

MUMBAI WOMEN PERFORM YOGA WEARING TRADITIONAL MAHARASHTRIAN SAREES

The yoga session was organised at Gateway of India in Mumbai on International Yoga Day. The International Yoga Day is being celebrated across the world today, with people coming out in huge numbers to perform yoga. A video from Mumbai has surfaced on social media that shows a group of women performing yoga in nauvari sarees at Gateway of India. The video has been posted on Twitter by news agency ANI and shows young girls wearing the traditional Maharashtrian saree and participating in the programme. International Yoga Day was first observed in 2015 and is being celebrated in full swing every year since then. The ANI video shows the women beginning the yoga session with 'Om' chanting. They are seen sitting comfortably in 'Sukhasana' with their



eyes closed. It then cuts to the participants performing some stretching before beginning the yoga session. As the video progresses, a yoga trainer is seen performing a variation of Paschimottasana (seated forward bend) - a pose useful in reducing the risk of complications related to diabetes.

The women are also seen performing Bhujangasana (cobra pose) and other poses while wearing sarees.

Nauvari (also known as Kasta Sari, Kacha, Sakachcha, Lugade) is a nine yards saree worn by women in Maharashtra. The name 'nauvari' originated from the saree's length of nine yards.

The style of drape for nauvari has evolved drastically from the traditional style to the modern-age cult and is draped in such a way that it gives a trouser-dress like an appearance, while the sari is tucked at the back.

Nauvari sarees usually come in cotton and is worn in most of the Maharashtra or Marathi dance forms.

Nauvari sarees are extremely popular in Bollywood and many actresses have worn it in various films.



Mumbai-Goa Vande Bharat ticket price is likely to be comparable to airfare

Mumbai-Madgaon Vande Bharat Express is expected to be flagged off on June 27 with fares for Executive Chair (EC) car comparable to airfare for the Mumbai-Goa journey.

The tentative fares for the EC chair car are ₹2,915 and ₹1,435 for the CC. The airfares from Mumbai-Goa range from ₹1,800 to ₹2,100 depending on the airline and time of the flight. "We are yet to receive final notification for the flag off of the express, though it is most likely."

At least 14 injured after elevator collapses in Mumbai's Kamala Mills compound

According to BMC officials, there were 14 people on board the elevator - out of which nine people have been hospitalised.

At least 14 people were injured after an elevator collapsed from the fourth floor to the ground floor in the Trade World Tower C at Mumbai's Kamala Mills compound at around 10:45 on Wednesday morning. Reportedly, the building is a ground-plus 16-storey structure.

According to the Brihamumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) officials, there were 14 people on board the elevator - out of which nine people have been hospitalised. The building's security staff rescued all those inside the lift and sent them to nearby hospitals.

Officials informed that while eight people have been sent to the Global Hospital, one person has been admitted to KEM Hospital. Meanwhile, the remaining four people who received minor injuries refused hospitalisation. Currently, all the injured patients are stable, said officials.

PRETERM INFANT IN NAGPUR SURVIVES 3 CARDIAC ARRESTS IN 90 DAYS

NAGPUR: A three-month preterm baby survived three cardiac arrests in three months while being treated for respiratory distress likely caused by the rare cytomegalovirus (CMV) infection at the neonatal intensive care unit (NICU) of Government Medical College and Hospital (GMCH), Nagpur.

Thanks to special care and intense monitoring by the NICU team, the baby recovered and was discharged recently. The baby was put on ventilator for two weeks with both her lungs severely infected due to viral pneumonia.

Another two-and-a-half-month preterm baby with similar respiratory illness needed 20 days on CPAP (continuous positive airway pressure) machine, a step-down equipment compared to the ventilator. This baby too recovered after a 75-day stay in the NICU.

Preterm babies in NICU can be either congenitally CMV infected or they can acquire infection after birth.

Given the shortage of resources and drug procurement delays, GMCH doctors relied on point of care lung ultrasound in both cases for precise diagnosis.

GMCH Nagpur is one of the few medical colleges in the state to have the high-end ultrasound equipment for babies.

