AMRITPAL SINGH STILL ON THE RUN: CENTRE ASKS BSF, SSB TO BE ALERT AT BORDER POSTS

IN OFFICER SAID A MESSAGE HAS BEEN SENT TO ALL UNITS OF THE BSF AND SSB ALONG WITH TWO PICTURES OF AMRITPAL – WITH AND WITHOUT HIS TURBAN.



The Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has asked the chiefs of the Border Security Force (BSF) and the Sashastra Seema Bal (SSB) to be alert in the border areas as there is a possibility that Waris Puniab De chief Amritpal Singh Sandhu might cross over the International Border in Punjab or via the India-Nepal border, it has been learnt.An officer said a message has been sent to all units of the BSF and SSB along with two pictures of Amritpal - with and without his turban. "It is reliably learnt that Amritpal Singh, the chief of a pro-Khalistan outfit, has been declared a fugitive by Punjab Police. There is a possibility that he crossed the India-Nepal border or International Border in Punjab.

They have been asked to be alert and to sensitise all personnel deployed in the bo The police had planned to arrest Amritpal at Mehatpur on the Jalandhar-Moga Road on Saturday. He, however, evaded them and sources said he left his vehicle and mobile phone near Nakodar. In a statewide crackdown, the police arrested 78 of his associates Saturday. The hunt for Amritpal continued for the second day with district police chiefs carrying out flag marches in major towns in Punjab and the state government extending internet suspension till Monday noon.rder posts," an officer said.

RS 35 CR FROM ABROAD, independent force of armed supporters in the name of Anandpur Khalsa Force (AKF), a senior official in an investigating agency, who did not wish to be identified, told The Indian Express.

A credit of at least Rs 35 crore from foreign countries over the last two years was found in the bank account of Daljit Singh Kalsi, a close aide of Waris Punjab De chief Amritpal Singh arrested from Gurugram, according to investigating agencies. Under scrutiny are also about two dozen mobile phone numbers from Pakistan from which calls were made or received on Kalsi's phone.

INVESTORS OF MORE THAN RS 68 LAKH



An offence has been registered against four persons of an investment company for allegedly cheating people of more than Rs 68 lakh in Maharashtra's Thane district, police said on Sunday.

A case under relevant provisions of the Indian Penal Code and Banning of Unregulated Deposit Schemes Act has been registered against four persons connected to Kalkaam Real Infra (India) Limited, an official from Thane police said.

At least 17 people had invested with the company and were promised 16 to 20 per cent returns in RDs and double the amount invested in 60

The victims had invested in the firm since 2013 and had not received any returns. The accused closed their offices and absconded, the official said, adding that no arrests have been made in the case.

Meanwhile, in an another case in Pune, the police on Saturday said that the Pune Police registered a case against a man for allegedly luring investors with a promise of big returns and cheating them to the tune of Rs 300 crore, an official said on Saturday.

MAHARASHTRA: FOUR BOOKED FOR CHEATING MAHARASHTRA: LAWYER ALLEGES FRAUD WHILE **BOOKING SERVICE AT YOGA FACILITY IN HARIDWAR**



A 32-year-old woman lawyer from Navi Mumbai who was looking to avail medical treatment at a Yoga facility in Haridwar lost Rs 32,300 while trying to book a service, police said on Sunday.

Police have registered a case against three unidentified persons under various sections of the Indian Penal Code for cheating and criminal intimidation and under the provisions of the Information Technology

A police official said the woman wanted to avail of medical treatment in Haridwar and came across a contact number while searching online. "She made a payment of Rs 10,000 and later transferred Rs 22,300 after she received a call saying her booking was not confirmed," he said.

When she received another call seeking payment of Rs 45,800 towards insurance, she realised something was fishy and sought a refund, he said.

"As she failed to get any reply for the refund request, she lodged a complaint with the police," the official said, adding that the

TWITTER DISABLES 2FA FOR NON-TWITTER BLUE HERE'S SUBSCRIBERS: HOW TO KEEP YOUR TWITTER ACCOUNT SAFE

TWITTER HAS DISABLED TWO-FACTOR AUTHENTICATION (2FA) USING SMS FOR NON-TWITTER BLUE SUBSCRIBERS FROM TODAY. HERE'S WHAT TO DO NEXT TO KEEP YOUR TWITTER ACCOUNT SAFE AND SECURE.

Twitter has disabled two-factor authentication (2FA) using SMS for non-Twitter Blue subscribers from today. The Elon Musk helmed company announced last month that from March 20, non-Twitter Blue subscribers will be unable to use text message/SMS for 2FA. Going forward, only Twitter Blue members will be able to use SMS method to keep their Twitter accounts safe. Twitter claimed that 2FA via SMS method was abused by bad actors, even though it is a popular and easy way to safeguard a Twitter account.

