**THE DELHI PUBLIC SCHOOL, MATHURA ROAD, RECEIVED A BOMB THREAT EARLY ON WEDNESDAY MORNING. INFORMATION WAS RECEIVED ABOUT A BOMB BEING PLACED THROUGH EMAIL.**

Delhi Public School, Mathura Road, received a bomb on school premises: DCP threat early on Wednesday morning. Information about a bomb being placed in the school was received through email. Panic ensued on campus shortly after receiving the information and parents rushed to the school to get their children out of the school premises.

The Indian School in Delhi's Sadiq Nagar was evacuated after receiving a bomb threat email on April 12. The bomb detection and disposal squad arrived at the school and conducted a thorough check of the school premises. According to the Delhi Police, "The Indian School in Sadiq Nagar received a bomb threat via email. As a precautionary measure, the school was vacated. Bomb Detection and Disposal Squad were also informed."

## DON'T CALL ME A CRIMINAL, WAS I BOOKED FOR RAPE OR EXTORTION, EXP & MURDER CONVICT ANAND MOHAN

Anand Mohan, former Member of Parliament (MP), who was serving a life sentence in the killing of IAS officer G Krishnaiah, is to be free along with 26 others who have been lodged in different prisons in Bihar for more than 14 years.



A notification amending the rules was issued late evening, when, Mohan, who has been on parole, was celebrating the engagement of his son, Chetan Anand, a sitting MLA of the ruling Rashtriya Janata Dal (RJD) in the state.

The Telangana-born Dalit officer, who was then the district magistrate of Gopalganj, was beaten to death by a mob in 1994, while his vehicle was passing through Muzaffarpur district.

**You have spent over 15 years in jail. How would you describe your journey?**  
It was my destiny and I completed my life term, which exceeded one-and-a-half years than the term of 14 years, very patiently. I tried to find positivity in the darkness and because of that, I have written more than six novels from inside the jail. Today, people talk of Dalits. The first book I wrote was on Mountain Man Dashrath Manjhi, which was included in the Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) syllabus. Similarly, I wrote a book on Madan Lal from our village, who was a cultural artist and singer. He belonged to the Dhanuk community. I spent the time in jail with positivity.

**Mayawati has tweeted, alleging that Nitish Kumar has taken an anti-Dalit decision. What do you have to say about these allegations?**  
Who is Mayawati? I don't know any Mayawati. I have known a lady named Kalavati since my childhood in the state Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) has been evading questions and statements on you. The BJP at the Centre is alleging that criminals are being released from jail by the Nitish government. They say this is another example of gundaraj. What is your take on this?

**SUDAN CRISIS: WAR CRIMES SUSPECT FREED AMID CHAOS**  
A former Sudanese politician wanted for alleged crimes against humanity has said that he and other former officials are no longer in jail.

Ahmad Harun was among those held in Kober prison in the capital Khartoum who are facing charges by the International Criminal Court (ICC). A ceasefire between Sudan's army and a rival paramilitary group still largely appears to be holding. But there are doubts about both parties' commitment to a lasting peace. In another development, a second evacuation flight rescuing UK nationals from Sudan landed in Cyprus, while a boat evacuating more than 1,600 people from dozens of countries has now arrived in Saudi Arabia. Volker Perthes, who is the UN special envoy to Sudan

and is currently in the country, said that it seemed the 72-hour pause in fighting was still being observed in some parts of Sudan. But gunfire and explosions were reported in Khartoum and the nearby city of Omdurman. "There is yet no unequivocal sign that either is ready to seriously negotiate, suggesting that both think that securing a military victory over the other is possible," said Mr Perthes. The ceasefire, which began at midnight (22:00 GMT) on Monday, is the latest attempt to bring stability to the country after fighting broke out between the army and paramilitary Rapid Support Forces (RSF) on 15 April. At least 459 people have died in this latest conflict so far, though the actual number is thought to be much higher.

# MUMBAI: ANDHERI HOTELIER WAS KIDNAPPED FOLLOWING A MONETARY DISPUTE WITH SUSPECT, RESCUED BY COPS

ACCORDING TO THE POLICE, THE HOTEL VEERA RESIDENCY OWNER WAS ALLEGEDLY KIDNAPPED BY THE FOUR PEOPLE BY THREATENING WITH AN AIRGUN AND KNIFE ON MONDAY AFTERNOON AT CHAKALA AREA AT ANDHERI EAST

A day after an Andheri-based hotel owner was allegedly kidnapped from his hotel by unknown suspects, the Mumbai Police have successfully rescued the victim and have nabbed the culprits, the police said on Tuesday.



