MARN HELD FOR MARRYING 'UNDERAG MUMBAI: A 23-year-old man was arrested by Dahisar police for abduction and cheating after he tied the knot with his 'underage' girlfriend. Police said the girl's father filed a complaint that she was minor though her Aadhaar card showed she had completed 18.

The girl is 17 and recently appeared for her class XII exams. Her father works as a tailor. On April 10, her father got a phone call from Dahisar police station. Officials said his daughter was at the police station to inform them that she had tied the knot. Her father rushed to the police station, checked the marriagerelated paperwork, and found the Aadhaar copy mentioned her year of birth as 2004.

"Her father disputed the date of birth on the Aadhaar copy and produced an enrollment slip which mentioned the year as 2005," said a police officer.

Police checked the UIDAI portal and found that the year was 2004. "Her father claimed she had got the change made at an Aadhaar enrollment centre at the

insistence of her boyfriend, without any supportive document. He sought time to fetch more documents to prove her age and to keep her at a government-run shelter till then," said a police officer.

The girl was placed at a shelter in Borivli. Her father approached the Dahisar school where she had studied upto class X, and sought a copy of the school admission form which mentioned his daughter's year of birth as 2006.

#### JAGAN REDDY WEALTHIEST, ONLY MAMATA NOT CROREPATI: LIST OF RICHEST CMS KEJRIWAL AND NITISH KUMAR OWN ASSETS OF OVER ₹3 CRORE, THE ADR REPORT ON 30 CHIEF MINISTERS OF INDIA CLAIMED. Andhra Pradesh chief minister Jagan Mohan Reddy is the wealthiest chief minister of the country with a total of ₹510 crore assets.

Andhra Pradesh chief minister Jagan Mohan Reddy is the wealthiest chief minister of the country with a total of ₹510 crore assets, according to poll affidavits analysed by the Association for Democratic Reforms. Out of the 30 incumbent chief ministers, 29 are crorepatis with the only exception being West Bengal chief minister Mamata Banerjee with a total asset of ₹15 lakh, the ADR report said. Out of the 30 CMs analysed, 29 (97 per cent) are crorepatis with the average assets being ₹33.96 crore for every CM, the ADR said. According to the ADR report, out of the 30 CMs, 13 (43 per cent) have declared serious criminal cases including those related to murder, attempt to murder, kidnapping and criminal intimidation.

The top three chief ministers in terms of assets are Andhra Pradesh's Jagan Mohan Reddy (over ₹510 crore), Arunanchal Pradesh's Pema Khandu (over ₹163 crore) and Odisha's Naveen Pattnaik (over ₹63 crore), according to the ADR.

The three CMs with the lowest declared assets are – West Bengal's Mamata Banerjee (over ₹15 lakh), Kerala's Pinarayi Vijayan (over ₹1 crore) and Haryana's Manohar Lal (over ₹1 crore), the ADR said.

Both Bihar Chief Minister Nitish Kumar and Delhi's Arvind Kejriwal own assets worth over ₹3 crore, the report said.

According to the report, Jagan Mohan Reddy, the 46-year-old chief minister has an asset of over ₹510 crore with a liability of over ₹1 crore. His self income is over ₹50 crore. The second-richest CM Pema Khandu's self income and liability are 0 while his total asset is over 163 crore. Delhi chief minister Arvind Kejriwal has self income of over 2 lakh and a total asset of over 3 crore.

# COVID SPIKE: INDIA LOGS 10,158 NEW CORONA CASES, 30% MORE THAN YESTERDAY

India recorded a sharp hike in daily Covid-19 cases at 10,158 compared to the previous day on Thursday. According to the health ministry data, the active infections stand at 44,998. This comes as the country is witnessing a surge in cases with Maharashtra and Delhi reporting over 1,000 daily cases the first time this year on Wednesday.

India recorded 7,830 new coronavirus cases on Wednesday, marking a sharp jump from Tuesday when 5,675 cases were reported, according to data shared by the Union Health Ministry.

