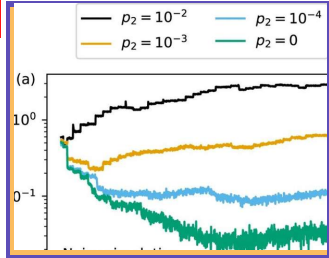

Scientists take an important step toward using quantum computers to advance materials science

A team of scientists from the U.S. Department of Energy's Ames National Laboratory demonstrated a way to advance the role of quantum computing in materials research with an adaptive algorithm for simulating materials. Quantum computers have potential capabilities far beyond today's computers, and using an adaptive algorithm allows them to produce solutions quickly and accurately. These unique capabilities allow quantum computers to make calculations beyond what is currently possible with classical computers. A team of scientists at Ames Lab are working to harness the power of quantum computers to make materials research easier and more efficient. A primary research focus at Ames Lab is rare earth materials. These materials are used in a variety of technology.

Uttar Pradesh Crime News: A father in Bijnor district killed his son over an alleged incestuous relationship with his mother.

Bijnor: In a shocking incident, **Uttar Pradesh Police** arrested a 45-year-old man for killing his son over the latter's alleged incestual relationship with his mother. The shocking incident was reported from Bijnor district in UP. The matter came to light when the wife of the accused filed a complaint against her husband alleging that the latter killed her son. The police said that 22-year-old Mohd Gulfam was killed by his father Shahid Ahmed on March 5. Acting on the complaint of the woman, the police registered a case under Section 302 of the Indian Penal Code (IPC). "We registered a case against the accused under section 302 of IPC based on the complaint filed by his relationship between the mother and son wife, but he had been on the run ever since. However, he has finally been arrested, the Bijnor SP informed that during interrogation Shaheed confessed to murdering his son. Shahid claimed that he h

had asked his wife to stay with him, but she chose to live with their son, which led to fights between them during the interrogations. He reportedly confessed to the case against the accused under section 302 crime and said that he had objected to the duo, which had led to quarrels. HANG ME, BUT DON'T STOP WRESTLING: BRIJ BHUSHAN SINGH AMID PROTESTS, POLICE CASE

Wrestling Federation of India chief Brij Bhushan Singh, who faces sexual harassment charges, on Monday said stopping wrestling due to protests is detrimental to the sport.

Wrestling Federation of India president Brij Bhushan Singh, who faces sexual harassment charges, on Monday, pointed out that the sport has come to a standstill in the last four months due to protests and said he is ready to be hanged but wrestling activity should not stop. Several top wrestlers, including Vinesh Phogat, Sakshi Malik and Bajrang Punia, have been protesting at Delhi's Jantar Mantar seeking Brij Bhushan Singh's arrest and ouster from the federation. All wrestling activities, including championships and camps, were stopped after several wrestlers came out in protest accusing the WFI chief of sexually exploiting women grapplers. Brij Bhushan Singh, who faces two FIRs, said stopping wrestling activity is detrimental to the cadet and junior wrestlers. "Don't play with the future of children. Allow the cadet



nationals to take place. Whosoever organises it, be it the government or the WFI, don't stop the wrestling activity," the federation chief told reporters. Earlier, Brij Bhushan Singh, who has remained defiant about not quitting his post, said he was ready to resign if it would make the protesters go back home and sleep peacefully. But the protesting wrestlers remain adamant that the stir will continue till action is taken against Singh. Top wrestlers first came out in protest against the WFI chief in January.

FAKE NIKAHNAMA CASE: PUNE POLICE ARREST ACCUSED AFTER 9-MONTH SEARCH



Chandannagar, May 2, 2023: The Pune police have arrested Sheikh Khalil Jaleem from Buldhana district, Maharashtra, for forging a Nikahnama (marriage certificate) and using it to defame a woman. The accused had been on the run for the past nine months before the Chandannagar police apprehended him. Last July, the police received a complaint from a 24-year-old woman regarding the forged Nikahnama, which led to an investigation into the matter. The accused claimed that the fake document was genuine and used it to spread negative propaganda against her in the Muslim community. After nine months of searching, the police received a tip-off that the accused was hiding in Chikhali, Buldhana district. They laid a trap and successfully apprehended the accused. The police revealed that the main accused, Imran Shaikh (38) of Ghorpadi, had earlier been arrested. He runs a marriage bureau, and the woman's family had shared her biodata in hopes of finding a prospective groom. Imran started stalking the woman and proposed marriage, but she refused due to the age gap. Imran got the fake Nikahnama made by Khalil and circulated it among friends and relatives. When the girl's family found out, they filed a complaint. The investigation team included Senior Police Inspector Rajendra Landge, Police Inspector (Crime) Jagannath Jankar, PSI Goraksh Ghodke, and policemen Namdev Gaddare, Sachin Randive and Santosh Lavte. Pune Police Crime Branch has also arrested Imran for trying to implicate the girl in extortion cases. He used to call politicians and businessmen using her details.

