the Mumbai Police on Friday claiming that bombs would go off at several places in south Mumbai. The caller, Ashwin Mhaiskar (29), was arrested from Dahanu within nine hours of him making the call.

With this, eight hoax terror calls have been received by the Mumbai Police till now this year.

An officer said that the south region control room received the call on Friday at 1.35 pm. The caller, who did not identify himself, claimed that a day earlier, some explosives had landed on the Mumbai port to be used to carry out blasts at J J hospital, Bhendi Bazaar and Null Bazaar in south Mumbai. When the police control room officer asked for his details, the caller hung up. As per protocol, the police carried out searches at the spots mentioned by the caller but no explosives were found. Following this, the staff of the police control room, led by Senior Inspector Anup Dange, found that the call was made from the cellphone number registered in the name of Nagpur resident Ashwin Mhaiskar. The police traced him to Dahanu, from where the call was made.

MUMBAI: A Gujarat resident was arrested by Kandivli police recently for stalking and defaming an ex-model from Mumbai with whom he used to have a relationship. The victim is married and has a son.

Police said the relationship between the accused and victim had ended on a sour note. The accused created a Facebook page under a fictitious name but used the victim's photo as the display image.

He wrote obscene messages on the page and mentioned two mobile numbers. He circulated the post online till it went viral. Unknown people started calling up the numbers.

EXPLAINED: WHAT'S DRIVING THE STRONG RALLY IN ADANI GROUP STOCKS

ADANI GROUP STOCKS HAVE BEEN RISING SINCE TUESDAY, WITH ITS FLAGSHIP COMPANY ADANI ENTERPRISES LEADING FROM THE FRONT. HERE'S WHAT'S DRIVING THE RALLY IN ADANI GROUP STOCKS.

Shares of Adani Enterprises have recovered nearly 30 per cent in just two trading sessions, substantially reversing losses that it has witnessed, following a report released by US short seller Hindenburg Research.

On Tuesday, Adani Enterprises shares rose as much as 15 per cent during intraday trade. Other Adani Group companies also rose sharply, leading to a substantial improvement in the group's total market capitalisation. Adani Group's market capitalisation has now gone above Rs 7.50 lakh crore. It may be noted that Adani Group stocks have been rising since Tuesday, with its flagship company Adani Enterprises leading from the front. Adani Ports was trading at around 1.70 per cent higher at around 2:25 pm, while Adani Total Gas was trading above 3 per cent. Adani Wilmar, Adani Power, Adani Transmission and Adani Green Energy were locked in their upper circuit of 5 per cent. Adani-owned Ambuja Cement and ACC were also trading 2-4 per cent higher, while NDTV was also locked in its 5 per cent upper circuit. Adani Group's fixed-income roadshow in Singapore and Hong Kong to boost investor confidence seems to have played a crucial role in boosting the stocks of listed companies. The fresh rally comes after another Economic Times report that said Adani Group has received a firm commitment for a \$800 million debt facility, which will be used to refinance Adani Green Energy's \$750 million 4.375 per cent bond due in September 2024.

"GLOBAL GOVERNANCE HAS FAILED": PM MODI AT G20 FOREIGN MINISTERS' MEET

Multilateral institutions had failed to meet the world's most pressing challenges, Prime Minister Modi said.

New Delhi: Prime Minister Narendra Modi today said, "global governance has failed" and multilateralism is in crisis as he opened a Foreign Ministers' meeting of the G20 where Russia's war in Ukraine has taken centre-stage. Multilateral institutions had failed to meet the world's most pressing challenges, PM Modi said in a recorded message before the first session of the Foreign Ministers' meet.

"We must all acknowledge that multilateralism is in crisis today...The experience of the last few years - financial crisis, climate change, pandemic, terrorism and wars - clearly shows that global governance has failed," he said. "After years of progress, we are at risk today of moving back on the sustainable development goals. Many developing countries are struggling with unsustainable debts while trying to ensure food and energy security.

They are also most affected by global warming caused by richer countries. This is why India's G20 presidency has tried to give a voice to the global south," the Prime Minister said. PM Modi urged world leaders to find "common ground" on divisive issues.

