

UP CRIME: WOMAN SLITS 9-YEAR-OLD DAUGHTER'S THROAT

Circle Officer said the incident took place around 8 am under the Chanda police station area. Police in Uttar Pradesh's Sultanpur on Tuesday said that a 35-year-old woman slit her nine-year-old daughter's throat with a knife in the Vivek Nagar area, PTI reported. Circle Officer Lambhua Mohammad Salam said the incident took place around 8 am under the Chanda police station area. The victim was identified as Paridhi. He said the mother, Priyanka Ojha, was mentally ill and undergoing treatment. Salam added that after the attack, Paridhi was taken to a community health centre in Lambhua which referred her to a medical college in Sultanpur. The child succumbed to injuries on the way to the medical college, he said.



The woman was detained and the body of the deceased sent for a post-mortem examination, police said. In a separate case, earlier on June 10, police in the Indian state of **Uttar Pradesh** said that a man allegedly **killed** his lover and hid her body in a tank at his under-construction house, news agency PTI reported. The body of Raj Kesar (35) was recovered on Friday from the house of the accused, Arvind, in Mahewa locality under the Yamunapur Karchhnaa police station area here, they told PTI. Arvind killed Kesar about a fortnight ago and hid her body in a tank at his house, Station House

Officer (SHO) Vishwajeet Singh said. On May 30, Kesar's family reported her missing. Based on the call details of her phone, Arvind was taken into custody and interrogated. The body was recovered at his instance, the SHO said. Earlier on June 7, a 56-year-old man was arrested by the **Naya Nagar police** for murdering his 32-year-old live in partner at Mira Road. According to the police, the woman was murdered two to three days ago. The occupants of the building got a foul smell emanating from one of the flats and alerted the cops. The police said that they found the woman's body cut into pieces. The deceased has been identified as Saraswati Vaidya, 32, while her live-in partner is one Manoj Sahani, 56. Both were living in the J wing of Geeta Akash Deep Building for the past five years. When the police broke open the door of the flat, they found Sahani inside

MIRA ROAD BRUTAL MURDER: LAST RITES OF 'CHOPPED' REMAINS PERFORMED BY SISTERS

The sisters performed the last rites of Vaidya in the afternoon in Mumbai, and DNA analysis, the body parts of Vaidya were handed over to the victim of Mira Road brutal murder case. MHT CET RESULT: 28 STATE STUDENTS GET FULL 100 PERCENTILE, 5 FROM MUMBAI

Statewide examination saw remarkable performance as 14 PCM and 14 PCB group students secured top honours, Pune records the highest number of toppers. The State Common Entrance Test Cell, Maharashtra, has announced the results of the Maharashtra Common Entrance Test (MHT CET) 2022 for the physics, chemistry, and mathematics (PCM) and physics, chemistry, and biology (PCB) groups. This year, a remarkable 28 students from across the state achieved a perfect score of 100 percentile, securing the top positions in their respective groups. Among the toppers, 14 students attained a perfect score in the PCM group, while another 14 candidates achieved the same feat in the PCB group. Notably, five of the top scorers are from Mumbai, with Borivili resident Iyer Sheshadri Ramakrishnan being one of them. Iyer appeared for the exam in the PCB group. The city of Pune registered the highest number of toppers, with seven students from the district securing top positions. Mumbai followed closely with five toppers, and Thane had three toppers on the list. The Maharashtra Common Entrance Test (MHT CET) is a statewide examination conducted for admission to undergraduate engineering, agriculture, and pharmacy programmes. This year witnessed a significant increase in registrations for the MHT CET exam, with a total of 6,36,089 candidates registering (3,33,041 in PCM and 3,03,048 in PCB group), surpassing the number of registrations from the previous year (6,05,944). Out of the total 5,91,130 candidates who appeared for the exam this year (3,13,730 for PCM and 2,77,400 for PCB group), 3,29,089 were male and 2,62,041 were female.

CYCLONE BIPARJOY BRIEFLY HITS FLIGHT OPERATIONS AT MUMBAI AIRPORT

Mumbai/New Delhi: Flight operations in Mumbai were affected last evening due to inclement weather conditions, with cyclone Biparjoy gushing over the Arabian Sea. Heavy rain and gusty winds pounded Mumbai as the intensity of cyclone Biparjoy, which has intensified into "extremely severe cyclonic storm", increased. Mumbai airport witnessed scenes of anxiety as some passengers waited for their flights for hours. A few flights were cancelled or delayed owing to the weather conditions. Some passengers took to Twitter to complain about the inconvenience. Air India late last evening put out a statement saying some of its flights running from Mumbai will be delayed due to bad weather and temporary closure of the runway.