The daily positivity rate was recorded at 4.42 per cent while the weekly positivity rate was 4.02 per cent. The active cases now constitute 0.10 per cent of the total infections.

According to the ministry's website, 220.66 crore doses of Covid vaccine have been administered in the country. The country is witnessing a sharp rise in the cases of Covid-19. The All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS)-Delhi has issued an advisory for its staff to follow Covid-19 appropriate behaviour after a few of them were tested positive for the infection.

"Nust use reusable cloth face cover/surgical mask in the workplace. Ensure proper cleaning and frequent sanitation of the workplace, particularly of the frequently touched surfaces," the AIIMS management said in an advisory on Wednesday.

The Mumbai Crime branch has "busted a gang" in Goregoan East that was involved in printing and selling T-shirt's of popular clothing brand "Levis"

The officials of unit XII of the Mumbai Crime branch also seized more than 300 T-shirts of the 'Levis brand' and a couple of printing machines worth more than rupees 16.16 lakh.

Police sources said that a 35-year-old accused has been arrested and booked under sections 420, 51, and 63 of the Copyright Trademark Act.

They said that acting on a complaint, a team led by police inspector Dilip Tejankar, WPI Nilofar Shaikh and other officials raided Smita Enterprises in Santosh Nagar in Goregaon West.

"We have seized more than 300 T-shirts," an officer of the Crime Branch's Unit XII said. The accused has been handed over to Dindoshi police station for further investigation.

## MAHARASHTRA: THREE HELD FOR KILLING SHOP OWNER IN THANE

ON APRIL 6, THE ANGRY EMPLOYEE CALLED MHAMANE TO DAHAGAON AREA FOR A BUSINESS DEAL. THE EMPLOYEE AND TWO OF HIS FRIENDS, ALL IN THE AGE GROUP OF 22 TO 25 YEARS, ALLEGEDLY STRANGLED THE SHOP OWNER TO DEATH AND DUMPED THE BODY IN A FOREST THERE, AN OFFICIAL SAID

Police have arrested three persons for allegedly strangling to death a solar products shop owner and dumping the body in a forest in Maharashtra's Thane district, an official said on Wednesday.

The victim, Sachin Mhamane (46), and his wife had reprimanded a man employed at their shop in Titwala area for being irregular in his work, Kalyan taluka police station's senior inspector Jitendra Thakur said.

On April 6, the angry employee called Mhamane to Dahagaon area for a business deal. The employee and two of his friends, all in the age group of 22 to 25 years, allegedly strangled the shop owner to death and dumped the body in a forest there, he said.

After the victim did not return home, his family lodged a missing person's complaint with local police.

During the search, the police found the victim's car abandoned on road in Dahagaon on April 8. They also found his decomposed body in the forest the next day, the official said.

The post-mortem confirmed the death due to strangulation following which the police registered a case of murder and destruction of evidence, he said.

The MIDC Police have arrested a 45-year-old man, an ex-employee of Mumbai Airport, for posing as a fake 'secret agent' from the Crime Investigation Department (CID) Mumbai branch. The matter surfaced on Tuesday when a police constable, Amol Pawar, was on patrol duty in the Andheri East area. He saw a suspicious man dressed in a police uniform.

Senior police inspector Satish Gaikwad said that the accused refused to show any identity, and upon his vehicle's search, two number plates, a Maharashtra Police logo, and several cigarette packets were found inside the car. He was later taken to the MIDC police station.

Accused confessed to being fake agent

During the investigation, the accused revealed his name as Kalidas Janardan Khamkar, a resident of Bhim Nagar in Ghatkopar West. He confessed to being a fake 'secret agent' of CID. He had gotten a police uniform stitched for himself from a local tailor. According to the police, Kalidas used to visit small cigarette and pan stalls and threaten them with fake charges in exchange for cigarette boxes.