"Broad spectrum anti-biotics were not resolving the baby's condition, as shown by the lung ultrasound. She was on ventilator for two weeks. Next step was to go for CMV test. As it is not available right now, we took parents' consent to start glanciclovir injection. Within a week, the baby responded to the treatment and was weaned off the ventilator," said Dr Abhishek

ACCUSED THREW TWO MOBILE PHONES, 4 SIMS USED IN CRIME INTO MITHI RIVER: POLICE

MUMBAI: The main accused in the actress Chrisann Pereira framing case, Anthony Paul, destroyed two mobile phones and four SIM cards, which he allegedly used in the crime, and threw them into Mithi river at Dahisar, the Mumbai Crime Branch has claimed in the chargesheet filed in the case on Wednesday.

Mumbai, India - April 24, 2023: The crime branch on Monday arrested a Borivali resident Anthony Paul and detained his associate Rajesh Babhote alias Ravi for allegedly framing a 27-year-old actor Chrisann Pereira (in pic) into becoming a drug mule. The actor worked in some of the noted films like Sadak-2 and Batla House. Chrisann was given the trophy before boarding the flight (HT Photo) (Hindustan Times)

The chargesheet stated that the trio of Paul, a Malad-based baker, and his associates, Rajesh Bobhate alias Ravi, and Shantilal Rajput, framed Pereira and four others by planting drugs in trophy and cakes and handed over to them while leaving for Sharjah.

The Sadak-2 actress was arrested on April 1 after she landed at Sharjah airport as Paul had tipped-off the authorities there that she was part of an international drug syndicate.



The police have also attached audio recordings of mobile conversations between the victim's family members and the accused baker wherein he has been demanding money to get Periera released. In all, 20 witnesses are cited in the case including a few family members of the victim. There is other evidence like the CCTV footage from Mumbai airport showing the accused handing over the trophy, in which drugs were hidden, to Pereira, who was about to take a flight to Sharjah.

Paul brought drugs from Rajput claiming that he required it as one of his relatives was suffering from jaundice. The accused brought 500 grams of ganja for ₹6,000 from Rajput in December 2022.

NAVI MUMBAI CRIME: WOMAN, SON BOOKED FOR DOWRY HARASSMENT

An offense has been registered in **Navi Mumbai** against a mother-son duo for allegedly harassing the latter's wife and demanding Rs 1 crore from her.

An offense has been registered in **Navi Mumbai** against a mother-son duo for allegedly harassing the latter's wife and demanding Rs 1 crore from her. According to the police official, a case under sections 498-A, (husband or relative of husband of a woman subjecting her to cruelty), 323 (voluntarily causes hurt), and other relevant provisions under the Indian Penal Code were registered against the duo on Monday.

The complainant, a resident of **Ghansoli**, has alleged that her husband and mother-in-law demanded Rs 1 crore from her to purchase an apartment, a police official from Rabale police station said.

"The complainant's husband also allegedly threatened to set her on fire and kill her," the police official said.

"The woman was also abused and physically tortured. No arrest has been made in this regard so far, he added.

MUMBAI MAN GATECRASHES WEDDING WITH FRIENDS, PAYS FOR IT WITH SCOOTER



The Mumbai man, his cousin, and friends decided to gatecrash a wedding while on an outing. Although the man and his friends got to enjoy a meal at the wedding, the man lost his scooter in the end.

Gatecrashing a wedding turned out to be an expensive affair for a man in Mumbai and his friends. Javed Qureshi, a resident of suburban Goregaon, had gone out with his 17-year-old cousin and friends last week when they came across a wedding nearby. The three decided to gatecrash the wedding for free meals.

However, they were caught red-handed when the family hosting the wedding realized they had gatecrashed the party. Angered by the intrusion, the family escorted Qureshi and the others outside.

The guests tried to calm the hosts down and let Javed and his friends go. As Qureshi was leaving, he realized he had parked his scooter inside. Due to the tense situation, he wasn't able to take it on his way out. So, he asked a wedding guest who had helped diffuse the situation earlier to bring him his scooter and handed over the keys to him.

However, the person did not return with the scooter. Later, Qureshi went to the police and registered a case of criminal breach of trust against an unknown person.

"NO URGENCY": DELHI HIGH COURT REFUSES URGENT LISTING OF THE PLEA BY HINDU SENA TO BAN MOVIE ADIPURUSH

Adipurush, which was released in theatres last week, has been facing flak for its dialogues and depiction of certain characters.

The Delhi High Court on Wednesday denied an urgent hearing of a public interest litigation (PIL) petition seeking a ban on the movie Adipurush.

The case was mentioned before the vacation bench of Justices Tara Vitasta Ganju and Amit Mahajan. The Court said that there was no urgency in the matter and it will be considered on June 30.

