APPLE LAUNCHES A NEW IPHONE 14 AND IPHONE 14 PLUS YELLOW COLOUR VARIANT

THE ALL-NEW YELLOW COLOUR VARIANT OF THE IPHONE 14 AND IPHONE 14 PLUS WILL GO ON PRE-ORDERS STARTING MARCH 10TH, 2023.

Apple usually reserves at least one colour option for its iPhone devices, which it unveils mid-season (5-6 months before the launch of its next lineup). Following the tradition, the brand has now launched an all-new Yellow colour variant of its iPhone 14 and iPhone 14 Plus devices.

The new Yellow colour for the iPhone 14 devices joins an already extensive list of paint jobs available (midnight, starlight (PRODUCT) RED, blue, and purple) and will soon start selling in the market. The Pro models, however, have not been provided with the same treatment, and it looks like Apple might not be releasing a new colour option for the iPhone 14 Pro and iPhone 14 Pro Max devices anytime soon. Nevertheless, let's take a look at the new Yellow colour variant of the iPhone 14 and iPhone 14 Plus devices.

As seen in the image above, this is what the new Yellow colour option for the iPhone 14 and iPhone 14 Plus devices looks like. The new Yellow colour iPhone 14 and iPhone 14 Plus devices retain the usual pricing, and will sell for a starting price of Rs 79,900 and Rs 89,900, respectively.

Interested buyers will be able to pre-order the new colour option in India and other countries starting tomorrow, i.e March 10th, 2023. The devices will be available starting March 14th, 2023.

Plus, as far as accessories are concerned, the iPhone 14 and the iPhone 14 Plus will now have four new official covers - canary yellow, olive, sky, and iris.



ED QUESTIONS MANISH SISODIA AGAIN AT TIHAR JAIL, ACCEPTS K KAVITHA'S REQUEST

 The enforcement directorate (ED) on Thursday questioned Delhi's former deputy chief minister Manish Sisodia for the second time inside Tihar jail about his role and links in the Delhi excise policy irregularities, in which ₹100 crore bribe was allegedly paid to the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) leaders in lieu of favouring certain liquor businessmen and politicians. People familiar with the interrogation said Sisodia is being interrogated on various aspects of the case including destruction of evidence (by changing phones frequently), changing profit margin for wholesalers from 5% to "unprecedented" 12%, kickbacks paid by the alleged South Group to Vijay Nair on behalf of AAP leaders and about the decision to change policy related Group of Ministers (GoM) report. His questioning may continue on Friday too, officials said. "We are currently focusing on larger conspiracy and the money trail," said an officer, who didn't want to be named.

'BJP MEMBERS FROM NORTH INDIAN STATES...': TAMIL NADU CM ON 'ATTACK' VIDEOS

Bihari migrant workers 'attacked' in Tamil Nadu: TN chief minister MK Stalin has spoken to Bihar's Nitish Kumar and reassured him of the safety of men and women from his state

Tamil Nadu chief minister MK Stalin on Thursday accused 'BJP members from north Indian states' of spreading 'fake news' - about the alleged assault on Bihari migrant workers. He claimed a 'politically motivated plot' against his government, and pointed out the rumours - viral on social media and shared by some media publications - emerged a day after he called on the opposition to unite against the ruling Bharatiya Janata Party before the 2024 election.

He was referring to comments made last week - during his birthday celebration - at which there were calls for him to be the opposition's prime ministerial face.

Stalin today said his state is home to people from across India and that 'Tamils love brotherhood... This is well known to the northern state brothers here'.

"You can understand the plot if you notice this (spreading of the rumours) was done the day after I spoke about the need for a united, national-level alliance against the BJP. Few people created fake videos... spread false news. BJP members from north Indian states did this with bad intentions," he said.



MUMBAI: BMC HOPES TO COLLECT RS 1,500 CRORE PROPERTY TAX IN 23 DAYS

Civic body short of revised target by Rs 300Cr, but hopes to collect more than it this financial year

The Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) officials aim to collect Rs 1,500 crore property tax in the next 23 days. They are hopeful of collecting property tax of around R6,000 crore this financial year by March 31, 2023. Deputy Municipal Commissioner Sunil Dhamane said, "We are hopeful that we can collect around Rs 6,000 crore. Till date, we have collected Rs 4,500 crore from property tax."

According to civic chief I S Chahal's budget speech of 2023-24, the BMC revised the target of property tax collection from Rs 7,000 crore to Rs 4,800 crore. There were two main reasons for the decrease in property tax. Firstly, exemption of property tax to residents having a carpet area of up to 500 square feet, and secondly, the revision in property tax that was due in 2020-21, but was deferred due to Covid-19 that year and also in 2021-22. In the year 2022-23, the government of Maharashtra, to help citizens, accepted the proposal of BMC to defer the revision of property tax by another year, Chahal had said in the speech. The BMC had collected Rs 5,792 crore as property tax in the last financial year. BMC has issued bills of property tax to residential property tax payers up to 500 square feet for 2019-20.

Mumbai: Bodies of couple found in Ghatkopar flat bathroom

While cops await post-mortem reports, resident of the building says a geyser could have caused deaths

The incident came to light when on Wednesday morning, a maid working for the Shahs, who stayed in G wing in flat number 501, arrived for work. She rang the door bell several times, but nobody answered the door. The maid then called Deepak's mother who gave the mobile phone number of a relative living nearby. The police said the relative arrived and opened the door with a spare key.

"There was nothing suspicious inside the home, the relative found the shower running in the bathroom, and both of them lying on the floor. They were rushed to Rajawadi Hospital, where doctors declared them dead on arrival," said DCP (Zone 7).

In a message posted on social media, he levelled certain allegations against Phansalkar pertaining to his term as the Thane CP from July 31, 2018, to May 17, 2021. Phansalkar rubbishes allegations, calls them "blasphemous" When contacted by the FPJ, Phansalkar rubbished the allegations, calling them "blasphemous". He said Toke was sacked last month and that was the reason why he was making baseless allegations. However, Toke told the FPJ that he had levelled the charges first on January 9, whereas he was sacked on February 16. "My press conference has nothing to do with my dismissal," he added. Toke had earlier filed a public interest litigation through his lawyer Pradip Havnur in the Bombay High Court with a view to exposing rampant corruption in the traffic police.
