MUMBAI CRIME: SENIOR CITIZEN IN ANDHERI LOSES RS 24,000 TO CYBER FRAUD

THE VICTIM FILLED IN THE ENTIRE DETAILS AND ALSO TRANSFERS RS 2 FROM HER BANK ACCOUNT, AND RECEIVED A MESSAGE OF THE SAME ABOUT THE REGISTRATION

A 60-year-old woman who retired and searching the contact number of a consumer from a nationalized bank was duped Rs 24,000 by an unknown cyber fraudulent. The senior citizen was searching for the contact number of the consumer customer forum on Google to file a complaint against the private aggregator cab driver who charged a couple of hundred more than the actual fare. According to the police sources, the complaint is residing in the Vijay Nagar area of Andheri East along with her 40-year-old son, 37-year-old daughter-in-law and 8-year-old grandson. She was working as an officer in one of the nationalized bank, and got retired in the year 2018.

But on April 20, she was shocked after receiving a message of Rs 20,400.54 debited from her saving account. The victim immediately called the police control by dialling 100 and informed, the officer talking on the other side asked her to inform by dialling 103 numbers. The police asked her to approach the bank and block the account as soon as possible. "She immediately rushed to the bank and informed the bank officer about the fraud then the bank officials told her to report the crime to the local Andheri police station," the officer added. "On the complaint of the victim, we registered the case on April 29, under various sections of IPC including the IT Act have also written to the bank and asked them to provide the account details in which the amount was transferred," said another officer. "Further investigation is underway," he added.

New GST rules in effect from today for businesses with turnover of over ₹100 crore.

Businesses whose turnover is ₹100 crore and above will now have to upload their electronic invoices on Invoice Registration Portal (IRP) within 7 days of the issue of such invoice with effect from May 1, GST Network has said. Currently, businesses upload such invoices on Invoice Registration Portal (IRP) on the current date, irrespective of the date of issue of such invoice. While issuing an advisory to the taxpayers, GST Network (GSTN) said the government has decided to impose a time limit on reporting old invoices on the e-invoice IRP portals for taxpayers with aggregate annual turnover greater than or equal to ₹100 crore. As per GSTN, "To ensure timely compliance, taxpayers in this category will not be allowed to report invoices older than 7 days on the date of reporting." NIGERIAN NATIONAL HELD WITH DRUGS WORTH RS 11.6 LAKH IN NAVI MUMBAI

Police have arrested a Nigerian national and seized the banned drug methaqualone worth Rs 11.6 lakh from his possession in Navi Mumbai township, an official said on Monday. They nabbed the accused, identified as Boniface Emenike (45), hailing from Awkuzu in Nigeria, and seized 116 grams of methaqualone from his possession, the police said in a release.



During questioning, it came to light that the accused did not possess any visa or passport for travel and stay in India, it said. The accused was booked under relevant provisions of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances (NDPS) Act, the Passports Act and the Foreigners Act, the release said. The police were trying to find out from where the accused procured the contraband and to whom he planned to sell it.

9-YEAR-OLD GIRL SEXUALLY ASSAULTED IN DELHI, MINOR BOY DETAINED: COPS

The police said the girl was playing in the street on Saturday when the accused took her to a vacant house near a park close to his residence and allegedly sexually assaulted her. The victim returned home and narrated the incident to her parents who took her to a hospital

A case under Section 376 (rape) of the Indian Penal Code and relevant provisions of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act was registered and the juvenile accused apprehended, the senior officer said.

DIVORCE CAN BE GRANTED ON 'GROUNDS OF IRRETRIEVABLE BREAKDOWN': SUPREME COURT

The six-month waiting period has also been "dispensed away with" before granting of divorce by mutual consent. The Supreme Court on May 1 held that it can use its extraordinary powers to do "complete justice" under Article 142 of the Constitution and dissolve a marriage on the ground of an 'irretrievable breakdown' of the union. Usually, the apex court has to refer the parties back to the family courts concerned for a long wait for a formal decree of separation and divorce. A Constitution Bench led by Justice Sanjay Kishan Kaul also did away with the six-month mandatory waiting period for couples seeking divorce by mutual consent. Senior advocate Indira Jaising, one of the lawyers in the case, said marriage laws required sweeping reforms. While reserving its order, the court had said social changes take time to accomplish, and it was easier to bring a law than persuade society to change with the times. Pronouncing the operative portion from the unanimous judgment he authored for the five-judge Bench, Justice Sanjiv Khanna said "it is possible for the Supreme Court to dissolve a marriage on the ground of irretrievable breakdown of marriage" without contravening with the general and specific principles of public policy". Justice Khanna said the six-month waiting period has also been "dispensed away with" before granting divorce by mutual consent. Article 142 of the Constitution deals with the enforcement of decrees and orders of the apex court to do "complete justice" in any matter pending before it.

