



AFTER MADHYA PRADESH, UP DECLARES 'THE KERALA STORY' TAX-FREE

The Uttar Pradesh government will declare the recently released film 'The Kerala Story' tax-free in the state, chief minister Yogi Adityanath announced on Tuesday.

Last year, the UP CM had also watched Akshay Kumar-starrer 'Samrat Prithviraj' at a special screening after declaring the movie tax-free in the state.

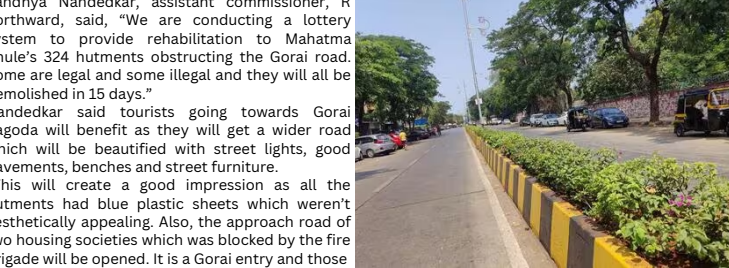
BMC DEMOLISHES 324 HUTS TO CLEAR INACCESSIBLE GORAI BEACH ROAD

Sandhya Nandedkar, assistant commissioner, R north ward, said, northward, said, "We are conducting a lottery to provide rehabilitation to Mahatma Phule's 324 hutments obstructing the Gorai road. Some are legal and some illegal and they will all be demolished in 15 days."

Nandedkar said tourists going towards Gorai Pagoda will benefit as they will get a wider road which will be beautified with street lights, good pavements, benches and street furniture. "This will create a good impression as all the hutments had blue plastic sheets which weren't aesthetically appealing. Also, the approach road of the two housing societies which was blocked by the fire brigade will be opened. It is a Gorai entry and those going to Gorai Beach towards the pagoda will find it easy," said Nandedkar.

On Sunday, CM Shinde interacted with stranded students from the state of Manipur. Students from Maharashtra who were stuck in the violence-hit areas of the northeastern state of Manipur have been brought back to Mumbai by a special flight on Monday.



The students left Guwahati around 4.30 pm for Mumbai, informed Maharashtra Chief Minister's Office. After landing safely in Mumbai, the students looked visibly relieved and even posed for photographs with each other. While talking to ANI, a student Rohit who was stuck in Manipur said, "We want to thank Chief Minister Eknath Shinde. The situation in Manipur was pretty bad, the internet was shut and there were firing." One of the stranded students who were brought back to Mumbai from Manipur tells about the situation in the northeastern state when violence spiralled out of control a few days ago.

Shiv Sena's Manipur chief Tombi Singh also expressed his gratitude to Maharashtra Chief Minister Eknath Shinde for providing all possible help to ensure the safe evacuation of students and even posed for pictures with them. SPA OWNER ALLEGEDLY MOLESTED IN NAVI MUMBAI, POLICE NAB TWO FOR EXTORTION

The Navi Mumbai Police on Monday said that it arrested two people and is on the lookout for two more for allegedly molesting and extorting money from a spa owner in Vashi. Four people were consistently complaining to the police station through applications about the alleged use of minors in the spa. On Sunday when the accused demanded sexual favours and extorted Rs 5,000 from the spa owner, she rushed to the police station and registered a complaint, the police said.

According to the complaint filed by the 23-year-old victim, she told the police that she runs a spa centre at Vashi and four men identified as Ganesh Govekar, Akshay Sonawane, Ritwick Kedar and Sahil Patankar visited the spa on April 25. After the visit, four of them started complaining to Vashi police saying that the spa allegedly uses minor girls for massages. Their complaints also mentioned spa and massage centres in the vicinity, the police said.

The accused kept on pressuring the 23-year-old spa owner to allegedly pay them Rs 15,000 per month and even demanded sexual favours from her. They even molested her, she told the police.

On May 7, the suspects again visited the spa and extorted Rs 5,000 from the spa owner through a digital wallet.

"After paying the money, the spa owner rushed to Vashi police station and registered a complaint against the four involved in the matter," said an official from Vashi Police station.

He said, "They were booked under IPC section 389 (Putting person in fear of accusation of offence, in order to commit extortion), 354 (outraging modesty of women) 354A (sexual harassment) and 34 (common intention). After the complaint, Ganesh Govekar (26) and Akshay Sonawane (27) were arrested immediately. While efforts are on to nab Ritwick and Sahil."

MUMBAI: 'EXPEDITE REDEVELOPMENT PROJECTS' DEVENDRA FADNAVIS DIRECTS OFFICIALS



Devendra Fadnavis conducted a meeting of senior officials from the cooperation, housing, finance, law and judiciary, BMC and the Maharashtra Housing and Area Development Authority.

Maharashtra Deputy Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis on Monday directed the officials from various government departments to expedite redevelopment and self-redevelopment projects in the city. He conducted a meeting of senior officials from the cooperation, housing, finance, law and judiciary, BMC and the Maharashtra Housing and Area Development Authority at the Sahyadri guest house. The discussion was aimed at bringing more clarity on several aspects of redevelopment and self-redevelopment of cooperative housing societies in Mumbai.

Fadnavis directed the officials that as per the policy, the housing societies opting for self-redevelopment are entitled to get an additional 10% floor space index (FSI) over and above the standard FSI as per the Development Control Rules standard rules. This benefit should also be given to the projects on roads which are less than nine metres wide, he added.

Dedicated single window' for projects

Fadnavis further directed the BMC officials to create a dedicated single window for such projects and ensure that further action is initiated on projects coming to this single window within three months. He also instructed me to prepare a proposal regarding the GST and interest exemptions for such projects. The BJP leader, who also handles the finance portfolio, directed the finance department that the banks willing to come forward to finance the self-redevelopment projects should be included by the department.

Fadnavis tells officials to reduce transfer premium

He asked the officials to digitise the deemed conveyance process and reduce the transfer premium from ₹1 lakh to ₹50,000 for transferring flats from the SRA cooperative housing societies.

FORMER MAYOR OF MUMBAI VISHWANATH MAHADESHWAR PASSES AWAY

Mahadeshwar death is seen as a huge loss to the Thackeray group of Shiv Sena

Senior Shiv Sena (UBT) leader and former Mayor of Mumbai Vishwanath Mahadeshwar passed away on Tuesday after being unwell for a few days. He was 63 years old and suffered cardiac arrest on Tuesday morning.

His mortal remains will be kept at Raje Sambhaji Vidyalaya, Santacruz East, at 2pm for last darshan. After that, at 4pm, the funeral procession will leave for the crematorium at Teachers Colony. Mahadeshwar's death is seen as a huge loss to the Thackeray. Shiv Sena chief Uddhav Thackeray and other Shiv Sainiks will attend his funeral.

Mahadeshwar was the Mayor of Mumbai from 2017 to 2019. He also chaired the Standing Committee. He has also served as the Chairman of the Education Committee. He faced defeat from Bandra East constituency in 2019 assembly elections. This is the constituency where party chief Uddhav Thackeray lives.

Mumbai Youth Congress President Zeeshan Siddique has expressed grief and shared condolences with the bereaved family of Mahadeshwar.

A case under section 307 (attempt to murder) of the Indian Penal Code has been registered against the accused, who is a resident of Mumbai in neighbouring Thane district, the official added.
