



WHY AMRITPAL SINGH, ARRESTED IN PUNJAB, WAS SENT TO ASSAM JAIL

THE REASON WHY AMRITPAL SINGH AND HIS AIDES HAVE BEEN TAKEN TO THE OTHER END OF THE COUNTRY IS THAT NORTH INDIAN JAILS ARE MORE LIKELY TO HAVE GANGSTERS ASSOCIATED WITH HIM OR THE SEPARATIST MOVEMENT, SOURCES SAID.

New Delhi: Radical preacher Amritpal Singh, who has been on the run since March 18, was taken to Dibrugarh Central Jail hours after he surrendered before the Punjab police on Sunday. Eight of his aides are already imprisoned in the highly secure jail, which is among the oldest and most-secure prisons in the northeast.

The reason why Amritpal Singh and his aides have been taken to the other end of the country is that North Indian jails are more likely to have gangsters associated with him or the separatist movement, sources said.

The language barrier is another reason to prevent the accused from connecting with other inmates and jail staff, sources said, adding that Dibrugarh is a very secure prison. Furthermore, the local Sikh community is not sympathetic to the Khalistan movement, they said.

Dibrugarh Jail has also never had a major prison break incident in its nearly 170-year history, furthering its reputation of being an extremely secure prison. The jail's location at the centre of Dibrugarh town is also an advantage for authorities to stop any escape attempts, sources added, as opposed to a location on the outskirts of town or remote areas.

Security around the jail premises has been strengthened since March 19 when four members of the 'Waris Punjab De' (WPD) were brought in. Now, the jail reportedly has 24-hour three-tier security.

"The jail compound has been surrounded by Assam Police's elite Black Cat Commandos, CRPF and other security personnel," an official told news agency PTI.

MUMBAI: 16-YEAR-OLD CRUSHED TO DEATH BY TRUCK AFTER FALLING OFF CYCLE

TEEN, WHO HAILED FROM PRAYAGRAJ, LOST BALANCE AFTER AUTO MADE SHARP TURN

A 16-year-old boy was crushed to death under a truck after falling off his bicycle at Gate No. 7 Malwani in Malad on Sunday afternoon. The deceased, Shahrukh Shaikh, was residing in the Azmi Nagar area with his maternal uncle. According to police sources, the teenager had come to Mumbai from Prayagraj after the death of his father six months ago. He was learning how to make imitation jewellery.



The boy's uncle, Yasin Shaikh, told mid-day, "Shahrukh had called me just a couple of minutes before the incident and I informed him that I was standing near a juice centre. After the accident occurred, like other bystanders, I rushed to the spot, which was nearby.

I could not recognise him at first. Only after taking a good look did I realise that the victim was none other than my nephew." He added, "We are in the casting and imitation jewellery business. He was learning the trade." During the investigation it was revealed that Shahrukh was heading towards Gate No. 1 when an auto-rickshaw cut him off abruptly, causing him to lose his balance. "Before he could get back on his feet, he got crushed under the tyre of the truck," said an officer attached to the Malwani police station.

OVER 400 KILLED, 3,500 INJURED IN SUDAN FIGHTING SO FAR: WHO

THE FIGHTING IS PART OF ONGOING CLASHES BETWEEN THE COUNTRY'S ARMY AND THE PARAMILITARY RAPID SUPPORT FORCES (RSF).

Geneva: The World Health Organization (WHO) said that 413 people have died in the current Sudan conflict, while the UN children's agency said children are paying a high price, with at least nine reportedly killed in the fighting and more than 50 badly injured, Turkish News Agency Anadolu reported. WHO spokesperson Margaret Harris told in a UN press conference that according to figures from the government in Sudan, 413 people have died and 3,551 injured in the conflict.



The fighting is part of ongoing clashes between the country's army and the paramilitary Rapid Support Forces (RSF). She said there had been 11 verified attacks on health facilities, including 10 since April 15. "According to the Ministry of Health in Sudan, the number of health facilities that have stopped working is 20. And also, according to Ministry of Health numbers, the number of health facilities at risk of stopping is 12," said Harris.