GANGSTER ACCUSED IN DELHI COURT SHOOTOUT KILLED BY RIVALS IN TIHAR JAIL

TILLU TAJPURIYA ALIAS SUNIL MANN WAS THRASHED WITH IRON RODS BY GANGSTER YOGESH TUNDA AND HIS AIDES IN TIHAR PRISON EARLY THIS MORNING.



New Delhi: Jailed gangster Tillu Tajpuriya was killed in an attack by rival gang members inside Delhi's Tihar Jail this morning. Tillu Tajpuriya, alias Sunil Mann, was thrashed with iron rods allegedly by gangster Yogesh Tunda and his aides in the high-security prison, officials said. He was taken to Deen Dayal Upadhyay Hospital, where he was declared dead, the police said. Another prisoner, Rohit, was also injured in the attack. He is said to be out of danger now. Yogesh Tunda, Deepak Teetar, Riyaj Khan and Rajesh, broke the iron grills of their ward on the first floor of the prison. They attacked Tillu, who had been kept in a ground floor ward with his other gang members, with the same rods, officials said. The four members of the rival Gogi gang used bedsheets to climb down to the ground floor. Tillu was the prime conspirator in the 2021 Rohini Court shootout in which gangster Jitender Gogi was killed. Two members of the Tillu gang, dressed as lawyers, shot dead Jitender Gogi inside the Rohini court on September 24, 2021. Both were then killed in retaliatory firing by the police. "Two men dressed as lawyers opened fire at Jitender Gogi inside the court. That's when police retaliated and killed those two assailants. It's not a gang war," police had told NDTV. The shooting was the result of a rivalry of years between Jitender Gogi's gang and the Tillu gang. The instruction to kill Jitender Gogi was given on the phone by Tillu Tajpuriya, police said. Police have launched a probe into the killing of Tillu Tajpuriya. This is the second case of violence and gang rivalry in Tihar jail in a month. Last month, Prince Tewatia, a close aide of gangster Lawrence Bishnoi, was killed in Tihar jail by rival gang members.

MUMBAI: COMMUTERS USE DUPLICATE KEYS TO ILLEGALLY ACCESS LOCKED MOTOR COACHES ON LOCAL TRAINS

Some commuters in Mumbai are reportedly using duplicate keys to travel in motor coaches attached to every third compartment of local trains. These coaches are otherwise under lockdown and strictly off-limits to commuters. Video recordings obtained by this paper show commuters using these keys to unlock the coaches and travel in them before locking them again after alighting from the train. The motor coach houses a tiny knob in each of these coaches that is connected to the train's brakes and is, therefore, kept locked at all times. Tampering with this knob leads to the crucial electropneumatic brakes not working, rendering the main brakes ineffective. Central Railways officials have expressed concern as only railway employees or policemen have access to the keys. According to experts, unauthorized entry in the motor coach of local service is not only unsafe for train movement but also dangerous for the offenders. "This is not only unlawful but also dangerous and fatal for the life of such intruders. The department should act firmly to curb this menace, lest some major mishap may occur," said PK Srivastava, retired general manager of South Central Railway and former Principal Chief Electrical Engineer of Central Railway.

TUNISHA SHARMA DEATH CASE: SHEEZAN KHAN FILES PLEA IN COURT SEEKING RETURN OF HIS PASSPORT

Television actor Sheezan Khan, the prime accused in the death case of co-star and ex-girlfriend actress Tunisha Sharma, has filed an application in Maharashtra's Vasai court seeking a direction to the police to return his passport which was earlier seized during the investigation of the ongoing case, sources said on Monday. Vasai court will hear application of Sheezan Khan on Tuesday. Sources said that in his application, Sheezan said that he has to fly abroad for shootings for which he would need his passport. Sheezan was arrested in December last year and was under judicial custody before being released on bail from Thane Central Jail earlier on March 5. The Vasai Court had ordered Sheezan's bail with Rs 1 Lakh surety bond and had asked the actor to submit his passport as well. Waliv Police had filed a 524-page charge sheet in the Vasai court accusing Sheezan in the 21-year-old actress' suicide case.