"After 20 March 2023, we will no longer permit non-Twitter Blue subscribers to use text messages as a 2FA method. At that time, accounts with text message 2FA still enabled will have it disabled," Twitter announced last month.

So if you are not a Twitter Blue subscriber and have 2FA enabled on your account using SMS, you will not be able to use it from today. Here's what to do next to keep your Twitter account safe and secure.

Twitter Blue subscription cost

The easiest way to get out of this problem is to subscribe to Twitter Blue which allows you to use 2FA using SMS along with features like a Blue Tick, Rank boost, ability to post longer videos in 1080p.

Twitter Blue subscription is priced at Rs 900 (monthly) and Rs 9,400 (annually).

1.Use Authentication app for Twitter 2FA

If you do not want to susbcribe to Twitter Blue, you can use an authentication app such as Google Authenticator, Authy, Duo Mobile, 1 Password and more. The app will generate an authentication code when you log in to Twitter. After based 2FA, using an authetication app is the easisest way to secure your account and is Ithe way we recommend.

RRR STAR JR NTR MAKES SHOCKING STATEMENT, REVEALS 'IF YOU... I'LL STOP DOING FILMS'

Telugu superstar Jr NTR, who is making the headlines recently for Naatu Naatu song's Oscars win recently attended the pre-release event for Vishwak Sen's film Ka Dhamki in Hyderabad and interacted with his fans. STRONG PROTEST FROM MEA AFTER PRO-**PROTESTERS** KHALISTAN **REMOVE** TRICOLOUR HIGH LONDON FROM COMMISSION

The MEA summoned deputy UK high commissioner Christina Scott late on Sunday and said that an 'explanation' was sought from the UK on the 'complete absence of the British security that allowed these elements to enter the High Commission premises.



On Sunday, March 19, India summoned a senior United Kingdom diplomat over the removal of the Indian flag atop the high commission building in London by pro-Khalistan protesters, accusing the UK of "indifference" to the security of Indian diplomatic premises.

Videos of pro-Khalistan protesters outside the Indian high commission in the UK had spread across social media. Amidst chants of Khalistan zindabad, a protestor climbed onto the flagpole above the door and brought down the Indian flag without any hindrance from any security personnel.

With the UK high commissioner Alexander W. Ellis travelling, his deputy Christina Scott was summoned to the Indian Ministry of External Affairs late on Sunday night.

Ahead of his colleague being summoned, Ellis posted on his official Twitter account that the "disgraceful acts" at India House in London were "totally unacceptable". Later, UK minister of state for the foreign commonwealth and development affairs, Tariq Ahmad tweeted that he was "appalled" at the attack and described it as a "completely unacceptable action against the integrity of the Mission and its staff". "The UK Government will always take the security of the Indian High Commission seriously," he wrote.

Unusually, the MEA had announced that a UK diplomat would be summoned in advance. "The senior most UK diplomat in New Delhi is being summoned," said the MEA spokesperson Arindam Bagchi on Sunday night.

OVER KHALISTAN SUPPORTERS DOWN THE TRICOLOUR AT THE **ANGER** PULLING MISSION IN LONDON

India has meanwhile registered its strong protest with the British government over the safety of its diplomatic mission and questioned the lack of sufficient security at the premises.



The pulling down of tricolour flying atop the Indian High Commission in London by pro-Khalistan protesters has infuriated people back home, with calls of strictest action against the culprits. A group of Khalistan supporters waved separatist flags and chanted pro-Khalistani slogans on Sunday as they grabbed India's national flag flying atop the mission in London, leading to an arrest related to the violent disorder. Shiv Sena (UBT) leader and Rajya Sabha member Priyanka Chaturvedi condemned the incident and said strictest action against the culprits needs to be taken by UK government.

"This is absolutely shameful, unacceptable and needs to be condemned strongly. Strictest action against the culprits being disrespectful to our tricolour & trespassing needs to be taken by UK Police& its Government," she tweeted. Congress MP Rajeev Shukla tweeted: "Highly condemnable incident. Culprits must be arrested by British police.'

Officials from the mission said the "attempted but failed" attack had been foiled and that the tricolour was now flying "grander", reported

Scotland Yard said it was called to reports of disorder on Sunday afternoon and that a man has been arrested as its enquiries continue. "There was no report of any injury, however windows were broken at the High Commission building," the Metropolitan Police statement

"Officers attended the location. The majority of those present had dispersed prior to the arrival of police. An investigation was launched, and one male was arrested nearby a short time later on suspicion of violent disorder. Enquiries continue," the statement said.

The external affairs ministry in New Delhi, meanwhile, summoned the senior-most British diplomat to lodge a protest after several videos on social media showed a Sikh man pulling down the flag outside the Indian mission in London. British deputy high commissioner Christina Scott was "reminded in this regard of the basic obligations of the UK Government under the Vienna Convention", said a statement from the external affairs ministry.
