

MINOR GIRL FALLS FROM 7TH FLOOR OF UNDER-CONSTRUCTION MUMBAI BUILDING WHILE PARTYING WITH FRIENDS, DIES

A 16-year-old girl died after she fell from the 7th floor of an under-construction building located in Sector 15 of CBD Belapur in Navi Mumbai. The victim was partying with two male friends when the incident occurred.

The NRI coastal police station has filed an ADR (accidental death report) in the matter. Police claimed to have found empty beer bottles at the spot and said it appeared that the girl slipped and fell to the first floor from the seventh, where the three of them were present. She suffered head injuries, causing her death.



The deceased, who lived in Panvel, was inebriated at the time of the incident. WHAT HAPPENED?

The girl had gone to the Belapur residence of her boyfriend Shivam Nanavare (20), who works at a nearby mall. They then called their common friend Sai Kadam (23) for the party. Kadam works as an administration staffer in a vehicle showroom in Kamothe. The girl who had been living at her friend's house for the past two days, insisted on partying outside, which was originally planned at her boyfriend's place.

She allegedly chose the location as she was hiding from her parents. Police suspect that the girl lost her balance and fell while following her friend who had gone to attend nature's call. The boys rushed down immediately and found her lying in a pool of blood.

Pramod Toradmal, senior inspector, NRI Coastal police station, said, "The boy (Nanavare) and the deceased knew each other and were friends for years, having grown up together and their families were also well-acquainted. They lived in the same building. As of now, no foul play has been suspected. But the postmortem report suggests head injuries. We are probing further and an investigation is on. Both the boys will be questioned. After she fell, one of them went to check on her and the other informed the police."

The incident came days after the boy scored 92 per cent in Class 10 state board exams, police said. The results of the board exams were announced last week. The incident happened in Vartak Nagar area of Thane. Residents were alerted after they heard a loud thud sound. When they reached the spot, they saw the boy lying in a pool of blood around 2 am, police said.

A case of accidental death was registered and a further probe was underway, police added.

Dr Padmini Desai, member of the Advanced Locality Management (ALM), who resides near the MHADDA office, said, "The MHADDA area is chock-a-block with barely one lane for vehicles to pass from both sides. If there are any construction vehicles, there will be jams. There are tables placed on footpaths by hawkers and stalls at the corner of the road where auto and cab drivers park their vehicles while having food. This leads to further jams."

Dr Desai added that she has operated on a few people from her area, who met with an accident due to rash driving by auto drivers. "An auto ran over someone's foot and he had to be operated upon."

MUMBAI CHAINSAW REPAIRMAN RECALLS CHILLING MEET WITH MURDER ACCUSED

THE SAME CHAINSAW WAS USED TO CHOP UP SARASWATI VAIDYA'S BODY. THE SHOPKEEPER SAID MANOJ SANE SEEMED CALM WHEN HE WAS AT THE SHOP.



Mumbai: On June 4, the day 32-year-old Saraswati Vaidya is suspected to have been murdered by her husband Manoj Sane, 56, near Mumbai, the accused had gone to a shop to get a tree-cutting chainsaw repaired. The same chainsaw was allegedly used to chop up Saraswati's body.

NDTV spoke to the owner of Karthika Enterprises in Borivali, who said that the chainsaw's chain had slipped and Sane had visited his shop to get it repaired on June 4.

Asked how Sane's demeanour was when he was at the shop, the shop owner, who refused to give his name, said, "He did not look scared or anything of the sort. He was calm and waited at the shop till the repair was complete."

The shopkeeper also said that the chainsaw may have been purchased at his shop earlier, when he was away. "We do sell chainsaws like the one Sane had. There wasn't much wrong with the machine. Just the chain had slipped," he said in Hindi. The shop owner said he had spotted no marks on the chainsaw while repairing it.

Asked how he felt now that he knew what the chainsaw was used for, the shopkeeper said he was worried about himself, since he would now have to go to the court as a witness whenever summoned.

The chopped up parts of Saraswati's body were found at the couple's rented apartment in Mira Road on Wednesday after neighbours alerted the police when they found a fetid stench emanating from the flat.

Police said earlier today that Saraswati and Sane were married, but kept that fact hidden because of the difference in their ages. Saraswati would tell people that Sane was her maternal uncle.

KEEPING US NUCLEAR FILES IN SHOWER, ATTEMPT TO DESTROY DOCUMENTS: 5 CHARGES IN DONALD TRUMP INDICTMENT

Former US President Donald Trump hoarded documents on US nuclear programs, potential military vulnerabilities of the US and allies, the indictment says. Trump is facing 37 criminal counts, including wilful retention of national defence information and obstruction of justice.

Former US President Donald Trump has been indicted for illegally retaining classified government records at his Florida estate after leaving the White House in 2021 and obstruction of justice. He has been charged with mishandling hundreds of classified documents, including ones about US nuclear secrets and military plans.

Trump faces a total of 37 criminal counts, including 31 counts of wilful retention of national defence information, according to the indictment. As many as six pictures released as part of the indictment against Trump, who is running for president again in 2024, show cardboard boxes of documents stacked in rooms across his Mar-a-Lago estate, reported the BBC.

As per the complaint lodged by Ayesha Shroff at Santacruz police station, the kickboxing association fighter, identified as Alan Fernandes, was appointed as director of operations in Tiger Shroff's MMA Matrix company. The company gives training in mixed martial arts and its administration is handled by Ayesha Shroff, he said. "Fernandes was appointed director in the MMA Matrix firm in 2018. He is accused of collecting money to organise 11 tournaments in India and abroad through the firm and depositing Rs 58.53 lakh in his personal account," the official said quoting the FIR.

Ayesha Shroff lodged a complaint on May 3 after which Fernandes was booked under Indian Penal Code sections for cheating, criminal breach of trust and other offences, the official said.
