

## 22-YEAR-OLD WOMAN KILLED BY FAMILY OVER INTER-CASTE MARRIAGE; GURGAON POLICE ARRESTS PARENTS, BROTHER

On Thursday, Sandeep informed police that he had married Anjali, who was from his village, on December 19, 2022.

A 22-year-old woman was strangled to death allegedly by her family, who later burnt her body, for marrying a man outside their caste, said Gurgaon Police Friday. The woman's parents and brother have been arrested.

Police said the woman, Anjali, a BSc student, and her husband Sandeep are from Surheta in Jhajjar and lived in a residential society in Sector 102.

ACP (Crime) Varun Dahiya said Sandeep informed police that



Anjali was missing from their flat, which they shared with her brother Kunal and his wife.

"Kunal was sent to stay with Anjali after the family formed a plan to kill her. On Thursday, when Sandeep went to his sister's house for a festival and Kunal's wife had gone to work, the brother informed his parents over the phone that Anjali was alone in the flat. Anjali's parents, Kuldeep (44) and Rinki (42), went to the flat... Kunal also came (there)... Kuldeep strangled Anjali while the two held her. They then burnt

her body in their village in Jhajjar to avoid a post-mortem examination and police investigation," the ACP said.

Police said Kuldeep and Rinki were unhappy with Anjali's decision to marry Sandeep without their consent as he was a Brahmin and she was a Jaat.

Police probe found that the parents went to the flat between 11am and 12 pm, killed Anjali and took her to the village in a car where they burnt the body. Police said they are also probing the role of Kunal's wife.

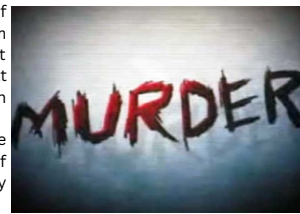
The platform also provides a "free" helpline number, where people can reach out to cyber security experts for advice and assistance. The experts help in drafting complaints and documenting evidence of a scam.

## Zepto raises \$200M at \$1.4B valuation: Two Stanford dropouts create India's first 2023 unicorn

Zepto, an instant grocery startup founded by a duo of Stanford University dropouts, both 20, raised fresh funds at a \$1.4 billion valuation.

Zepto, an instant grocery startup founded by a duo of Stanford University dropouts, both 20, raised fresh funds at a \$1.4 billion valuation, creating a rare Indian unicorn amid a gloomy venture funding climate. Zepto(Satish Bate/HT PHOTO)

StepStone Group, Goodwater Capital and others invested a combined \$200 million in the Mumbai-based company, it said Friday in a statement. Zepto, built with backing from startup incubator Y Combinator, said it's on track to turn profitable within 15 months and intends to go public in two to three years.

Childhood friends Aadit Palicha and Kaivalya Vohra dropped out of Stanford's computer science program to return to India and build the startup when they were teenagers. They are now the youngest founders of any Indian unicorn. "Quick commerce is India's fastest-growing consumer internet category, scaling far more rapidly than segments like ride-hailing and food delivery," Palicha said over video conference. "We are India's fastest-growing consumer internet company and will be Ebitda-positive within 15 months."

The Series E round comes at a challenging time for the quick commerce segment globally, with startups like Gopuff in the US and Getir in Europe cutting jobs. Zepto itself faces stiffening competition from rivals in India, including Alphabet Inc.-backed Dunzo

The Colaba police have apprehended three men for allegedly trying to kill a man. The incident came to light on July 31, when the victim approached the police station to register his complaint.

According to the FIR, the victim who is identified as Imran Namakwala had gone out with his friends for dinner in a hotel in south Mumbai. After Namakwala and his friend left the place and reached Regal Cinemas, some unknown people beat him up and fled from the scene. "We had no lead in this case. However, with a lot of technical investigation and with inputs from reliable sources, we apprehended one of the accused from Sewri," said Senior Police Inspector Vijay Hastikar.

One of the alleged accused identified as Salim Shaikh (23) was apprehended by police from Sewri.

The police then received a tip-off that another accused Lokesh Rawat (28) was hand in gloves with the accused and hence he was arrested from Virar. The duo had confessed that they had received "supari" from Imran's brother. Subsequently, the police arrested Imran's brother Irfan Namakwala (45).

"Both brothers had disputes due to which Irfan planned to kill his brother. Imran was severely injured and had 17 stitches on his face. He is unable to talk," said the police official.

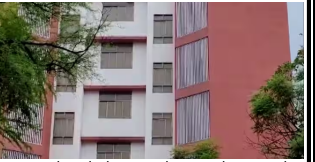

### G20 SUMMIT: NEW DELHI AREA TO BE OUT OF BOUNDS FOR 3 DAYS FROM SEPT 7

The traffic police has also launched a virtual helpdesk in view of the G20 summit, which will inform users about the available transport services, ambulances and police service.



The Delhi Traffic Police has released a detailed advisory for the upcoming G20 summit, which will hold in the national capital for three days - 8-10 September. Special CP (Traffic) SS Yadav said that restrictions will be put in place in the New Delhi area, since the summit will be held at the newly-built Bharat Mandapam convention centre in Delhi's Pragati Maidan under India's presidency. The restrictions will be put in place from the night of September 7 and remain in place till September 10, said Mr Yadav. Those who live in the New Delhi area will be allowed to move freely, but those coming from other districts of Delhi, or tourists from other places, will have to show valid hotel bookings to enter the area.