MAN POSING AS GUJARAT CMO OFFICIAL RAPES MODEL ON PRETEXT OF GIVING HER JOB

Police have arrested a man for allegedly posing as an official of the Gujarat chief minister's office (CMO) and president of Gujarat International Finance Tec-City (GIFT City), and on the charge of raping a model on the promise of giving her a job, an official said here on Sunday. The accused conman, Viraj Patel, was arrested on Saturday, he said, adding that his real identity came to light after he was brought to a police station in Vadodara following his quarrel with someone. The man was brought to the police station on Friday night along with the model accompanying him after he entered into a quarrel with someone at a multiplex. The accused initially told the police that he was a CMO official who had come to watch a movie with the woman. He also claimed that he was the president of the GIFT City," Assistant Commissioner of Police AV Katkad said. When the police checked his identity, it was found that he used a different surname on his PAN card, while there was no surname mentioned on his Aadhar card. During his interrogation, Patel revealed that he was neither working in the CMO nor was he the president of GIFT City, he said. After his real identity came to light, the model from Mumbai accompanying him claimed that he raped her on the pretext of giving her a job as the brand ambassador of GIFT City and promised to marry her, Katkad said. In the preliminary investigation, it was found that he is a resident of Gandhinagar, the ACP said, adding that further probe into the case was handed over to the city crime branch. The accused was booked under Indian Penal Code sections 170 (pretending to hold any particular office as a public servant), 417 (cheating), 467 (forgery), and 376 (rape), the police officer said.

RS 67 LAKH EXTORTED FROM GOLF GREEN RESIDENT AFTER THREATS WITH INTIMATE PICTURES

A 59-year-old resident of Golf Green was allegedly blackmailed and forced into paying Rs 67 lakh to fraudsters who threatened to upload his intimate photographs and videos on social media, police said. The complainant, a senior executive of a private company, reported the matter to police in October last year when the blackmailing calls did not stop even after he had paid the money demanded of him, said an officer of the cyber crime cell of Kolkata police. "According to the complaint, the fraudsters had fraudulently captured the complainant's photographs and videos and started to blackmail him with them." The man, the police said, was told that his videos and photographs would be used to create his fake social media profile to malign him unless he paid up. The police said they found during the investigation that the Rs 67 lakh that the complainant had transferred over a period of a few days was subsequently transferred through 13 bank accounts, two of which were traced to a bank in Bareilly in Uttar Pradesh. "Most of the accounts through which the money was transferred were mule accounts, meaning they had been opened with fake identity papers. It is difficult to trace the real owners of such accounts. Fraudsters withdraw money using ATMs from anywhere in the country," said an investigator. But the two Bareilly accounts were used by the genuine owner, the investigator said. Based on the findings of the investigation, a team of officers from the cyber crime police station of Kolkata police conducted a raid in Bareilly on April 24 and arrested Amit Kumar, 36, for his alleged involvement in the case.

INDIA BLOCKS 14 MOBILE MESSENGER APPS USED BY TERRORISTS TO RECEIVE TEXTS FROM PAKISTAN

The Central Government has blocked 14 mobile messenger apps over security concerns. As reported by news agency ANI, it is reported that terrorists used these mobile messenger apps to spread the message and receive messages from Pakistan. As reported by News18, these messenger apps were being used by terror groups in Jammu and Kashmir. The names of the blocked mobile messenger apps are not listed. However, a source told News18 that apps including Cryptviser, Enigma Safeswiss, Wickrme, Mediafire, Briar, BChat, Nandbox, Conion, IMO, Element, Second line, Zangi, Threema among others have been blocked by the Centre. It was found that these apps were being used by terrorists in Kashmir to communicate with their supporters and on-ground workers (OGW), top sources told the daily.

Schroder finished his night with two points, four rebounds, five assists and two steals in 23 minutes of playing time. Despite finishing as the seventh seed in the Western Conference, the Lakers have one of the most talented rosters in the league and a legitimate chance to win the 2023 NBA Championship. With the victory, they are now 26-18 in the 44 games they have hosted on their home floor in Los Angeles (3-0 in the playoffs).
