

## PM MODI ASKED TO BAN ADIPURUSH, LODGE FIR AGAINST OM RAUT, MANOJ MUNTASHIR: HERE'S WHAT AICWA IS DEMANDING

The All Indian Cine Workers Association (AICWA), in an open letter to Prime Minister **Narendra Modi**, has demanded a ban on the screening of Adipurush. AICWA believes the movie, based on the Ramayana, "clearly" defames the image of Lord Ram and Lord Hanuman and hurts "religious sentiments of Hindus and Sanatan Dharma".

"Adipurush is a complete disaster of our faith in Shri Ram and Ramayan," it says.

While it does not demand any specific action against the actors of the movie, it says that

Prabhas, Kriti Sanon and Saif Ali Khan shouldn't have been part of "such a disgraceful movie ever made in the history of Indian Cinema",



The film portrays Lord Ram and Ravana in a manner that resembles video game characters, with dialogues that have caused offense to Indians both within the country and around the world, says AICWA in the letter. Prabhu Shri Ram, according to the association, holds a divine status for people of all religious backgrounds in India. In response to this, AICWA has urged Prime Minister Narendra Modi to intervene and take action to prevent the screening of the movie Adipurush in theatres and on OTT platforms in the future.

AICWA is also calling for an First Information Report (FIR) to be filed against director Om Raut, writer Manoj Muntashir Shukla and producers of the film.

The AICWA believes that the sentiments of Hindus have been deeply hurt by the portrayal and that immediate action is needed to protect the revered image of Bhagwan Shri Ram, Maa Sita, and the devoted Ramsevak Bhagwan Hanuman. AICWA is seeking to preserve the sacredness and reverence associated with these divine figures.

Om Raut's film Adipurush has faced widespread criticism, protests, and bans, resulting in a considerable decline in its performance at the Box Office. Monday, a crucial day for gauging a film's popularity, saw Adipurush only managing to **earn a meagre ₹20 crore in box office** collections. Prior to that, the movie managed to earn ₹340 over the weekend.

## INVESTORS IN GOREGAON COUPLE'S OTHER BUSINESS IN PANIC AFTER THEY FLEE

**Abandoning mystery Goregaon couple in drugs haul case also had a trading firm, which investors say was doing well; now, they are worried**

The alleged **masterminds** of the massive home-based drug distribution racket, the couple who fled their **Goregaon** home after transferring nearly Rs 174 crore of the alleged Rs 300 crore drug money into various accounts, have many investors worried. Ashesh Mehta is a stockbroker and many people have invested with his trading company.

Investors have been calling them since mid-day's reports on them but their phones are off.

While some who spoke to mid-day said they have regularly received returns on their investments, the

reports have made them panic. Some investors even went to Mehta's office, Bliss Consultants, at Goregaon, but found it locked, intensifying their worry.

The Mehtas are suspects in a home-based drug distribution racket being probed by the **Madhya Pradesh police**. The MP police have issued a lookout notice against them. Mehta and his wife Shivangi, run a trading company, Bliss Consultants, at We Work Oberoi Commerz II, International Business Park, Oberoi Garden City, Goregaon (East).

### 'Need some communication'

An investor said, "Ashesh is a stock trader, and some of us have our savings invested with his trading company, Bliss Consultants. Since 2019 their dealings have been excellent, straightforward, and transparent. There has never been any scope for speculation about anything criminal or suspicious. But we want some communication from them now."

Another investor added, "We were getting our profit on time, not once or twice, but for the past five years. They are unreachable so we are worried about what will happen to our investment amount. They should inform us at least how many days we have to wait."

Investors said the couple has been very prompt in all their financial dealings. This is the prime reason why their company has even attracted investors from overseas.



### Mumbai: Man slits woman's throat while travelling in auto rickshaw in Sakinaka, held

A Mumbai Police official said that a quarrel between the two started while they were in an auto-rickshaw. During the argument, the suspect slit her throat and then fled away from the crime scene.

A 30-year-old woman was allegedly killed by a man while the two were travelling in an auto rickshaw in the Sakinaka area of Mumbai, a police official said on Monday. According to the police, the incident came to light on Monday evening. The murder took place at Khairani Road in the Sakinaka area. The suspect in the murder case and the victim were travelling by an auto-rickshaw and began to argue with each other.

The police said that the quarrel between them started while they were in an auto rickshaw. During the argument, the suspect slit her throat and then fled away from the crime scene.

The police were informed about the incident and a team of police officials immediately rushed to the spot. The deceased has been identified as Panchashila Jamdar, 30, a resident of Sangharshnagar area in Chandivali, Sakinaka, an official said.