The Delhi Traffic Police will also keep cargo trucks out of Delhi for three days, said Mr Yadav. They will be diverted to the Eastern and Western peripheral expressways. But vehicles with permission or carrying important cargo will be allowed to enter the national capital, he added. Interstate buses will also be allowed entry into Delhi.

However, there will be no restriction on vehicles deployed in emergency services and ambulances. It is important to note that Mathura Road, Bhairon Marg and Purana Qila Road will be closed for traffic. Further, except ambulances, no other vehicle - including DTC buses - will be allowed in the New Delhi area.

### CHARLES SOBHRAJ, CONVICTED MURDERER, HAS A NEW STORY TO TELL

After spending 19 years in a Nepali jail, 'the Serpent' says he plans to sue for his imprisonment and chase series deals.

Kanpur: A conman and cyber-criminal who was lodged in Tihar jail escaped from the custody of Haryana police on Tuesday night while on remand in Kanpur's Naubasta.

Mumbai Andheri Crime News: A thief in Andheri has done something like this with a woman on the pretext of asking for time, seeing which the ground has shifted from under the feet of many people.

Late last year, after spending 19 years in a Nepali jail, 79-year-old convicted murderer Charles Gurmukh Sobhraj was revelling in his new-found freedom. The day after Christmas, a text message from Sobhraj landed on my phone, sent from a hotel in Paris: "It's 6am and I am in my first bathtub since many years. Feels so nice."

He used the pretext of nature's call to dodge the police and when he was taken to the roadside in Naubasta to relieve himself, he fled. Sub-inspector Govind Ram of Haryana police lodged an FIR against the criminal Ashu Bajpai, a resident of Unnao, on Thursday, said SHO Naubasta Jagdish Pandey.

### 18-YEAR-OLD GIRL MURDERED NEAR WOMEN POLICE STATION IN PUTTUR IN COASTAL KARNATAKA

The thief distracted the woman by asking what time it was saying, "apke paise niche gire hai". After the woman was distracted, the thief reached for her purse on the back seat of the car. The incident took place in Chinoy College area of Andheri East (Andheri News). The CCTV footage of the entire incident has come to light.

Three days previously, Sobhraj, a French citizen, had been released from Kathmandu Central Jail where he had been imprisoned for the murder of two backpackers in 1975. It was not his first time in prison. Sobhraj has spent more than 40 years in different prisons, including in Athens and Tehran, and 21 years in India on charges including murder. It was during his time in Delhi's high-security Tihar Jail in the 1990s when I first met Sobhraj. Back then I was a crime reporter in the Indian capital and would often interview him.

An 18-year-old girl was allegedly murdered a few metres away from the Women Police Station in Puttur, in Dakshina Kannada district, on August 24. The police arrested the alleged assailant Padmaraj.

According to information received, the woman, a doctor by profession, had gone to drop her daughter at Lady Vasantji School in Andheri East on Tuesday afternoon. This time the woman parked her car in front of Chinoy College. Leaving the girl, the lady doctor was sitting in her car when a stranger approached.

### MUMBAI: COP CAUGHT SCHMOOZING WITH CRIMINAL SHE HAD BEEN TASKED WITH CATCHING

According to police sources, the assailant, who was an earthmover operator (driver), has been following Gauri for the last few days and pestering the latter to marry him. On Thursday, August 24, the girl dialled her mother and asked her to come over to Puttur bus stand after briefing her about the harassment by Padmaraj. Even before the mother could reach Puttur, the assailant who came in a motorcycle at around 1 p.m., met the girl near the police station. He had a brief chat with the victim before slashing her neck with his knife. Padmaraj then sped away from the spot.

"Apke paise niche gire hai", the man asked the woman what time it was. Meanwhile, after the woman was distracted, he ran away with the purse, gold ornaments and cash kept in the back seat of the car (Crime News).

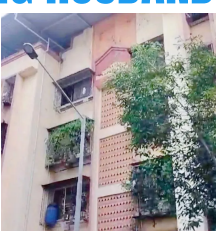
First the cops asked her help to catch notorious Mumbai - mobile snatcher; when she didn't reply, they raided him on their own, only to find her in his company in a city hotel.

Police said she was mentally unwell and depressed, and fought with him often The Nayanagar police at Mira Road have arrested a 55-year-old woman who allegedly killed her 69-year-old husband on Thursday. The police said she is mentally unwell and depressed.



Police said the woman, identified as Rajkumari Gupta, killed her husband Ramesh Kumar Gupta at their flat in Shanti Nagar, Sector 7 on Thursday.

The couple stayed with their 30-year-old son who works for a food delivery app. The police said the accused hit the head of the deceased with a grinding stone multiple times due to which he died on the spot.

On based on her complaint, the Kherwadi police in Bandra East started the probe and learned that the suspects were from Mumbai. They had committed the same offences in Vile Parle as well, said sources.

The deceased's son came to know from neighbours about a fight and he rushed home around 4.40 pm. He alerted the police on seeing his father's body lying in a pool of blood. During investigation, it was revealed that the mental status of the accused is not well.

The cops approached the Mumbai police and sought assistance in tracing the accused API Borse, however, asked them to wait for a few days, saying she was going on leave, the sources added.
