Then after a while they killed him by slitting his throat with a knife. The matter is of Lagere area. According to the information, the accused lover suspected that his girlfriend had an affair with another boy as well. Due to this, he carried out this dreadful incident of murder. According to the police, the deceased has been identified as 24-year-old Navya. She was a clerk in the police department. She had an affair with a young man named Prashant, a resident of Kanakpur, for the last 6 years. Both looked like brother and sister in the relationship.



The family members did not know about their affair. Meanwhile, Prashant suspected that Navya was having an affair with some other boy as well. Both of them argued many times about this matter. But still this doubt did not leave Prashant's mind. Due to which he made a plan to kill Navya.

Prashant thought why not kill Navya on her birthday itself. So he invited Navya to his house saying that he wanted to celebrate her birthday together. Navya agreed and came to his house. There Prashant had decorated the whole room nicely. Cake was cut, then killed. He first

got Navya to cut the birthday cake. Then brought a knife from the kitchen and killed him by slitting his throat. After committing the murder, he fled from there. On the other hand, when Navya did not reach home, her family members registered a missing case in the police station. When the police investigated, his last location was found at Prashant's house.

The accused was arrested. When the police reached Prashant's house, they found

Navya's dead body there. The dead body was immediately taken into custody and sent to Victoria Hospital. On the other hand, Prashant was searched and soon he was arrested.

## MUMBAI COURT ORDERS MAN TO PAY ₹1.25 LAKH AS MAINTENANCE TO ESTRANGED WIFE, SAYS, 'AMOUNT MUST MATCH LIFESTYLE'

**The wife is leading a "lavish lifestyle" and using credit cards and the parties belong to the "elite class" with a sound economic background, according to the arguments of both parties, Metropolitan Magistrate Komalsing Rajput said.**

Mumbai: The amount of maintenance must be such that the wife can maintain her standard of living, a Bandra magistrate's court noted and ordered a businessman to pay Rs.1.25 lakh every month to his estranged wife who has alleged domestic violence against him. The wife is leading a "lavish lifestyle" and using credit cards and the parties belong to the "elite class" with a sound economic background, according to the arguments of both parties, Metropolitan Magistrate Komalsing Rajput said. Court: Applicant shall leave her

lifestyle and lead a distressed life "It is not expected that merely because the main respondent (husband) is paying nothing, the applicant shall leave her lifestyle and lead a distressed life waiting for the mercy of the respondent," the court noted. The wife has no income but the husband, who is a businessman and is earning well from various sources, the court noted. However, he had not made any arrangement for her to earn a livelihood and thus it could be inferred that he has caused "economic violence", court noted. The couple had married in 1991

and have a son and a daughter, who are both now adults but are studying.



## CRIME BRANCH BEGINS PROBE INTO MARINE ENGINEER SUICIDE CASE

While the Saki Naka police initially took an accidental death report in the matter, the next month, Shrivastav's mother approached the police with a complaint following which an abetment to suicide case was registered against the woman. THE MUMBAI police crime branch has begun their probe in an abetment to suicide case in which a marine engineer jumped to death from the 12th floor of a building at Saki Naka in January. The family members of the deceased, identified as Harsh Shrivastav, had approached the Bombay High Court that agreed to a parents' plea to transfer the case to the Mumbai crime branch. A source said that the incident took place on January 20, when the 34-year-old jumped to death

from the 12th floor following an Accidental Death Report (ADR) had been taken by the local Saki Naka police. Next month, the police filed an abetment to suicide case against Shrivastav's fiancé based on the complaint given by his mother. The fiancé got anticipatory bail from the court and later the Saki Naka police filed a chargesheet against her. Shrivastav's parents then approached the HC seeking the case to be transferred to the crime branch earlier this month. A source said that since a chargesheet in the case has already been filed, the crime branch (unit X) has been asked to carry out further investigation in the matter.