"The accused also confessed that he would often randomly stop motorcycles and cars on the road and ask them to pay a fine, which is how he used to make Rs. 500-1000 every day," the officer said. A case has been filed against Kalidas under relevant sections of the Indian Penal Code

#### NAVI MUMBAI MUNICIPAL CORP FACES FLAK BY RESIDENTS OVER WATER CUT FOR 48 HOURS

The NMMC had announced a 24-hour cut in the water supply for April 10. The move was undertaken as the civic body planned to shift the Morbe main pipeline at Chikhale for the Panvel-Karjat railway line and cross the water supply mainline at the Diva-Panvel railway line below the expressway bridge at Kalamboli

The Navi Mumbai Municipal Corporation (NMMC) faced the ire of citizens after failing to provide sufficient water supply to the city for 48 hours. Facing problems, residents reached out to the administration and demanded answers for the prolonged disruption in the water supply.

Belapur resident, 54-year-old Sudhir Dhani, said they had to beg for water for two days, a Hindustan Times report mentioned.

The NMMC had announced a 24-hour cut in the water supply on April 6 for April 10. According to the report, the move was undertaken as the civic body planned to shift the Morbe main pipeline at Chikhale for the Panvel-Karjat railway line and cross the water supply mainline at the Diva-Panvel railway line below the expressway bridge at Kalamboli. The engineering department of the civic body also decided to do the maintenance work of the Bhokarpada water treatment plant and Morbe dam to Digha main pipeline. The water supply was supposed to resume after 10 pm on April 11.

Nerul-based activist Anarajit Chauhan was quoted by Hindustan Times as saying that the NMMC could have undertaken the work in winter when the consumption of water per capita is less than in summer. Chauhan is set to file an RTI to unveil the mismanagement.

# CHANDRAKANT PATIL SHOULD NOT HAVE MADE BABRI-Shiv sena workers remark: Mumbai BJP Chief

Chandrakant Patil's statement that not a single Sena worker was present when the Babri mosque in Ayodhya was demolished in 1992 has put the Bharatiya Janata Party in a spot, as it is a partner of the Eknath Shinde-led Shiv Sena in the Maharashtra government

Mumbai BJP chief Ashish Shelar on Wednesday said it would have been better had his party colleague and Maharashtra minister Chandrakant Patil not made his remark about the role of Shiv Sena workers in the Babri Masjid demolition.

Patil's statement that not a single Sena worker was present when the Babri mosque in Ayodhya was demolished in 1992 has put the Bharatiya Janata Party in a spot, as it is a partner of the Eknath Shinde-led Shiv Sena in the Maharashtra government.

Shelar's reaction came after he met Union Home Minister Amit Shah in New Delhi.

"Patil made those comments in personal capacity. Perhaps it would have been better had he not made those comments," he told reporters.

All were working to bring together various communities and groups. Balasaheb's (late Sena founder Bal Thackeray) role in it (Ram Janmabhoomi movement) was helpful and supportive. We have welcomed it, respected it and honoured his (Bal Thackeray's) views in this movement, he said.

"I want to ask Uddhav ji (Uddhav Thackeray) what was his role in the whole (Babri Masjid demolition) operation," Shelar, a former Maharashtra minister, further said.

The BJP believes that the Babri structure demolition was a spontaneous reaction of Hindus, he said.

"The party neither took any credit for it, nor does it seek it now," he said, adding that religious leaders had started the Ayodhya movement.

ATIU AHMED'S SON ASAD, WANTED CRIMINAL O UMESH PAL MURDER CASE, KILLED IN ENCOUNTE Asad, the son of a gangster-politician Atiq Ahmed, and

Ghulam, son of Maksudan, were both wanted in the Umesh Pal murder case in Prayagraj and had a reward of ₹5 lakh each.

They were killed in an encounter with the UPSTF team led by DySP Navendu and DySP Vimal in Jhansi, ANI reported. The UP STF also reported the recovery of sophisticated foreign-made weapons.

On February 24, Umesh Pal - along with his two police security guards - was fatally shot outside his home in the Dhoomanganj area of Prayagraj. He was a a crucial witness in the 2005 murder case of BSP MLA Raju Pal.