"The team of police officials investigating the matter have nabbed the suspect in the case and further investigations in the case are underway," the official said. He said that the suspect slit the throat of Panchshila Jamdar inside a moving auto rickshaw. She got out of the vehicle.

### GRANT ROAD MURDERS: POLICE FILE 374-PAGE CHARGE SHEET IN CASE

The document uses 72 eyewitness statements, CCTV footage from neighbourhood and mobile phone video footage of witnesses to make an iron-clad case against the man who murdered 3 neighbours

A 374-page charge sheet has been submitted by **DB Marg police** station regarding a triple murder case that occurred at Parvati Mansion in **Grant Road** on March 24. Police said the accused assumed his family had abandoned him because of their neighbours, whom he later killed. The charge sheet also states that the accused had previously quarrelled with the deceased and had issued death threats to them. The charge sheet, presented to **Killa Court**, includes testimonies from 72 witnesses, as well as CCTV footage and videos captured by local residents. As part of the investigation, the police have also recorded a statement from the accused, Chetan Gala's wife, who acted as a witness. The accused attacked five of his neighbours, resulting in the deaths of three. The remaining two victims provided statements to the police after making a recovery. The charge sheet further reveals that the accused had previously issued death threats to the victims, and non-cognisable complaints were filed with the police, which now form part of the evidence. The crucial statement provided by Gala's wife also discloses that he exhibited a hyperactive sexual drive and would forcibly engage in physical relations, leading to frequent arguments between them and eventually resulting in their separation. The incident occurred following a heated argument between the husband and wife, who subsequently left; the accused went on a rampage, attacking five of his neighbours. Gala has been charged with murder and attempted murder.

### MUMBAI: WOMAN SUFFERS SKIN BURNS AFTER FACIAL, FIR REGISTERED AGAINST SALON

In a shocking turn of events, a local beauty salon came under scrutiny after a customer filed a First Information Report (FIR) against the salon.

According to the complainant, fake beauty products may have been used in the treatment, causing her skin burns and irreversible facial damage.

The complainant (name not revealed) visited the Glow Luxe salon at Andheri's Kamdhenu Shopping Centre on June 17 for a HydraFacial treatment worth Rs 17,500. However, what should have been a relaxing experience turned into a nightmare, leaving her with skin burns and permanent damage. A HydraFacial treatment is an in-office medical treatment that focuses on resurfacing the skin and removing impurities while soothing your skin.

Following the therapy, the woman encountered a sensation of intense



heat and sought assistance from a dermatologist, who informed her that she had incurred burns on her skin and irreversible damage as a result of the massage. Subsequently, she enlisted the support of Prashant Rane, a local MNS corporator, to file a First Information Report (FIR).

A complaint has been lodged by the Andheri police in this case, and they are further investigating the case.

After the incident unfolded, several netizens expressed their experiences on social media and demanded that strict regulations be put in place to prevent such incidents from occurring. The incident has sparked a broader discussion

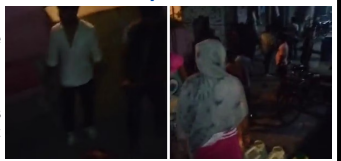

## KEJRIWAL WRITES TO L-G OVER SPURT IN CRIMES, SAYING 'NOTHING CHANGED ON THE GROUND DESPITE'

Kejriwal stressed the need to increase police patrolling, especially during night hours, and urgent engagement with the residents of Delhi on the matter.

Delhi chief minister Arvind Kejriwal has proposed a Cabinet meeting with lieutenant governor Vinai Kumar Saxena on the law and order situation in view of recent murders in the national capital. In a scathing letter addressed to Saxena, Kejriwal expressed deep concern and report which was made public last year, highlighted the need for immediate and effective measures to restore the faith of Delhi's residents in their safety and security. Referring to the recent murders that have sent shockwaves through the city, the chief minister stressed that the repeated occurrence of such serious crimes has eroded public confidence and called for a swift response to fulfill the obligations entrusted to those responsible for maintaining law and order.



"Though I am of the firm opinion that the latest National Crime Records Bureau (NCRB) report which was made public last year, should have served as an eye-opener for the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) and the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor, both of whom are directly responsible for maintenance of home ministry, is responsible for law enforcement in the national capital. It did not happen," the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) chief said. Citing the NCRB data, Kejriwal said 32.20 percent of total crimes against women in 19 cities. He alleged that nothing changed on the ground despite the need for urgent preventive steps on crimes against women.

According to the police official, a case under sections 498-A, (husband or relative of husband of a woman subjecting her to cruelty), 323 (voluntarily causes hurt), and other relevant provisions under the Indian Penal Code were registered against the duo on Monday.