## ON FUGITIVE AMRITPAL SINGH'S ARRIVAL IN AMRITSAR, TOP PUNJAB COP SAID...

There were reports that Amritpal Singh may visit Amritsar or Talwandi Sabo which forced Punjab Police stepped up its vigil in the city. Punjab Police on Friday said they don't have exact information of 'Waris Punjab De' chief Amritpal Singh's arrival in Amritsar at a time when Punjab marks the beginning of the harvesting season today. Commissioner of police, Amritsar, Naunihal Singh, directed anyone who is associated with the fugitive and has been declared 'wanted' in the case to surrender immediately. 'Waris Punjab De' Chief Amritpal Singh's poster put up by Punjab Police at the Amritsar Railway Station, stating that a suitable reward would be given to anyone who tells about his whereabouts and his name would be kept confidential, in Amritsar on Thursday. **launch of North Korea's 'most powerful' missile**

North Korea successfully launched a solid-fuel short-range missile 'Hwasong-18'. State media photos show North Korean leader watching the missile blast off.

State media hailed Thursday's launch, which led to a brief evacuation order in Japan, a "miraculous success". Solid-fuel missiles can be fired more quickly than liquid-fuel ones, making them harder to intercept. But analysts say they are not without downsides. South Korea maintains that the North will need more time to develop a fully operational solid-fuel ICBM. This is the first time the North has test-fired a solid-fuel ICBM after years of testing solid-fuel short-range missiles. It has tested various ICBMs, but these were powered by liquid propellants, which must be fuelled directly ahead of launch - a process that can take hours. Experts describe this as a breakthrough in Pyongyang's weapons programme, as solid-fuel ICBMs come ready-fuelled, and would therefore enable North Korea to strike the US with far less warning. South Korea's Defence Ministry on Friday said the technology is not new, and described North Korea's test on Thursday as a "middle step" in developing a full-fledged solid-fuel ICBM system.

# 13 KILLED AFTER BUS FALLS INTO A RAVINE OFF OLD MUMBAI-PUNE EXPRESSWAY

**There were a total of 41 passengers on the bus, of whom 27 have been rescued.**

At least thirteen people were killed and 20-25 were injured after a private bus ferrying members of a music troupe fell into a ravine off the old Mumbai-Pune Expressway near Khopoli on early Saturday morning. Most of the deceased were members of Bajji Prabhu Vadak Gat, a musical troupe that specialises in playing the cymbal – a percussion instrument. They were returning from Pune when the accident occurred around 4 am.



"There is a possibility that the accident may have occurred due to loss of control of the vehicle on the ghat. There were a total of 41 passengers in the bus, of whom 27 have been rescued. Teams from Khopoli, Khandala, local police, and highway police have helped in the rescue operation which is still underway. According to the information we have so far, 13 people have died," said Raigad Tanaji Chikhle, Superintendent of Police, HSP, said.

# MUMBAI: GUTSY WOMAN CATCHES PHONE THIEF AFTER CHASING HIM FROM JUHU TO ANDHERI

**The incident took place around 8 pm on Wednesday at the Kapaswadi bus stop in Juhu.**

27-year-old graphic designer chased a mobile phone thief from Juhu to Andheri after he fled with her phone, and eventually managed to catch him and hand him over to the police, reports from Mid-Day stated.

Nejal Shukla had left her workplace and was waiting for a bus to go to Santacruz railway station. While waiting for the bus, a man came on his bike and snatched her mobile phone and fled. After the theft took place, Shukla caught an auto rickshaw which was passing by, however, was not successful in catching the snatcher. She then requested a biker who

was passing by the auto for help. She sat pillion and requested the man to chase the biker, as per the report. Bike chase The duo chased the biker for seven minutes from Juhu to Andheri West, however they missed him as he escaped into a narrow lane. She requested the biker to take her to the police station to register a complaint. The accused was identified as Mohsin Mohamad Rafiq Khan, 25.

# WOMAN FINDS PERVERT MASTURBATING AT PAREL STATION, ACCUSED ESCAPES IN NEXT LOCAL; THE VIDEO SURFACED WHEN A WOMAN COMMUTER TOOK TO TWITTER TO COMPLAIN ABOUT THE OBSCENE BEHAVIOR OF THE MAN ON THE RAILWAY STATION PLATFORM.



In a shocking incident captured on camera, a man was seen masturbating on the platform of Parel railway station in Mumbai. What is more shocking is that the Railway Protection Force (RPF), despite taking cognizance of the case, has not assured any action against the pervert spotted by commuters, including women. The video surfaced when a woman commuter took to Twitter to complain about the obscene behavior of the man on the railway station platform. Tagging Mumbai police on Twitter along with the video of the man, she wrote: "I'd like to bring this to your notice, yesterday while returning home from work at Parel railway station a man was masturbating and the moment I could even think of calling the station police he caught the next local and went."

