

MAN KILLS LIVE-IN-PARTNER, CHOPS BODY INTO OVER 20 PIECES IN MUMBAI'S MIRA ROAD; HELD

According to the police, the residents the housing society on Wednesday called them complaining of a foul smell emanating from flat number 704.

A 56-year-old man allegedly killed his 32-year-old live-in partner and later chopped her body into more than 20 pieces using two cutters in order to destroy evidence in Mumbai's Mira Road area.

The Naya Nagar police have detained the accused and are interrogating him further. A preliminary inquiry indicates that he killed her over domestic disputes.

According to the police, the residents of J-wing in Geeta Aakashdeep Cooperative Housing Society, Geeta Nagar, Phase-7, on Wednesday called them complaining of a foul smell emanating from flat number 704.

Following this, a team from the Naya Nagar police station visited the building, broke open the flat and found the decomposed body of a woman in pieces



lying in the flat. The deceased woman has been identified as Saraswati Vaidya, 32, an orphan.

A hunt for the accused was launched and he was soon nabbed from the colony.

A preliminary inquiry revealed that Vaidya had been living with Manoj Sahani in the flat since 2014. Sahani used to work at a ration shop.

Neighbours told the police that the couple would often fight.

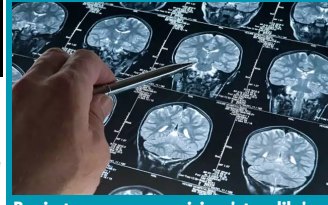
In the preliminary inquiry, it seems that the accused, in order to destroy the evidence, chopped the body in pieces. We nabbed the accused while he was trying to leave the building. We are further interrogating him," said Jayant

Bajbale, Deputy Commissioner of Police. "The gruesome killing was committed on June 4, and the accused, using two cutters, including an electric one, chopped the body into small pieces. Some pieces of the body seem to be missing. We suspect that the accused may have dumped the body pieces gradually in different areas," said Shrikant Pathak, Additional Commissioner of Police, Mira-Bhayandar Vasai Virar police. The police have seized the cutters used in chopping the body.

"We are in the process of registering a case under sections 302 (murder) and 201 (destruction of evidence) of the Indian Penal Code," DCP Bajbale said.

This is the second gruesome killing of women in the past fortnight in the area. Last week, a woman's headless body was found near Uttan Beach.

The brutal murder also reminded the shocking killing of Shradha, who was killed and later chopped into 35 pieces by her live-in partner Aftab Poonawala.

'Girls don't come to train anymore' — in Haryana hinterland, anger brews over treatment of wrestlers

Support for wrestlers demanding BJP MP Brij Bhushan's arrest is growing across rural Haryana, where akhadas are seen as road to glory for young sportspersons.

Chandigarh: For 45-year-old Dayanand Dhaka, kabaddi is more than just a sport. He started playing in his younger days, and years later, turned a plot attached to a crematorium in Haryana's Kirtan into a makeshift stadium with the help of fellow villagers.

His pet project was a hit. Over the past three years, more than a 100 boys and 25-30 girls have flocked to this 'stadium' each morning to play kabaddi, engage in a bout of wrestling, or train for sprints, marathons and other activities that don't need costly equipment.

Last year, a girl and two boys from the village, located in Hissar district, were recruited by the Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) and the Army, respectively. They were regulars at the makeshift stadium.

It is not the same anymore. Ever since the allegations of sexual harassment against benched Wrestling Federation of India (WFI) chief Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh made the news, many have stopped sending their daughters for training, said Dhaka.

"I personally went to some of the parents, requesting them not to deprive their daughters of this physical activity.

WE HAVE FAILED TO UNDERSTAND IQBAL'S PERSPECTIVE

This paper comprises various thinkers and philosophers of Modern India, such as Pandita Ramabai, BR Ambedkar, Mahatma Gandhi, VD Savarkar, etc.

A statement from the office of DU Vice-Chancellor read, "Allama Iqbal was dropped from the Political Science syllabus during the discussion on the undergraduate course in the 1014th Academic Council meeting of the University of Delhi. Presiding over the meeting, Vice Chancellor Prof Yogesh Singh said that those who laid the foundation to break India should not be in the syllabus. The House unanimously passed the Vice-Chancellor's proposal."

This is sheer prejudice against the great poet. Rafiq Zakaria wrote in his book Iqbal: The Poet and the Politician that though Iqbal failed miserably as a politician, his vision as a poet-philosopher was all-encompassing. Iqbal proposed the creation of a Muslim province within the Indian Federation,

COMMUNAL CONFLICT IN MAHARASHTRA AGAIN. 'SOCIAL MEDIA POST ON TIPU SULTAN' STOKES PROTEST IN KOLHAPUR

Mumbai: Maharashtra's Kolhapur boiled with communal conflict Wednesday after a group of Hindutva organisations called a bandh in the city to protest against an allegedly objectionable social media post shared by some persons the previous day.