The complainant, a resident of Ghansoli, has alleged that her husband and mother-in-law demanded Rs 1 crore from her to purchase an apartment, a police official from Rabale police station said. "The complainant's husband also allegedly threatened to set her on fire and kill her," the police official said. "The woman was also abused and physically tortured. No arrest has been made in this regard so far, he added.

## DARSHANA PAWAR DEATH: MULTIPLE INJURIES ON BODY POINT TO MURDER, SAY POLICE



According to police, the body of Darshana was found in a partially decomposed state at the foothills of the fort in Velhe taluka of Pune district. The police in Pune has confirmed that the death of 26-year-old Darshana Pawar, who had recently qualified for the state forest services and whose body was found on Sunday at Rajgad Fort, a popular tourist and trekking spot, was a case of murder. They have also stepped up their search to locate her 25-year-old friend who, they believe, is a missing link in the case.

"The post-mortem report has confirmed that the deceased, Darshana, was murdered. Multiple injuries, along with evidence of a head injury, have been found on her body. A probe is on to identify the killer and motive behind the murder. As of now, an offense of murder under section 302 of the Indian Penal Code is being registered against the unidentified accused," Assistant Police Inspector Manoj Pawar, of Velhe police station, said.

According to police, the body of Darshana was found in a partially decomposed state at the foothills of the fort in Velhe taluka of Pune district. The recovery came days after she and her friend — identified as Rahul Handore — were reported missing in separate police complaints lodged by their families last week. Police are currently searching for Handore.

Darshana, the daughter of a driver at a sugar mill in Ahmednagar, had recently cleared the Maharashtra Public Service Commission (MPS) exam for the post of Range Forest Officer (RFO). Her friends and teachers described her as a "studious student" who had been preparing for various competitive exams for a while before finding success in the state forest services exam.

According to police, Darshana reached Pune on June 9, stayed with a woman friend in Pune's Narhe area, and attended the academy's felicitation. Darshana later informed her parents that she was visiting Sinhgad Fort on June 12, police said. She told the female friend, with whom she was staying, that she was going trekking at Rajgad and Sinhgad forts. But since then, police said, the families of both could not reach them over the cell phone. With police locating their last call location at Velhe, Darshana's cellphone was found at the foothills of Rajgad Fort — about 35 km from Sinhgad Fort

Mumbai Police has filed a case against Taarak Mehta Ka Ooltah Chashmah producer Asit Kumarr Modi. However, no arrests have been made yet.

The Powai Police has registered a case against Asit Kumarr Modi under sections 354 and 509 (Assault or criminal force to a woman with intent to outrage her modesty) of the Indian Penal Code (IPC). However, no arrests have been made yet.

Meanwhile, an actress in the popular sitcom Taarak Mehta Ka Ooltah Chashmah had earlier left the show. Following her exit after 15 years, she made serious allegations of mental and sexual harassment against the show's producer, Asit Kumarr Modi. She filed a complaint against producer Modi, Project Head Sohail Ramani, and executive producer Jatin Bajaj for alleged sexual harassment at the workplace.

## MUMBAI NEWS: ALLEGED POSTING OF BOGUS DOCTORS AT MULUND HOSPITAL LEADS TO 149 HEART ATTACK DEATHS IN 9 MONTHS; 3 HELD

A man named Sushant Ramchandra Jadhav was arrested recently. Sources revealed that Jadhav has a certificate of Bachelor of Homeopathy Medicine and Surgery (BHMS).

The police have arrested a 30-year-old man for posing as a doctor with bogus certificates at MT Agarwal Hospital in Mulund. This is the first arrest in the past month after an FIR was registered against Jeevan Jyot Trust (a social welfare organisation managing the hospital) and six persons for allegedly posting unqualified doctors at the hospital. The complainant in the FIR, Goldy Sharma, alleged that in an RTI reply received by him, it has been revealed that almost 149 deaths were recorded in the hospital's ICU in a span of nine months — from Feb 17 to Nov 22, 2018. The cause of death is listed as heart attack. In his statement to the police, he said that he started keeping track of the hospital's activities after the death of his brother Balkumar Sharma, in the ICU, on June 4, 2019.

**Bogus death certificates**  
The Free Press Journal was the first to report about the previous two arrests in the case. The report published on June 3 mentioned that a man named Chandrasekhar Bhularam Yadav, 32, was arrested by the Mulund police for allegedly issuing several death certificates that were bogus in nature. Yadav claimed to be a doctor with a Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) degree from China. On June 2, a woman was arrested, identified as Surekha Chavan, 34; she worked at the trust as a coordinator. Police sources informed the FPJ that Chavan, like Yadav, issued bogus death certificates.
