NAGPUR A 40-year-old man was arrested on Friday for allegedly raping a 77-year-old paralysed woman at a private nursing home in Nagpur on Wednesday.

The accused, identified as Deepak Thakre, 40, is a friend of her adopted son and had gone to the hospital to meet him. Deepak offered to stay with her in the hospital room while his friend stepped out to get medicines.

When a nurse entered the room by opening its latched door, she saw that he was sexually assaulting the elderly woman who lay unconscious.

The nurse raised an alarm and the hospital staff got hold of the accused and handed him over to the police. The Dhantoli police booked the accused under section 376 (rape) of the Indian Penal Code. "The survivor is being provided medical as well as psychological support," informed Pravawati Ekurkey, the police inspector of Dhantoli police station. The woman, a retired government servant, suffered a paralytic attack three days ago.

Washington: The US Supreme Court on Friday temporarily preserved access to a widely used abortion pill, freezing rulings by lower courts that would have banned or severely restricted availability of the drug.

Two conservative justices disagreed with the decision in the most significant abortion case to reach the nine-member court since it overturned the constitutional right to the procedure 10 months ago. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the decision by the

nation's highest court means that mifepristone, which accounts for more than half of the abortions in the United States, will remain available while the case plays out in an appeals court.

The Justice Department of President Joe Biden had filed an emergency appeal asking the Supreme Court to block the lower court rulings that would have banned or limited use of mifepristone.

The case stems from a ruling by a US District Court judge in Texas, in a lawsuit brought by anti-abortion groups, that would have banned mifepristone, which was approved by the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) in 2000.

An appeals court blocked a ban on the pill, but imposed tough restrictions on access, after which the baton was handed to the Supreme Court, where conservatives wield a 6-3 majority.

The Supreme Court decision effectively freezes the lower court rulings pending the an appellate court hearing of the appeal from the Justice Department and mifepristone manufacturer Danco Laboratories.

Reacting to the Supreme Court move, Biden said the lower court decisions "would have undermined FDA's medical judgment and put women's health at risk.'

"As a result of the Supreme Court's stay, mifepristone remains available and approved for safe and effective use while we continue this fight in the courts," Biden said in a statement. "I will continue to fight politicallydriven attacks on women's health." · 'Deeply misguided' -

OMICRON VARIANT DRIVING SURGE IN MAHARASHTRA MORE FATALITIES, INCLUDING 10 RECONCILED B)

India has reported 12,193 new Covid Cases over the last 24 hours. With the surge, the country now has 65,556 active cases.

The death toll due to the viral disease has climbed to 5.31.300 with 42 more fatalities, including 10 reconciled by Kerala, according to the ministry's data updated at 8 am.

Besides, data released on Friday revealed that the XBB.1.16 is the dominant variant of Omicron that was driving the case surge in Maharashtra.

Here are key updates related to the virus.

- Maharashtra on Friday reported 993 Coivd cases and five deaths, which took the tally to 81,60,499 and the toll to 1,48,497, a health official said. 681 cases were caused by the XBB.1.16 dominant variant of the virus, and five persons succumbed. Mumbai and Pune recorded two deaths each while the fifth fatality was in Nagpur, a PTI report said.
- Of the 1,348 fresh coronavirus cases recorded in Haryana, over 50% were reported from Gurugram and Faridabad, combined. They have been fuelling the current surge in infections in the state.
- Among other Haryana districts, Rohtak and Jind reported 89 cases each while Hisar, Panchkula and Jhajjar reported 68, 59 and 55 cases, respectively, according to the bulletin released on Friday.
- The Centre on Friday asked eight states including Uttar Pradesh, Tamil Nadu and Maharashtra to maintain a strict watch and take preemptive action in any area of concern to control any emerging spread of Covid 19.
- A rise in positivity rate has also been noted across the country, with
