US Crime News: It is generally seen or heard that a woman or a girl has been raped by a man, but in America it has been seen exactly the opposite. Here a 17-year-old girl has been accused of raping two minor boys. One of the victims is 10 years old and the other is 14 years old. The incident is from Mississippi, USA.

According to the report of Daily Mail, the police told that the accused girl has been taken into custody. She has been identified as 17-year-old Amira Morgan. Not only this, the police have also registered a case against the mother of the accused girl.

police and relatives. After which the accused girl thrashed the children who complained. Amira Morgan, 17, has been taken into custody by police after admitting to engaging in sexual activity with two underage boys. Along with this, the mother of the accused has been arrested for assaulting the children who informed about the incident.

Case will run like an adult According to the report of Daily Mail, the police has made it clear that no concession will be given if the accused girl is a minor. The case against the girl child will proceed in the same way as against the adult i.e. mature (adult) accused. Now the next hearing of this matter is on 8 ju.

BOOKED FOR 'ASSAULTING' DOCTOR AT MUMBAI HOSPITAL, 2 ACQUITTED DUE TO LACK OF EVIDENCE

A sessions court recently acquitted two people, including a senior citizen, on charges of assaulting a doctor at a public hospital in Mumbai due to lack of evidence. The court said that while the alleged offence took place at a public hospital, no independent witnesses were examined and the delay in filing the FIR and recording statements was not explained.

On August 13, 2014, one Dr Ravi Shinde had reported to his duty at Sion Hospital. At around 9 am, when he was going towards a hospital ward, a man named Tukaram Shinde, 62, came towards him and requested him to fill up the form of a health scheme. The doctor told him that since he was

busy with his duty, he would fill the form later. On the next day, around the same time, Shinde approached the doctor again and began arguing with him. Shinde's son, Amol, 26, who was admitted to the hospital, too got into an argument with the doctor and allegedly assaulted and abused him. The Sion police filed a complaint under sections 353 (use of force against a public servant), 332 (voluntarily causing hurt to deter a public servant from duty) of the Indian Penal Code along with relevant sections of the Maharashtra Medical Service Persons and Medicare Service Institutions Act, 2010.

During the trial, the court examined four witnesses, including the doctor, a nurse who said she had not seen the actual incident, another staffer and the investigating officer. The prosecution also relied on the medical report which showed that the doctor had suffered from facial trauma. It said there was no reason for the doctor to falsely implicate the two accused. The court, however, said there were discrepancies in the statements of the doctor and the other staffer, who was an eyewitness.

The court said that the hospital staffer had not stated specific acts committed by the accused. It added that while the incident took place in August 2014, the statements were recorded only in January 2015.

SEX WORK NOT AN OFFENCE, BUT DOING IT IN PUBLIC PLACE CAN BE: MUMBAI COURT

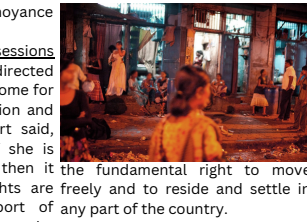
MUMBAI: Observing that sex work in itself is not an offence, a sessions in public place causing annoyance court has directed a shelter home to set at liberty a 34-year-old female to others.

sex worker detained following a raid at a Mulund brothel in February. The court said it can be called an offence when one engages in sex work

The woman moved the sessions court after a magistrate directed her to be detained at the home for one year for care, protection and shelter. The sessions court said,

"The victim is a major...if she is detained without reason then it can be said that her rights are infringed... from the report of police nowhere does it appear the victim indulged in sex work in a public place....Victim is at liberty to reside anywhere and to move freely." The state had opposed her plea saying there is possibility that again she may indulge in sex work. "Detaining sex worker due to antecedents not proper"

Directing a shelter home to set at liberty a 34-year-old female sex worker detained following a raid at Mulund in February, a sessions court said the victim is a major and, as a citizen of India, possesses



The court also said that detaining the victim only on grounds of antecedents of the work was not proper. The woman had approached the sessions court after a magistrate court had directed her to be detained at the home for the period of one year for care, protection and shelter. "The victim has two kids. Certainly they need their mother and if the victim is detained against her wish, it curtails her rights," the court said. The judge cited a Supreme Court ruling.

TWO MEN HELD AFTER 11 YEARS FOR RS 78 LAKH ATM CASH VAN HEIST IN MUMBAI

MUMBAI: Two men, wanted for 11 years in an ATM cash van heist, were arrested from rural Maharashtra recently by a Kandivali police team. The prime accused, Arun Waghmare, was a driver of the cash van. He had fled with Rs 78 lakh in cash and the vehicle in September 2012. The cash was to be deposited into ATMs.

"Using technical investigative methods, our team tracked down Waghmare to Sangli and arrested him on May 21. He gave us information on his associate, Satish Agle, who was arrested from Latur," said inspector Deepshikha Ware. Both the accused have been remanded into police custody till May 26. Waghmare, 38, had joined the company that handles ATM cash management and loading only 10 days before the incident. The vehicle had reached an ATM outlet at Kandivali where three of his colleagues got off to deposit cash. The fourth was an armed security guard who stayed back with Waghmare. After a while, the guard stepped out to fetch water. Waghmare took the opportunity to flee with the van and Rs 78 lakh in cash kept inside it. After crossing a few kilometres, he abandoned the van and fled with the cash. His colleagues tried to call him but his phone was switched off. They then informed the police control room.