"So this means that all those people who need care, and this is not only the people who've been injured hearings, terrible fighting, but that the people who were needing treatment before and continuing treatment," are impacted, said the WHO spokesperson, Anadolu reported. At the same press conference, UNICEF spokesperson James Elder said, "Clearly, as ever, the fighting takes a devastating toll.

A cardiologist from Thane has allegedly duped of Rs 23 lakh by a woman who promised to allow him to make presentations at international summits and also arrange awards for him said a police officer from Vartak Nagar police station on Sunday.

The 41-year-old complainant a cardiologist got to know the woman through Facebook sometime in 2022.

Santosh Gaikar, police inspector, at Vartak Nagar police station said, "The woman cheated the doctor by claiming that she was the niece of a union minister and worked in the public relations department of the Prime Minister's office. The complainant also said to us that the woman offered to get a job for his brother in the PMO."

Fake promises made by female accused Gaikar further added, "The woman also offered the complainant an opportunity to make presentations at a business event and a "United Nations Summit". Doctor was told that he would be speaking on the topic "healthy mindset" at the UN event which would be attended by the prime ministers and top industrialists.

The woman also promised to arrange awards for the doctor for excellence in the field of cardiology and get a mention of his name in a prestigious business magazine.

Gaikar told, "The woman asked the doctor to pay several lakhs of rupees from time to time under various pretexts. When the doctor realised that none of the promised things materialised and he had been taken for a ride he complained to us. Based on the complaint we have registered a case against the woman at Vartak Nagar police station under Indian Penal Code (IPC) section 420 (cheating). As of now no arrest has been made and we are further investigating the case."

TOP WRESTLERS RESUME PROTEST. SEEK PROBE REPORT FINDINGS AND FIR AGAINST THE BJP MP



Seven women wrestlers have filed separate police complaints against BJP MP and Wrestling Federation of India (WFI) president Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh, accusing him of sexual harassment and criminal intimidation.

It is learnt that in their complaints, filed Friday with the Connaught Place Police Station in New Delhi, the wrestlers have cited multiple instances of sexual harassment, dating back to 2012 and as recent as 2022. The reason they did not raise the issue before was their fear of facing consequences, the complainants said.

They also alleged that at least on four occasions, the harassment took place at Brij Bhushan's MP bungalow at Ashoka Road, New Delhi, which also doubles up as the WFI office. Incidents of harassment also took place during an international tournament outside India as well as domestic competitions, the wrestlers alleged.

The police complaints came even as top wrestlers, including Olympic medalists Bajrang Punia and Sakshi Malik along with world championship medalist Vinesh Phogat, returned to Jantar Mantar Sunday, three months after they first began a sit-in protest against Brij Bhushan, accusing him of sexual harassment, among other issues. Sitting next to each other, Sakshi and Vinesh, who were in tears, also demanded that the report submitted to the sports ministry by the government-appointed probe committee be made public.

"It's being said that we haven't given any evidence to the committee to support our claims," said Vinesh. "Has anyone asked Brij Bhushan if he has given any proof?"

Late Sunday, Vinesh - flanked by Sakshi and Bajrang - said in a video message that Delhi Police had not filed an FIR even after the complaints. "We are standing together in this battle for our sisters and daughters. If we fight together, we will definitely get justice," said Bajrang, a bronze medalist at Tokyo Olympics.

Brij Bhushan did not respond to calls or messages from Media.

MUMBAI CRIME: BHOJPURI ACTRESS GETS ARRESTED FOR ALLEGEDLY RUNNING PROSTITUTION RACKET

The accused actress charged 50-80K for one girl and sent three girls to the Royal Palm Hotel located inside Aarey Colony. "During the raids, we have also rescued three girls who were forced into prostitution," an officer said.

The actress, Suman Yadav, also known as Suman Kumari Tetu Gopi, has worked in various films in the Bhojpuri industry, including Laila Majnu, Jomestic Box, web series, Baap Numbari, and Beta 10 Numbari Bhojpuri film. She has also worked as a lead role in various albums in Hindi and Punjabi.