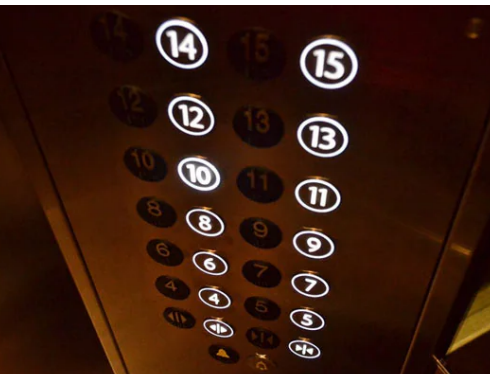
The Counsel appearing for the petitioner organization, Hindu Sena told the Bench that the movie has several controversial scenes which are even affecting India's relations with other countries. "The movie affects India's international relations. Even Nepal has banned the film," the counsel said.

However, the Bench responded that the movie has already been released and there is no urgency in the matter. "There is no urgency, sir. Please come back on June 30," Justice Ganju said.



The movie which stars the likes of Prabhas, Saif Ali Khan, and Kriti Sanon was released in theatres on June 16. Since then, several people have raised objections to certain dialogues of the movie and the depictions of epic characters like Hanuman and Ravana. Vishnu Gupta, National President of Hindu Sena filed the present PIL on the Delhi High Court seeking a ban on the film. As per the plea, Hindu gods and characters like Lord Rama, Sita, Hanuman, and Ravana have been depicted in an inaccurate manner and their description in the film is contrary to what is described in the epic Ramayana. The petition said that the depiction of characters like Ravana, played by Saif Ali Khan,

ELEVATOR IN PROMINENT MUMBAI HIGHRISE CRASHES FROM 4TH FLOOR, 9 INJURED



The incident took place at Trade World Building in the city's Kamala Mills area, a commercial complex in Lower Parel Mumbai: At least nine people have been hospitalised after a lift in Mumbai highrise crashed to the ground floor this morning.

The incident took place at Trade World Building in the city's Kamala Mills area, a commercial complex in Lower Parel that houses several corporate offices and prominent restaurants. The area had hit headlines in 2017 when a massive fire that started in a bar left 14 people dead and over 50 injured.

According to the civic body, Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation, and the city's firefighting department, the incident took place around 11 am today when at least 11 people were inside the lift on the 17-floor building. The lift then crashed from the fourth floor to the ground.

Security personnel of the lift ensured the rescue of the passengers from the crashed lift. While each of the lift's occupants suffered injuries, those with minor injuries refused hospitalisation.

While eight people have been admitted to Global Hospital, one is at KEM Hospital. The injured are in the 20-50 age bracket and include at least three women.

MUMBAI COVID CENTRES' SCAM: ED RAIDS SHIV SENA UBT LEADER'S AIDE, OTHER OFFICIALS

The ED probe is related to a first information report (FIR) lodged at the Azad Maidan police station in August 2022 against partners of Lifeline Hospital Management Services, contracted by the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC).

The Enforcement Directorate (ED) on Wednesday carried out searches at 15 locations in Mumbai and adjoining areas as part of its money-laundering probe related to alleged irregularities in the award of contracts for running jumbo Covid centres in the city.

According to the people familiar with the matter, 14 premises were searched in Mumbai and one premise outside the city. Among those whose premises were searched by the agency included IAS officer Sanjiv Jaiswal and businessman Sujit Patkar, a family friend of Shiv Sena (UBT) MP Sanjay Raut.

The agency had in January recorded the statement of city's municipal commissioner Iqbal Singh Chahal in its probe to seek information and clarifications related to the case.

The ED probe is related to a first information report (FIR) lodged at the Azad Maidan police station in August 2022 against partners of Lifeline Hospital Management Services, contracted by the Brihanmumbai Municipal Corporation (BMC) to set up two jumbo centres. Patkar is one of the firm's partners.

According to the FIR, the company got the BMC contract by allegedly providing "forged documents and had no experience in providing manpower for any medical or health facility".

According to the FIR, in 2020, a news journalist died of Covid in Pune after which the Pune Municipal Corporation and the Pune Metropolitan Region Development Authority (PMRDA) jointly probed the firm. It also seized the security amount of Rs 25 crore possessed by the Lifeline Hospital Management Services.
