

MUMBAI TO GET ITS FIRST OSC CENTER AT A WOMEN'S HOSPITAL FOR VIOLENCE SURVIVORS

The construction work for the OSC centre on the ground floor of Cama hospital has already begun. The centre is expected to start in the next six months and will have five beds that will be run in association with an NGO who will appoint qualified counsellors and lawyers to assist the survivors in distress.

TO ENSURE a safer and more comfortable environment for survivors of gender-based violence, Mumbai is set to get its first one-stop-crisis (OSC) centre inside a women's hospital at Cama and Abbess Hospital. Established under Centre's Nirbhaya Fund, OSC centres in crowded hospitals are often avoided by women survivors fearing stigma.

"When a woman is subjected to abuse, she is traumatised. In such a situation, she feels more secure in less crowded areas, amid other women. This is why Cama Hospital, which is dedicated only to women care, has been selected," said



superintendent Dr Tushar Palve. "It will be the first such centre in Mumbai to be started in a women's hospital," he added.

The construction work for the OSC centre on the ground floor of Cama Hospital has already begun. The centre is expected to start in the next six months and will have five beds that will be run in association with an NGO that will appoint qualified counsellors and lawyers to assist the survivors in distress. With this, it will be the third OSC centre in Mumbai. In 2019, the Union Women and Child Development minister inaugurated the state's most expensive OSC at Parel's KEM hospital. Later, the second one started at Jogheshwari Trauma Centre which caters to Mumbai sub-urban areas. Currently, the state has 37

OSC centres with an aim to provide a single point of contact for medical, legal, social, and psychological aid to women facing sexual and domestic abuse in each district across the country.

As [The Indian Express](#) reported earlier, due to low referrals and official apathy, the centres are not utilised to maximum. Data showed that per 110 registered rape cases, on an average annually, only one is referred to OSCs in Mumbai. Between 2020 and 2021, the city reported a total of 1,655 rape cases. Of these, just 16 or one per cent were attended to at the city's two OSCs, showed RTI applications.

Taking note of it, last year, the WCD held several internal meetings where district-wise data were analysed. "The data showed that OSCs in rural areas were performing better than the ones in cities. We also noticed that in OSCs that are located inside women's shelters or women's hospitals (like Amravati), more women approached the centres for help," said a senior officer from WCD.

Contractor shot dead by bike-borne miscreants in Khordha, probe launched

The miscreants opened three rounds of fire at Ramesh, leading to his death on the spot.

A young contractor was allegedly shot dead by two unidentified miscreants at Chandesar Square under Tangi police limits in Khordha district late Sunday night. The deceased has been identified as Ramesh Rout of Radhamohanpur.

According to reports, Ramesh along with two of his friends had been out for work when two miscreants on a motorbike intercepted the trio near Chandesar Square.

The miscreants opened three rounds of fire at Ramesh, leading to his death on the spot. The miscreants then fled the scene before locals could understand anything.

On being alerted, local police rushed to the spot and launched a manhunt to nab the miscreants. The reason behind the brutal murder was not known immediately. Meanwhile, his family members have demanded a thorough probe into the incident.

The deceased is survived by his wife and two children.

"He had gone out for some work. When we called him, he said that he was on his way back home. However, we were worried when he did not reach home. Later, we came to know that he was shot at by some miscreants. We rushed to the hospital only to find him dead," said the deceased's brother Sesadev.

KANDIVLI BOY YUVRAJ GUPTA EMERGES MAHARASHTRA TOPPER IN JEE ADVANCED 2023



MUMBAI: Kandivli boy Yuvraj Gupta (18) has emerged as Maharashtra topper in the JEE (Advanced) results announced on Sunday. With an all-India rank of 13 and a score of 315 out of 360, Yuvraj has his eyes set on the computer science engineering course at IIT-Bombay. While Gupta stood second in the IIT-Bombay zone, Ujwal Shankar, with an AIR of 11, topped the zone. Ujwal, also 18, is from Bengaluru. Aditi Singh, who secured AIR 104, is the topper among girls in the IIT-Bombay zone.

