

ANTI-MODI POSTERS IN CAPITAL: 44 FIRS, 4 ARRESTS

AT LEAST 2,000 POSTERS WERE REMOVED AND 2,000 MORE SEIZED AFTER A VAN WAS INTERCEPTED.



The Delhi Police has registered 44 FIRs and arrested four persons, including two printing press owners, after posters including some seeking the ouster of Prime Minister Narendra Modi ('Modi hatao, desh bachao'), were found pasted on walls and poles in several areas of the Capital. At least 2,000 posters were removed and 2,000 more seized after a van was intercepted. Special Commissioner of Police (Law and Order of Northern Zone) Dependra Pathak told The Indian Express that police intercepted a van in I P Estate when it was coming from the AAP headquarters on DDU Marg and arrested a man.

"The arrested man disclosed that he was asked by his employer to deliver the posters at AAP's headquarters and that he had made a delivery a day earlier as well. We have arrested two other men and further investigations are on," Pathak said. There was no immediate response from the AAP. According to police, two printing press firms were given orders for 50,000 such posters each, and workers linked to the companies passed several of them from late Sunday night to Monday morning. The owners have been arrested for not publishing the names of their printing press on the posters. The incident comes two years after Delhi Police arrested 30 people and lodged 25 FIRs over a similar incident of posters with remarks critical of Modi during the Covid vaccination drive. According to police, 20 FIRs in the latest incident were registered in the Northwest district, six in North and five in West, apart from three each in Shahdara and Dwarka, two each in Central, Northeast and East,

PUNJAB POLICE SHARES 7 LOOKS OF AMRITPAL SINGH, SUSPECTS HE MIGHT HAVE CHANGED APPEARANCE



As the Khalistani leader and fugitive Amritpal Singh is still on the run even after four days of manhunt, Punjab Police on Tuesday released a set of possible avatars that he could've adopted to evade arrest. In the hope that people could help identify and spot Amritpal Singh, the police have released seven different pictures, where he can be seen donning clean shaved or bearded looks and different turbans and guises. Cops suspect that Amritpal Singh might have changed his appearance and these photos will help people identify him even in a different appearance from the one he had when he escaped. "There are several pictures of Amritpal Singh in different attires. We are releasing all of these pictures. I request you display them so that people can help us to arrest him in this case," said Punjab IGP Sukhchain Singh Gill. Earlier today, Punjab Police arrested four people who helped Amritpal Singh escape. Amritpal Singh, the self-styled chief of Waris Punjab De, has been declared a fugitive after he gave cops the slip on Saturday after an intense car chase through Jalandhar district. According to sources, after changing vehicles, Amritpal Singh fled on a motorcycle. He also changed his clothes, and turban and covered his beard with a cloth.

11 KILLED, OVER 100 INJURED AS 6.5 QUAKE RATTLES PAKISTAN, AFGHANISTAN: UPDATES



Pakistan- Afghanistan Earthquake: At least 11 people died in the two countries and more than 100 people were injured in Pakistan. A magnitude 6.5 earthquake struck Pakistan and Afghanistan on Tuesday, panicking residents who were seen fleeing from homes and offices. At least 11 people died in Afghanistan and Pakistan, Associated Press reported. More than 100 people were brought to hospitals in the Swat valley region of Pakistan, a spokesman for Pakistan's emergency services informed. These terrified people collapsed, and some of them collapsed because of the shock of the earthquake," the spokesperson said. The earthquake was centred in Afghanistan. It was also felt in bordering Tajikistan and triggered landslides in some of the mountainous areas, Associated Press reported. Pakistan media reports suggested cracks had appeared in some apartment buildings in Islamabad. Sharafat Zaman Amar, Taliban's appointed spokesman for the public health ministry said that at least two people died and around 20 others were injured. He said "Unfortunately, there could be more casualties as the quake was so powerful, in most parts of the country."

DELHI BUDGET 2023 LIVE: AAP GOVT ALLOCATES ABOUT ₹16,500 CRORE FOR EDUCATION

THE DELHI BUDGET IS BEING PRESENTED IN THE STATE ASSEMBLY ON WEDNESDAY, A DAY AFTER BEING APPROVED BY THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS WHICH HAD ASKED THE KEJRIWAL GOVERNMENT TO RESUBMIT THE BUDGET OVER CERTAIN CLARIFICATIONS.

The Delhi budget is being presented by finance minister Kailash Gahlot in the Delhi assembly on Wednesday. This comes a day after the ministry of home affairs (MHA) approved the Delhi government's budget, a day after 'stalling' it, as alleged by the Arvind Kejriwal government. MHA had asked the National Capital government to resubmit the budget over clarifications regarding allocation of funds for infrastructure and advertisements.

Amid the fresh flashpoint between the Centre and the Delhi government, chief minister Kejriwal Tuesday had written a letter to Prime Minister Narendra Modi, requesting him not to stop the city government's budget.

The budget requires approval from the President through the Union home ministry.