"We are meeting at a time of deep global divisions. We have a responsibility to those not in this room," said the PM.

"We should not allow issues that we cannot resolve together to come in the way of those we can."

'IF MANISH SISODIA JOINS BJP TODAY...' KEJRIWAL'S JIBE ON AAP LEADERS' ARREST

Manish Sisodia, Satyendar Jain news: Delhi's former deputy chief minister and the capital's health minister both quit Tuesday night after they were jailed on corruption allegations.

Delhi chief minister Arvind Kejriwal hit out at the Bharatiya Janata Party Wednesday evening amid the row over the arrest (and resignation) of Manish Sisodia over alleged irregularities in the liquor excise policy case, asking 'if Manish Sisodia joins BJP today, won't he be released tomorrow?' In a statement after meeting Aam Aadmi Party MLAs and councillors, Kejriwal continued: "All cases will be withdrawn. If Satyendar Jain joins BJP today, all cases will be withdrawn and he'd be released from jail tomorrow. Issue isn't corruption but to stop work and send CBI-ED after opposition." Kejriwal also launched a staunch defence of Sisodia and Jain, who led the Delhi government's education and health ministries among several others. "Two people who brought laurels to India have been jailed by PM Modi. Excise policy was an excuse... there was no scam. Sisodia was arrested as he did good work in education... Jain was arrested as he did good work in health." This was the chief minister's first public statement since the tumultuous events of Tuesday evening, when the Supreme Court rejected Sisodia's bail plea. Sisodia - arrested Sunday by the CBI - and Jain - in jail for nine months



NEW LEAK SUGGESTS WINDOWS 12 IS ON THE WAY, POTENTIALLY IN 2024

Another piece of evidence suggests that Windows 12 is in the works.


Window 12 could launch as soon as next year, based on previous reports. Recent leaks give more credence to suggestions that a new major release of Windows is on the way. A since-deleted tweet by @leaf_hobby, who is known for Intel hardware leaks, stated that Windows 12 is on the supported OS list for Intel's Meteor Lake-S desktop chipsets.

It's important to place today's reports within context. They refer to details from a leak about a chipset that mentions an operating system that has not publicly been confirmed to exist by Microsoft. With so many moving pieces and reports, it's important to take things with a grain of salt.

That's everything I know" The chipset in question, the Z980, is expected to be paired with Intel Meteor Lake and Arrow Lake CPUs. Meteor Lake processors may come in the second quarter of 2024, based on a report by BenchLife.

Our Senior Editor Zac Bowden reported that Microsoft moved to a new Windows development cycle back in July 2022. Major releases of Windows will come out every three years and feature drops will ship intermittently. One such feature drop shipped this week, adding an improved tablet mode, several taskbar options, and Phone Link support for iOS (in preview). Windows 11 first shipped in October 2021. Going off the release cadence that Microsoft reportedly has, Windows 12 should arrive sometime in 2024. Plans are always subject to change, but we have at least an educated guess on when to expect the next major release of Windows.

ON ELECTION COMMISSION APPOINTMENTS, SUPREME COURT'S MASSIVE ORDER



The Supreme Court today said Election Commissioners will be appointed by a panel including the Prime Minister, the Leader of the Opposition and the Chief Justice of India, in a landmark verdict aimed at "maintaining the purity of elections". The Chief Election Commissioners and two election commissioners, who oversee polls across the country, will be appointed on the advice of a committee that will give the opposition and the judiciary a say. "Elections should undoubtedly be fair and the buck stops with the Election Commission of India to ensure its purity is maintained," said a five-judge Constitution bench led by Justice KM Joseph. "In a democracy, the purity of elections must be maintained or else it would lead to disastrous consequences," said the unanimous verdict. The far-reaching verdict also means the Election Commission will have an independent secretariat, rule-making powers, an independent budget, and equal protection from impeachment. The Election Commission can now draw funds directly from the consolidated fund of India, instead of having to go to the Prime Minister's Office and the Law Ministry for funds and approvals.
