On Friday, the benchmark indices ended the trading session in green. BSE Sensex Index is up by 1.26 per cent at a level of 64,718.56 and NSE Nifty-50 Index is up by 1.14 per cent at a level of 19,189.05. The Sensex Index hits fresh all-time high at a level of 64,768.58. About 1,890 shares have advanced, 1,627 have declined, and 331 remain unchanged on the BSE.

In the broader market, the indices showed positive movement, with the BSE Mid-Cap Index rising by 0.67 per cent and the BSE Small-Cap Index increasing by 0.51 per cent.

In terms of sectors, the indices were trading mixed, with the BSE Information Technology Index and BSE Capital Goods Index leading the gains.

The market cap of BSE listed companies is Rs 296.48 lakh crore as of Friday, June 30, 2023.

## Mira Road bizman gets 20 years in jail for possessing 5 kg Mephedrone

Businessman Sanjay Jain has been sentenced to 20 years in prison for possessing 5kg of Mephedrone in 2015. Others involved in the case were acquitted.

The special NDPS court, however, acquitted the two main accused, Pramod Pandey and Rajan Rajput, who allegedly supplied the drug to the UK as well as the US and Rohan Gawas, who allegedly made the contraband available to Jain.

The other accused - Ladu Kumawat, Chandramani Pandey, Ankit Kapoor, Rakesh Kapoor, Jogabhai, Nanji Dewasi and Parag Mehta, who allegedly had gone to collect a large consignment - were also acquitted in the matter.

The Narcotics Control Bureau (NCB) raided certain premises in Mira Road on February 25, 2015, based on the information that Jain and Pramod had been storing huge quantities of narcotic substances at a residential premises in Mira Road. When they reached the premises, the officials found Jain in the house, and they claimed to have recovered Mephedrone weighing 5 kg.

The agency claimed that when questioned, Jain confessed that Pramod supplied the contraband and it was to be distributed in the city.

## AJIT'S MOVE LEADS TO CONFUSION AMONG NCP LEADERS IN NAVI MUMBAI

NCP leaders in Navi Mumbai are in confusion after Ajit Pawar joined the Eknath Shinde-Devendra Fadnavis government. Some support Sharad Pawar, while others are waiting to see what happens next.

NAVI MUMBAI: NCP leader Ajit Pawar's move to join forces with the Eknath Shinde-Devendra Fadnavis government has left the party's Navi Mumbai unit leaders in confusion. While some are openly siding with the party chief Sharad Pawar, those inclined towards Ajit Pawar have adopted a wait and watch policy to ensure there are no repercussions in case of another twist in the saga.

The party had previously suffered a setback after the Navi Mumbai strongman Ganesh Naik switched loyalty to BJP before the 2019 Assembly elections.

City unit president Namdeo Bhagat, who was picked by Ajit Pawar after he quit the Shiv Sena, remained non-committal.

"Not just Ajit Pawar, but other top leaders like Chhagan Bhujbal and Dilip Walse Patil have also joined the government. I do not want to make any comments for now. We need to understand the situation first," Bhagat said. Another senior leader, G S Patil, has also taken a cautious approach.

On the other hand, Prashant Patil, NCP general secretary and party observer for Navi Mumbai has sided with the party chief Sharad Pawar. "I have only one Vitthal in the party and that is Sharad Pawar. There is no question of leaving him at any cost. The party rank and file are firmly behind him and it is not going to be any different in Navi Mumbai."

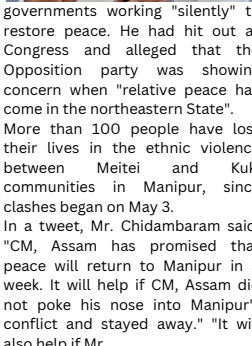

# DRI FINDS 500 GM OF COCAINE WORTH RS 5 CR IN WOODEN SHOWPIECE CONSIGNMENT IN MUMBAI; TWO ARRESTED

MUMBAI: The Directorate of Revenue Intelligence (DRI) seized 500 grams of cocaine worth Rs 5 crore from the consignment of wooden showpieces that had arrived from Costa Rica at the courier terminal in Mumbai and arrested two persons.

Those arrested included a woman, an official said on Monday.

The consignment was seized by the DRI's Mumbai zonal unit on June 28 and a probe found it was imported on a vague address and had a mobile number, the official said.

"Small pouches containing cocaine were concealed in the base of the wooden articles to avoid detection by Customs. There were 56 pouches cumulatively containing 500 grams of cocaine worth Rs 5 crore," PTI quoted him as saying.