The operations on runway 09/27 were moved to another runway due to the cross winds. "The agony as flight delays are equally troublesome for us. It is only under extremely uncontrollable situations we're compelled to make such changes in the schedule. We look forward to your kind understanding," Indigo tweeted responding to a passenger. FOOD DELIVERY AGENT KILLS NEIGHBOUR IN MUMBAI, COVERS BODY IN BEDSHEET, CONCEALS AT HOME



Police have arrested a 26-year-old man who allegedly killed his neighbour following an argument in Mumbai on Friday night. The accused, who worked as a food delivery agent, allegedly killed the man, later covered his body in a bedsheet and concealed it in the victim's house.

A 26-year-old man allegedly killed his neighbour following an argument and later covered his body in a bedsheet and concealed it in the victim's house in the Dharavi area of central Mumbai, police said on Monday.

The accused, identified as James Paul Kanaran, who worked as a food delivery agent, was arrested under relevant provisions of the Indian Penal Code (IPC), an official from the Shahu Nagar police station said.

The incident happened on Friday (June 9) and came to light on Sunday (June 11) when some people in the neighbourhood went to collect maintenance charges from the victim's house and noticed a foul smell emanating from his home, he said.

Subsequently, police were informed and the victim's decomposed body was found covered in a bedsheet in his own house, he said.

A probe revealed the victim had invited the accused for a drink at his house on Friday night and the latter allegedly attacked him following an argument, killing him on the spot, the official said.

NETIZENS REJECT ZOMATO'S APOLOGY, BOYCOTT ZOMATO TRENDS ON TWITTER

Apologising for unintentionally hurting sentiments, food delivery platform Zomato has removed its controversial ad that featured on World Environment Day. However, despite removing the objectionable advertisement, "#BoycottZomato" again started trending on Twitter on Friday morning.

Netizens have continued to slam Zomato for being casteist as the food aggregator depicted an actor, who played the Dalit character Kachra in the film "Lagaan" as items made of recycled waste.

Zomato's advertisement which has now been removed from YouTube and social media platforms had tried to draw a link between the character Kachra with 'kachra', the Hindi word for garbage.

The ad, aiming to show the food delivery company's recycling efforts, was termed "disgusting", "blatantly casteist", and "extremely insensitive" by netizens on Twitter. "Masaan" director Neeraj Ghaywan, filmmaker Madhurita Anand and Dalit historian Karunyakara Lella were among those who spoke out. "#Kachra from #Lagaan was one of the most dehumanised voiceless depictions of Dalits ever in cinema. @zomato has used the same character and made a repulsive #casteist commercial. A human stool? Are you serious? Extremely insensitive! you/bvdxVdEhJk-k

ATMS OF MULTINATIONAL FIRM TAMPERED IN 18 STATES, RS 2.53 CRORE WITHDRAWN: POLICE

FRAUDS CARRIED OUT IN MAHARASHTRA, ODISHA, CHHATTISGARH, MADHYA PRADESH, KARNATAKA, HIMACHAL PRADESH, PUNJAB, ASSAM AND 10 OTHER STATES.

Police have booked a group of unidentified persons for allegedly tampering with a multinational company's 200 white-label ATMs installed across 18 states, and fraudulently withdrawing Rs 2.53 crore from there.

Based on a complaint filed by the company, an FIR was registered against the accused at the Vanrai police station in Mumbai on Saturday. According to the FIR, the accused made 2,743 transactions with the help of 872 ATM cards to fraudulently obtain cash over three days, said police.

According to police, the first fraudulent ATM, the second person - also present at the transaction was carried out on October 12, 2022, ATN kiosk - would pull the electric wire or and it was reported to the company's corporate team in Goregaon. WOMAN KILLS MOTHER, STUFFS BODY IN SUITCASE, BRINGS IT TO POLICE STATION IN BENGALURU



A 39-year-old woman killed her mother in Bengaluru and stuffed her body in a suitcase. The accused, who is a physiotherapist and belongs to West Bengal, took the suitcase to a police station. She was arrested.

39-year-old physiotherapist in Bengaluru killed her mother, stuffed her body in a suitcase and walked into the police station in the city's Mico Layout area. The woman confessed to killing her mother because of regular arguments with her, the police said.

The accused, who is from West Bengal and resides in a flat in Bengaluru, was arrested after she brought the body-stuffed suitcase to the police station in the Mico Layout area.

Police said the accused was married and her husband was not at home at the time of the crime. The woman's mother-in-law was present in the house but she was unaware as the murder took place inside the room, they added.