A case was registered against Ahmad, Ashraf, their family members, and others based on a complaint filed by Umesh Pal's wife, Jaya Pal, on February 25. The FIR was filed under sections 147 (rioting), 148 (rioting armed with deadly weapons), 149 (unlawful assembly guilty of offence committed in prosecution of common object), 302 (murder), 307 (attempt to murder), and 506 (criminal intimidation) of the IPC.

On April 13, Atiq Ahmed and his brother Khalid Azim, also known as Ashraf, were brought before the Chief Judicial Magistrate Dinesh Gautam's court in connection with the Umesh Pal murder case. Amid heavy security deployment, the two were presented at around 11:10 am.

While Ahmed was transported from Sabarmati Jail in Gujarat, Azim was brought from a Bareilly jail. Ahmed is also facing charges in the 2005 Raju Pal murder case.

DAY AFTER FIRING AT BATHINDA MILITARY STATION, INDIAN ARMY JAWAN SHOOTS SELF ON DUTY

AN INDIAN ARMY JAWAN DIED AFTER SHOOTING HIMSELF AT BATHINDA MILITARY STATION ON EARLY THURSDAY MORNING.



By India Today News Desk: An Indian Army jawan reportedly shot himself dead in Punjab's Bathinda. The deceased, identified as Laghu Raj Shankar, was stationed on duty when he fired gunshots at himself from his rifle. He succumbed to the bullet injury. The army said the case "purportedly seemed to be of attempted suicide".

The incident took place in the wee hours of Thursday. In a press release, the army said, "The soldier was on sentry duty with his service weapon. The weapon and cartridge case from the same weapon was found next to the soldier. The gunshot wound was near the right temporal region. He was immediately evacuated to the Military Hospital, but succumbed to his injuries. The soldier had returned from leave on 11 April 2023."

The incident comes a day after Punjab Police registered an FIR against two unidentified men in connection with the Bhatinda military station firing incident on Wednesday.

"Death of another soldier at Bathinda military station on Wednesday afternoon has no connection with the earlier firing incident," the army's statement read.

#### UP MAN FLOGGED TO DEATH BY BOSS OVER SUSPICION OF THEFT IN SHAHJAHANPUR, 7 BOOKED IN MURDER CASE

A 32-YEAR-OLD MAN WAS FLOGGED TO DEATH IN UTTAR PRADESH'S SHAHJAHANPUR. THE PROBE BEGAN AFTER A POLICE OFFICER EXAMINED THE BODY AND NOTICED INJURIES INCONSISTENT WITH THE CLAIM OF ELECTROCUTION.



A shocking incident of flogging has been reported from Uttar Pradesh's Shahjahanpur where a 32-year-old man was allegedly beaten to death. The manager was reportedly beaten on the orders of his boss over the accusation of theft. Several employees are said to have been assaulted. As for the deceased identified as Shivam Johri, his body was dumped outside at a government hospital.

According to a report by NDTV, the matter pertains to a transport businessman who had his manager beaten to death. The businessman identified as Bankim Suri is among seven people named in the manager's murder case.

A video of the assault also surfaced online. The video, shared by a journalist on Twitter, showed Shivam tied while a man is seen repeatedly hitting him with a rod.

The report mentioned the police as saying that Shivam's body was abandoned at the medical college and hospital Tuesday night. His family members were told that he had died of electrocution, they said. The probe began after a police officer examined the body in the hospital and noticed injuries inconsistent with the claim of electrocution.

The visuals that surfaced on social media also showed black patches on the victim's body caused by flogging.

Shivam was working with the transport businessman for the past seven years, NDTV reported.

As per the report, the probe so far found that a package of prominent business Kanhiya Hosiery went missing recently and several employees of the transporters were allegedly similarly assaulted on the suspicion of theft. One of the persons said he and two more workers were beaten with him.

The owner of Kanhiya Hosiery identified as Neeraj Gupta is also among the seven accused in the murder case.

Police seized a car from the premises of Kanhiya Hosiery which is suspected to be linked to the crime. The post-mortem report will throw more light on the crime, NDTV reported the police as informing.