The purported post was about Tipu Sultan, the 18th-century Muslim ruler of the erstwhile princely state of Mysore. Stone-pelting erupted as the police stepped in and asked the protesters to return.

A day earlier, stone-pelting was reported in another district of Maharashtra — Ahmednagar — during a rally organised by the Sakal Hindu Samaj, an umbrella organisation of several Hindutva outfits, in Sangamner town. Two people were injured and five vehicles vandalised.

The 'Hindu Jan Akròsh Morcha' was organised allegedly after some



youths displayed photos of 17th-century Mughal emperor Aurangzeb at a rally in the area.

Speaking to reporters in Navi Mumbai Wednesday, Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnis, who also holds the home portfolio, said "acts of glorifying Mughal emperor Aurangzeb or Tipu Sultan will not be tolerated in Maharashtra".

Meanwhile, the Opposition has accused the state government of encouraging communal conflict. With these two incidents, Maharashtra has seen nine incidents of communal conflict in 4 months.

MUMBAI: ENTIRE FAMILY TERRORISED BY PSYCHO STALKER FOR FIVE YEARS

After he harassed and stalked 18-year-old for two years, Amboli man was sent to jail; now, he is out and has resumed his harassment with impunity outside their home. The members of an **Andheri-based** family have claimed that a deranged stalker has been targeting their daughter and disrupting their lives for five agonising years. The family has repeatedly brought the behaviour of the accused, Rajan Kashyap, to the attention of the Mumbai police. According to sources, Kashyap was arrested in 2020 and subsequently released on bail. After getting convicted and serving more than one and half years in **prison**, the accused on Monday, a day after being released, approached the residence of the family and tried to enter it. According to the family, Kashyap kept yelling the name of the 23-year-old woman member of the family with whom he was allegedly obsessed since she was 18. Disturbed, a number of building residents recorded him and tweeted the videos to the police seeking help. The woman's father said, "Kashyap has been harassing and stalking my daughter. We

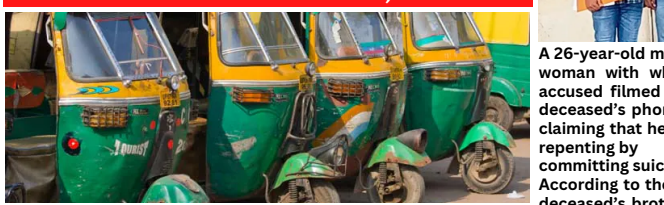


lodged four FIRs and more than half a dozen non-cognisable reports between 2018 and 2020 at the Amboli police station. He was arrested and released on bail and sentenced to about one and a half years over these crimes. On June 4, he came out of jail. He started creating a nuisance the very next day by repeatedly shouting my daughter's name on the road." He added, "Kashyap used to work as a peon in a studio near the building. He would harass and **stalk** the girl when she would go to and return from college. Every time the police would take action, he would come to our place and create a racket. We felt some relief after he was convicted but not that he's out, he is back to his old tricks." He added, "I have shifted my wife and daughter to my relative's house."

21-YEAR-OLD WOMAN FROM JALANDHAR GOES MISSING AFTER FALLING INTO NIAGARA FALLS

AUTO DRIVER HAD SEX WITH DRUNK MAN AFTER ARGUMENT OVER FARE, ARRESTED



The incident occurred on Saturday night after the male passenger (31), who was heavily drunk, boarded an autorickshaw in Ghatkopar, Mumbai: A 25-year-old autorickshaw driver has been arrested by Mumbai Police for allegedly performing unnatural sex with a drunk male passenger in suburban Ghatkopar after an argument over the payment of fare, an official said on Wednesday. The driver also took away the mobile phone and the ATM card of the victim. The incident occurred on Saturday night after the male passenger (31), who was heavily drunk, boarded an autorickshaw in Ghatkopar. He made the autorickshaw driver go from one place to another as he was barely in his senses and cannot pinpoint the location of his destination, the official said. "After an hour, the passenger finally got down from the rickshaw. When the driver asked him to pay ₹ 250 in fare, the passenger handed him over a ₹ 100 note, following which an argument ensued. In a fit of rage, the driver forcefully took the man with him to an isolated place in a garden and forcefully performed unnatural sex with him," the official said. Later, the driver forced the victim to accompany him to an ATM kiosk and made him withdraw ₹ 200. He took away the victim's mobile phone and ATM card before allowing him to go, the official said quoting the FIR.