'KEY ACCUSED' IN KETAMINE SMUGGLING RACKET ARRESTED FROM MUMBAI AIRPORT

The Mumbai crime branch has arrested a person believed to be a key accused in a case pertaining to the smuggling of ephedrine worth Rs 8 crore to Australia and the UK by concealing it in air cargo. Officers identified the arrested individual as Ali Asgar Shirazi. The police had been tracking him in Srinagar and Delhi before eventually arresting him from Mumbai airport as he tried to flee. An officer said, "A Look Out Circular (LOC) had been issued against him. As he tried to leave for Dubai, the airport authorities informed us following which we took him into custody." "He is an important catch. We suspect he was second in command after Kailash Rajput in operating this network," an officer said. The crime branch had found in that in the six months preceding the arrests made in the case on March 15, ketamine worth Rs 7.87 crore and over 23,000 strips of there were nearly 72 instances when such contraband is believed to have been sent abroad.



Apart from the seven arrests made so far, the police have issued three LOCs, including one against international drug lord Kailash Rajput. "We suspect the entire operation was part of Rajput's network. He is a wanted accused in several cases of narcotics across the country," the official added. Investigators have sought more details from other central agencies about Rajput's network in order to find out who else is part of his operations in the country, the official said. Later five more persons were arrested in the case.

MUMBAI'S JOGESHWARI TO GET A RS 70 CRORE TERMINUS BY JUNE NEXT YEAR

The Western Railway has appointed a contractor for construction of a terminus at Jogeshwari for long distance trains which will cater to passengers from north and western parts of India. The new outstation train terminus will come up on the eastern side of the tracks, in between suburban Ram Mandir and Jogeshwari stations. WR's chief public relations officer Sumit Thakur said, "The contractor for the civil work has been appointed, and the target date of completion is June 2024." The railway board has sanctioned Rs 70 crore for the Jogeshwari terminus project and the civil works component will cost Rs 36 crore approximately, which includes construction of platform, approach road, booking office, control tower, foot over bridge and track. The civil work contract has been awarded to Giriraj Civil Developers Ltd.

"COUNT US OUT": AAP, TRINAMOL BOYCOTT OPENING OF NEW PARLIAMENT BUILDING



New Delhi: Mamata Banerjee's Trinamool Congress became the first opposition party to say that they would boycott the inauguration of the new parliament on Delhi's Central Vista by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, due on May 28. Later in the evening, Arvind Kejriwal's Aam Aadmi Party became the second, declaring that they would boycott the function on account of the "insult" to President Droupadi Murmu, who was not allowed to inaugurate the building. Mr Kejriwal had met Bengal Chief Minister Mamata Banerjee on Tuesday as part of his outreach to opposition parties over the Centre's executive order on transfer and postings of bureaucrats in Delhi. Trinamool MP Derek O'Brien tweeted, "Parliament is not just a new building; it is an establishment with old traditions, values, precedents and rules - it is the foundation of Indian democracy. PM Modi doesn't get that. For him, Sunday's inauguration of the new building is all about I, ME, MYSELF. So count us out". The Arvind Kejriwal government, which is challenging the Centre's executive order, known as Ordinance, over transfer and postings in Delhi, said not inviting the President is an "insult to her" and the party will boycott the parliament ceremony on Sunday. "Not inviting Her Excellency the President Draupadi Murmu ji to the inauguration ceremony of the Parliament House is a gross insult to her. This is an insult to the Dalit tribal and deprived society of India. @AamAdmiParty will boycott the inauguration program in protest against Modi ji not inviting His Excellency the President," AAP leader Sanjay Singh tweeted.

"OKAY TO FAIL": UMA HARATHI RANKS 3 IN CIVIL SERVICES EXAM IN 5TH ATTEMPT

New Delhi: It took Uma Harathi N, an engineering graduate from Telangana, five attempts to clear the civil services exam. Ranked third in the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) examination 2022, she shared an important message today for the young aspirants: "It's okay to fail. I failed so many times. Just be proud of yourself." Uma, an IIT-Hyderabad graduate, is among the women who secured the top four positions - along with Ishita Kishor (AIR 1), Garima Lohia (AIR 2), and Smriti Mishra (AIR 4), all graduates of the Delhi University. "This was my fifth attempt. This has been a long process and it was not easy. But it was a great journey. I learnt from my mistakes and discovered myself," she told NDTV, crediting her family and friends for her success. "The 28-year-old said it was her father who motivated her towards civil services. "He kept telling me what a great platform it is - both as a career and a platform where I can do something meaningful," said Uma, who holds a B.Tech degree in civil engineering. She said there's no single formula for success and that perseverance is the key to achieve something.

ANDHRA GIRL SETS SEVERAL PLACES ON FIRE TO EVICT HER FAMILY FROM VILLAGE, THE REASON IS SHOCKING



Several places in a village in Tirupati district of Andhra Pradesh were set on fire by a 19-year-old girl. According to police, the girl, who was upset with her mother's "bad" behaviour, wanted to evict her own family from the village. Keerthi set fire at 12 places in the village with a motive to "reform" her mother, India Today reported. As per Tirupati ASP (Admin) J Venkat Rao, Keerthi thought her family would become superstitious after these fire incidents and eventually leave the village. Rao said the girl started burning clothes in her family first and she did the same at her neighbour's houses. The incidents created fear among villagers who even conducted some rituals to get rid of any curse on the village. Local legislator, policemen and government officials also visited the village. The incident came to light after police intensified the probe and quizzed villagers. During questioning, the girl told the police about things she has done in the village. The police also got to know that the girl did such things as one of her friends was not talking to her. The police seized Rs 30,000 from the girl which she stole from her mother. A case has been registered under IPC sections 435 and 506.