Delhi budget 2023: 350 Delhi govt schools to get 20 computers each, tablets for faculty

As part of budget 2023, 350 Delhi government schools will get 20 computers each, while all teachers, principals, vice- principals will get tablets, announced finance minister Kailash Gahlot.

AAP govt allocates about ₹16,500 crore for education

With an increase of about over ₹200 crore compared to last year, AAP government has allocated about ₹16,500 crore for education sector in 2023 budget.

LOOKOUT CIRCULAR, NON-BAILABLE WARRANT AGAINST PUNJAB KHALISTANI LEADER

Chandigarh: Punjab Police have issued a lookout circular (LOC) and non-bailable warrant (NBW) against 'Waris Punjab De' chief Amritpal Singh, the fugitive Khalistani leader.

Addressing a press conference, Inspector General of Police (Headquarters), Punjab Sukhchain Singh Gill said that Amritpal Singh has not been arrested yet.

"We are making all efforts to arrest him. We're hopeful that we'll arrest him soon...It is difficult to say that. Punjab Police is receiving full cooperation from other states and central agencies," the IGP said.

"A lookout circular (LOC) and non-bailable warrant (NBW) have been issued against Amritpal Singh, who remains a fugitive and efforts are being made to arrest him," said the Information and Public Relations Department Punjab government.

As part of its efforts to arrest Amritpal Singh, Punjab Police released his pictures on Tuesday.

IGP Gill requested people to help them in Amritpal's arrest.

"There are several pictures of Amritpal Singh in different attires. We are releasing all of these pictures. I request you display them so that people can help us to arrest him in this case," said Punjab Inspector General of Police (IGP) Sukhchain Singh Gill.

One of the pictures shows Amritpal Singh as clean-shaven.

According to a preliminary probe, police said he visited a gurdwara in Jalandhar district while on the run and escaped on a motorcycle after changing clothes.

According to CCTV visuals, Amritpal Singh was seen escaping in an SUV in Jalandhar on March 18. He is still on the run.

He was asked if Amritpal Singh had fled to any other state.

"In the preliminary investigation, it was found that they went to Gurdwara Sahib in Nangal Ambian where Amritpal changed his clothes and they escaped on two motorcycles. Teams are working, further investigation is underway.

Nashik: The murder of a three-month-old baby in Nashik has taken a shocking turn. The police investigation revealed that the birth mother killed the girl. The ground shifted under everyone's feet as it came to light that the birth mother killed the girl by slitting her throat after getting tired of being tortured by her father-in-law. Dhruvanshi Rokade, a three-year-old girl, was strangled to death in the Dhruvnagar area of Nashik. This murder caused a stir in the city. Who could be the enemy of a three-month-old child? Such a question was raised. The Women's Commission also expressed great doubt about this.

In the investigation of the three-month-old baby, shocking information has come to light. The mother-in-law killed her daughter by slitting her throat after getting tired of being tortured by her father-in-law.

The unknown woman had faked her death by strangling her unconscious. However, when the police investigated the matter with great enthusiasm, it was found that the mother of the murdered girl, suspect Yukta Rokade, had killed her daughter.

As the in-laws are torturing the mother because the daughter went to her father and got well, it is revealed that the mother killed the unborn daughter by slitting her throat, creating hatred towards the daughter. After checking the situation at the spot and the CCTV footage of the surrounding area, the police suspected that the mother was faking it.

Accordingly, when the police investigated the case on the basis of the mother's WhatsApp chat and other information, it came to light that the birth mother herself had killed her daughter and this incident has created excitement in the city.

PUTIN SAYS CHINESE PROPOSAL COULD BE BASIS FOR PEACE IN UKRAINE

Russian President Vladimir Putin said after talks with Chinese leader Xi Jinping on Tuesday that Chinese proposals could be used as the basis of a peace settlement in Ukraine, but that the West and Kyiv were not yet ready.

In a joint statement issued at the end of Xi's state visit to Moscow, the two men cautioned against any steps that might push the Ukraine conflict into an "uncontrollable phase", adding pointedly that there could be no winners in a nuclear war.

Putin accused Western powers of fighting "to the last Ukrainian", while Xi reiterated China's "neutral position" on Ukraine and called for dialogue. "We believe that many of the provisions of the peace plan put forward by China are consonant with Russian approaches and can be taken as the basis for a peaceful settlement when they are ready for that in the West and in Kyiv. However, so far we see no such readiness from their side," Putin said.

China's proposal - a 12-point paper calling for a de-escalation and eventual ceasefire in Ukraine - lacks details on how to end the war.

The United States has been dismissive of the Chinese proposal, given Beijing's refusal to condemn Russia over Ukraine, and says a ceasefire now would lock in Russian territorial gains and give Putin's army more time to regroup.

Kyiv has welcomed China's diplomatic involvement but says Russia must pull its troops out of Ukraine, and underlines the importance of Ukraine's territorial integrity.

The Kremlin talks were intended to cement the "no limits" partnership the two leaders announced last February, less than three weeks before Russia invaded Ukraine.

They signed a series of documents on a "strategic cooperation" after what Putin described as "successful and constructive" talks showing China was clearly now Russia's most important economic partner.