LIEUTENANT COLONEL DONATES SPERMS TO WOMAN CLERK WITH WHOM HE HAD AN AFFAIR, COURT-MARTIALLED

A WATCHMAN OF THE HOSTEL IS MISSING AND POLICE TEAMS HAVE BEEN FORMED TO TRACK HIM
A Lieutenant Colonel who was posted at the Indian Military Academy (IMA), Dehradun, has been court-martialled by the Army for having an affair with a civilian woman clerk at the academy and donating sperms for her in-vitro fertility treatment. The General Court Martial of the officer concluded on June 7 at the Bengal Engineer Group and Centre, Roorkee, where he pleaded guilty to all charges against him. The officer has been awarded severe reprimand by the court martial along with a sentence of forfeiture of three years service for the purpose of substantive rank of Lt Col, forfeiture of three years seniority of rank and forfeiture of three years service for increased pay. The Lt Colonel belongs to the Army Education Corps and was posted in the Academic Branch of IMA Dehradun when he developed a relationship with the woman clerk working in IMA who was married at the time to a Havildar of the Corps of Engineers. The Lt Colonel too was married and has two children. During the course of investigation, it was



revealed that the officer had accompanied the woman on multiple occasions for her in-vitro fertility treatment for pregnancy and had also donated sperms for the same. It was when Lt Colonel stopped all contact with the woman after being posted out of IMA Dehradun that she filed a police complaint and thereafter a complaint with the Army authorities. The accused officer was defended by two defence counsel, Shailendra Kumar Singh and Keshav Sharma of Allahabad High Court. Prosecution was conducted by Colonel Virender Singh (retd),

TRAGIC END TO AN AFFAIR: MAN HELD FOR KILLING LOVER'S HUSBAND

26-YEAR-OLD, AFTER KILLING MAN WITH A HAMMER, BURIED BODY NEAR THANE CREEK AND SENT OUT A FAKE SUICIDE MESSAGE TO FRIENDS AND RELATIVES



A 26-year-old man has been arrested for **killing** the husband of a woman with whom he had an affair. After the murder, the accused filmed a video of the creek near **Ghodbunder** on the deceased's phone and sent a message to his wife and relatives claiming that he had made a mistake a year ago and he was now repenting by committing suicide. According to the police, they initiated an investigation after the deceased's brother approached the Samta Nagar police station and showed them the video and suicide message. The police registered a missing person complaint and began their investigation using technical analysis and CCTV footage. They subsequently apprehended the suspect, who confessed to the crime during interrogation. The accused, identified as Sureshkumar Kumawat, has been **booked** and arrested under various sections of the IPC, stated an officer. The deceased, Dinesh Prajapati, was involved in the clothing business and resided with his wife and siblings in the Poisar area. Both the accused and the deceased hailed from the same native village in Pali district, Rajasthan. During the interrogation, it was revealed that Kumawat worked as a dhokla supplier and also repaired CCTV cameras. He admitted to having an affair with Prajapati's wife. Kumawat confessed to assaulting Prajapati with a hammer during a fight at his residence in Kajupada on June 1, resulting in Prajapati's death. The accused then wrapped Prajapati's body in a plastic bag, tied it with a rope, and transported it on Prajapati's scooter to Ghodbunder near the creek around midnight.

MERELY 38% OF BCOM STUDENTS PASS FINAL EXAMS

MUMBAI: Only 38% final-year BCom students cleared their Mumbai University exams, probably the lowest-ever success rate recorded in the final exams. The current batch of final-year students across traditional undergraduate courses have spent two crucial years of their college at home, learning online and also giving the exams online. Their first written exam was the Semester V one, which was held in November last year. An equal number of students had failed to clear the Semester V exam too. Colleges, however, were hoping for better results in the final exams. "We are seeing more than 50% of students failing the first- and second-year college internal exams too. They have lost the practice of studying. Many have lost touch with studies, as they had managed to clear the multiple-choice-questions based online exams easily in the pandemic," said a principal. Among all other courses, BCom sees the highest enrolment in Mumbai and therefore a large number of students reach the final year too.

GANGSTER SANJEEV JEEVA, AIDE OF MUKHTAR ANSARI, SHOT DEAD IN LUCKNOW COURT



A man, dressed as a lawyer, opened fire at Sanjeev Maheshwari Jeeva who had come to the SC/ST court for a hearing. Dreaded gangster Sanjeev Jeeva was shot dead by a man inside a Lucknow court on Wednesday. The incident occurred inside the court house, where the assailant opened fire, killing Sanjeev Jeeva and also injuring a young girl. Sanjeev Maheshwari Jeeva, a close aide of gangster-turned-politician **Mukhtar Ansari**, was accused in the murder case of BJP MLA Brahma Dutt Dwivedi. Initial reports suggest that the shooter arrived in the court dressed as a lawyer and opened fire at Sanjeev Jeeva. The attacker who killed Sanjeev Jeeva has been arrested by Lucknow Police. He has been identified as Vijay Yadav. Jeeva, who himself was a dreaded shooter, was brought to Lucknow court for a hearing in a criminal case. He was booked in several other criminal cases. A police constable was also injured in the attack and has been sent to Lucknow Civil Hospital for treatment. Meanwhile, heavy police forces have been deployed in Lucknow court after the shootout. Starting his journey as a compounder, Sanjeev Jeeva eventually found himself immersed in the underworld. He was also said to be a close aide of Munna Bajrang, who was killed in 2018 while serving time in Baghat prison.