"The DRI team called the mobile number and in the mobile phone data of the two it was answered by a girl who claimed she was not aware of any such parcel.



The team then checked KYC documents and got another mobile number. The person who answered it accepted he was the consignee," the official said.

He was held when he came to collect the consignment and his questioning led to the arrest of his woman associate, the official added.

Incriminating evidence has been found in the mobile phone data of the two accused and both have been remanded in DRI custody, the official informed.

# VIDEO: MUMBAI BOY, HIT BY TRAIN WHILE STANDING ON PLATFORM'S EDGE, DIES

**Mumbai:**

A 17-year-old boy died after he was hit by a local train in Mumbai, officials said, as a video of the incident surfaced nearly after two weeks.

Mayank Sharma was standing on the edge of platform 3 at the Malad station when the train moving at a fast speed hit him.

The incident occurred on June 17 when the victim was washing his lunchbox near the tracks.

The boy was tossed away in the impact and showed no movement thereafter, showed security camera footage. He was rushed to Shatabdi Hospital in Kandivli but was declared dead on arrival, officials said. One of his friends standing nearby was also thrown off but he was visibly unharmed, and stood up immediately.

# 9 KILLED AS TRUCK HITS MULTIPLE VEHICLES, CRASHES INTO DHABA IN MAHARASHTRA



According to the police, the accident took place around 10 am on the Mumbai-Agra highway near Palasner village in Dhule district, located 300 kilometres from Mumbai.

Mumbai: At least nine people were killed and more than 20 injured after a truck barreled down a highway in Maharashtra's Dhule district on Tuesday, plowing into four vehicles and a dhaba, police said.

According to the police, the accident took place around 10 am on the Mumbai-Agra highway near Palasner village in Dhule district, located 300 kilometres from Mumbai.

The brakes of the truck failed, sending it barreling out of control. The truck then rammed into two motorcycles, a car, and another truck on its rear side before slamming into a dhaba near a bus stop on the highway and flipping over, the police said.

Some of the victims included those waiting at the bus stop.

The truck was on its way to Dhule from Madhya Pradesh.

The injured have been shifted to hospitals and the police have initiated a probe into the accident.

# RELIEF FOR MOTORISTS AS NHAI FIXES POTHOLES ON VARSOVA BRIDGE

NHAI takes action against contractor to ensure smooth commute along Mumbai-Ahmedabad stretch

Motorists travelling from **Mumbai** to **Ahmedabad** via the newly constructed **Varsova** bridge, which passes over Vasai Creek, will no longer have to endure traffic jams as the National Highway Authority of India (NHAI) contractor has successfully filled the potholes on the bridge.

Speaking to mid-day, NHAI official Suhas Chitnis stated, "We have issued a notice to the contractor, Vijay M Mistry Construction Pvt Ltd and NG Project (JV). We instructed them to repair the potholes and uneven road surface on the bridge, and if they fail to do so, appropriate action will be taken as per the contract. On Monday, the contractor carried out the necessary repairs, making the road surface on the bridge smooth."

This reporter travelled on the Mumbai-Ahmedabad stretch between Borivali and Manor on Sunday afternoon. While crossing the new Varsova bridge, it was observed that repair work had commenced, although the rainfall was causing some inconvenience to the workers involved.

# MANIPUR HIGHWAY BLOCKADE LIFTED AFTER KUKI GROUPS ASSURED OF SETTLEMENT OF POLITICAL DEMANDS

The 60-day blockade of the Dimapur-Imphal National Highway-2 was lifted on July 3 after a representative of the Union government assured Kuki groups that their political demands can only be addressed and settled by the government. Yogi Adityanath's office tweeted that whenever there is riot in any part of the globe, the world seeks solace in Yogi model.

Uttar Pradesh chief minister Yogi Adityanath's office on Saturday reacted to a viral tweet that demanded Yogi Adityanath be sent to France to control the riot situation there within 24 hours. "Whenever extremism fuels riots, chaos engulfs and law & order situation arises in any part of the globe, the World seeks solace and yearns for the transformative 'Yogi Model' of Law & Order established by Maharaj Ji in Uttar Pradesh," the verified handle of Yogi Adityanath's office tweeted.

The demand was raised by a Twitter account going by the name Professor N John Camm identifying himself as a senior interventional cardiologist. However, social media users doubted the identity of the Twitter and claimed that the handle actually belongs to Dr Narendra Vikramaditya Yadav who was once arrested for a cheating case.

On Twitter, many users lightly commented that Yogi Adityanath can control the riots in France in 24 hours, but this particular tweet by the handle @njohncamm with a blue tick went viral as the handle was presumed to be of an international personality.