"Someone who openly masturbates in public, as this behavior may demonstrate a lack of regard for societal norms and boundaries. This could potentially indicate a higher risk for engaging in more serious and harmful acts, such as sexual assault," she further said. Another tweet by one Twitter user corroborated the said incident. Sharing the similar video of the man, the Twitter user wrote: "Hello @MumbaiPolice, this man was spotted at Parel railway station masturbating while looking at female passengers. The video was shot by one of my friends. Has Mumbai become unsafe for females now? This is horrible! Please act." RPF says not been able to track the pervert. As furious commuters tagged RPF and police on the video shared on social media, the RPF took to Twitter to respond. In its replies below the tweet, the RPF said: "Today, on 13/04/2023, a complaint was received from DSCR/BB through Twitter that a passenger was doing obscene acts on the platform of Parel station. As soon as the complaint was received, ASI NR Kumbhar along with the settlement staff Dinesh Jhodia at Parel station inspected the platform of Parel station." "The team investigated about the person who indulged in obscene acts in the station premises. But the said person was not seen anywhere."

# UP: 183 ENCOUNTERED SINCE MARCH 2017, ACTIVISTS POSE QUESTIONS

**THE UP POLICE DATA SHOWED THAT MORE THAN 10,900 POLICE ENCOUNTERS HAVE TAKEN PLACE IN THE STATE SINCE MARCH 2017, WHEN ADITYANATH TOOK OVER AS THE CHIEF MINISTER OF UTTAR PRADESH FOR THE FIRST TIME.**



**Lucknow:** With the killing of gangster-politician Atiq Ahmad's son Asad and his aide in Jhansi, the number of alleged criminals gunned down in police encounters in Uttar Pradesh has risen to 183 in the six years of Yogi Adityanath's government, officials said. The UP Police data showed that more than 10,900 police encounters have taken place in the state since March 2017, when Adityanath took over as the chief minister of Uttar Pradesh for the first time. In these encounters, 23,300 alleged criminals were arrested and 5,046 were injured. The number of policemen injured in them was 1,443 and 13 were killed, the data showed. Of the 13 policemen killed in encounters since March 2017, eight were ambushed in a narrow lane in a village in Kanpur district by the aides of notorious gangster Vikas Dubey. Dubey was shot dead by police when he tried to escape while being brought to UP from Ujjain in Madhya Pradesh. Police said Dubey's vehicle had overturned during the transit and he had snatched a policeman's gun. "As many as 183 criminals have been gunned down in police encounters in the state since March 20, 2017," Special Director General of Police (Law and Order) Prashant Kumar told PTI. However, the opposition parties and the critics of the government have alleged that many of these encounters were "fake" and demanded a high-level probe to bring out the facts. The UP government and the police have denied these allegations and said law and order has improved since the BJP came to power in 2017.

# MUMBAI: POLICE INSPECTOR CRUSHED TO DEATH AT VAKOLA



**A 43-year-old police inspector attached to the Marine Drive police station died when he was crushed between two buses at Vakola on Friday, a day before the accident took place. He had gone to Alibaug with his family and had then taken them to the Marine Drive police station. The Vakola police have arrested the bus driver whose vehicle dashed into another standing bus, crushing the inspector. Police Inspector Pravin Ashok Dinkar stayed with his family at T3 Building Kole-Kalyan Police Line at Santacruz East. According to the police, the accident took place on Friday at around 8 am opposite new modern school near Vakola Masjid bus stop. PI Dinkar was headed for Marine Drive Police Station and waiting for a bus at the bus stop.**

# TWITTER USERS CAN NOW SHARE TWEET AS LONG AS 10,000 CHARACTERS

**The decision to introduce 10,000-character-long tweets comes as Twitter is embroiled in a fight with popular subscription newsletter platform Substack.** Twitter now allows users to post tweets with up to 10,000 characters. Twitter now supports tweets up to 10,000 characters in length, "with bold and italic text formatting," the company informed. It is worth noting that the feature will be available to Twitter Blue subscribers. The Elon Musk owned platform announced the new feature before deleting all legacy Blue tick marks on April 20. In February, the micro-blogging platform introduced 4,000-character-long tweets for Blue subscribers. "Sign up for Twitter Blue to access these new features, and apply to enable Subscriptions on your account to earn income directly on Twitter. Tap on 'Monetization' in settings," said the Elon Musk-run company.