IIT-Bombay zone, which includes Maharashtra, Gujarat, Karnataka and Goa, had three candidates in the all-India JEE top 10 list year, but none this year. The performance of students in the zone has dropped marginally even in the top 100 and top 500 ranks, as compared to 2022. IIT-Delhi and IIT-Roorkee zones have bettered their performance from the previous year, when it comes to the top 10 ranks, with Roorkee producing two national toppers this year. JEE (A) 2023 organizing chairperson, Bishnupada Mandal, said the toppers' ranks' distribution also depends on the batch of students and from where they appear for the exam. "Often these students take coaching in the south or in Kota but appear for the exams from their hometowns. So the rank distribution differs," he said.

State topper Yuvraj, a student of Narayana e-Techno School in Marol, Andheri, had also cleared the second-level of the International Physics Olympiad. He was ranked 7th, but only five candidates were shortlisted for the final in Tokyo. He was also selected for the Asian Physics Olympiad in Mongolia but could not represent the country as the dates were clashing with JEE (A), said his mother Dr Anu Gupta. Both his parents are doctors -- father, an oral & maxilla facial surgeon and his mother, a dentist -- but he was always inclined towards mathematics and was keen on pursuing engineering. Gupta said his sole focus was JEE. Though, he spares some time for football and cricket. He is also an avid reader and loves to be surrounded by books on science and astronomy. IIT-Bombay zone topper Ujwal Shankar's parents and his sister, too, are doctors -- father a radiologist and the mother a gynaecologist. "My sister, too, got into medicine and is right now pursuing her internship."

CLASS 12 STUDENT STABBED TO DEATH BY FRIENDS OVER RS 1,000

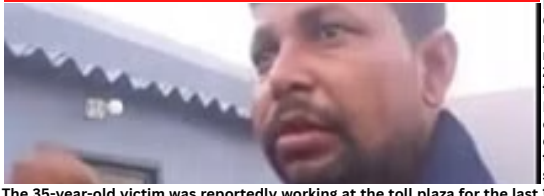

An FIR under IPC section 302 (murder) has been lodged in this connection.

Deepak Kumar Pandey, inspector of Gombi Nagar police station, said that the deceased was identified as Akash Kashyap, whose father Jagdish Kashyap runs a roadside eatery near Bhoonthnath market of Indira Nagar colony. He said that the two accused have been identified as Abhay Pratap Singh and Devansh Kumar. The incident happened at the room of their mutual friend Avansh Tiwari where a group of four friends were partying.

Akash reportedly had a verbal duel with Abhay over the phone in connection with the monetary issue. As per Abhay, Akash was not paying him back Rs 1,000 which he had borrowed. The police official said that Akash and Abhay, along with another friend Devansh, got together at Tiwari's place and there the verbal duel turned into a confrontation while the group was having drinks.

The cop said that the confrontation erupted again due to a conversation over the same issue. This time, Abhay turned violent. Akash was first beaten up with a baton and then stabbed multiple times with a kitchen knife, causing him fatal injuries. Later, Abhay and Devansh escaped from the room when the neighbour's turned up at Avansh's room. Akash was rushed to Ram Manohar Lohia Hospital, where he succumbed to his injuries on Sunday.

BIHAR CRIME: BOUNCERS THRASH ARRACH TOLL PLAZA GUARD TO DEATH ON SUSPICION OF STEALING ₹50, SHOCKING VIDEO EMERGES

In a shocking incident from Bihar, a native of Gonda in Uttar Pradesh working at the Kuhladiya toll plaza on the Arrah-Patna highway of Bhojpur district was thrashed by bouncers on the suspicion of stealing Rs 50. After beating the man badly, the accused bouncers put the victim on a train. The victim who was from Gonda district of Uttar Pradesh, identified as Balwant Singh, died due to the injuries while undergoing treatment in Gonda, his hometown. In a video shared on social media and Twitter, guard Balwant Singh is allegedly seen getting beaten and threatened by bouncers. "Take him back to the toll," one person can be heard saying in the video. The video showing the victim Balwant Singh beaten up by bouncers is said to be of Koilwar area. Koilwar is an area between Arrah and Patna districts. Police has taken note of the incident. OM RAUT'S OLD TWEET 'TROLLING' SRK'S 'FAN' GOES VIRAL AS 'ADIPURUSH' GETS PANNED ONLINE

The highly-anticipated movie 'Adipurush', starring Telugu superstar Prabhas, has made its worldwide theatrical release. Directed by Om Raut, this film, which includes Prabhas, Kriti Sanon, and Saif Ali Khan, premiered in 2D and 3D across various languages such as Telugu, Hindi, Tamil, Malayalam, and Kannada on June 16th.