According to the police, the Hotel Veera Residency owner was allegedly kidnapped by four people threatening with an airgun and knife on Monday afternoon in the Chakala area at Andheri East. Police said that the prime accused in the case had sent three people who posed as waiters, housekeeping staff and a driver to the victim's hotel. The police traced the culprits to the Padgha area after their last location was traced.

On the day of the crime, all three accused worked in the hotel from morning till afternoon. In the afternoon at around 3.30 pm all three accused joined the main accused and they pulled an airgun to threaten the victim. They also demanded all the dues pending and threatened to kill him. While kidnapping the hotel owner, the suspects were captured in the CCTV of the hotel, they were seen beating the victim and his driver before leaving from the crime scene.

Police said, the main accused is a partner of the hotel owner for the past few months and they got into a dispute over the pending bills for the hotel expenses.

# DOUBTS ON WIFE'S CHARACTER, FIRST KILLS DAUGHTER, THEN KILLS HERSELF- SHOCKING INCIDENT IN MUMBAI

A FATHER KILLED HIS 11-YEAR-OLD DAUGHTER AND THEN COMMITTED SUICIDE AS HE SUSPECTED HIS WIFE'S CHARACTER. THE INCIDENT TOOK PLACE IN THE LALBAGH AREA OF MUMBAI.



A shocking incident has come to light from Mumbai. Suspicious of his wife's character, a father killed his 11-year-old daughter and then took his own life. This incident has taken place in the Lalbaug area of Mumbai. The deceased father's name is Bhupesh Pawar. Arya Pawar is the name of the murdered eleven-year-old girl.

**First killing the girl, then hanging himself**  
Bhupesh Pawar always suspected his wife's character. On Tuesday (April 25), while his wife was out, Bhupesh strangled his 11-year-old daughter and then hanged himself. A case has been registered under section 302 of IPC in Kalachowki police station on the complaint of a wife. Police are investigating the matter further.

**Husband and daughter were found dead**  
Deceased Bhupesh Pawar (aged 42 years) used to work as a stockbroker. While his wife works as a data operator in a private company. A husband, wife and daughter lived on the sixteenth floor of the Bimawala Mahal building in Ganesh Galli. Yesterday the wife went to her work as usual. But around eleven in the morning, she made many calls to her husband Bhupesh Pawar. But he did not receive any call. Feeling suspicious, the wife rushed home. The door of the house was locked from inside. After this, she informed the neighbours and called the Kalachowki police station. After this, the police immediately reached the house. After breaking the door, they found both Bhupesh Pawar and the girl hanging. Police have informed that both were admitted to KEM Hospital where they were declared brought dead.

**Give my money, gold, and house to niece, mentioned in a suicide note**  
Meanwhile, the police have also found a suicide note in his house. In it, he has written that he has taken this step due to an argument with his wife. He has also written that the girl should not fart after him. Also, my money, gold and house should be given to my nephew. Not only this but before committing suicide, Bhupesh Pawar had removed 9 to 10 tolas of gold and cash of Rs 9 lakh from the house and kept it on the ground. The suicide note mentions giving this compensation to his nephew.

# SUDAN CRISIS: AHMAD HARUN, ACCUSED OF WAR CRIMES, GENOCIDAL RAPES, FREED FROM PRISON

Ahmad Harun, a former Sudanese politician, accused of alleged crimes against humanity, said that he and his associates have broken out of prison as the country plunges into crisis.



The International Criminal Court (ICC) slammed charges on Ahmad Harun and he was held in the Sudanese capital Khartoum's Kober prison.

"We made a decision to protect ourselves due to lack of security, water, food and treatment as well as the death of many prisoners in Kober," Harun told al-Sudani, the BBC said in its report. The news agency citing Sudan's military officials said that former president Omar al-Bashir has been moved to a military hospital. Bashir was ousted from power in 2019 by the military following mass protests in the country of 46 million people.

Sudan is currently facing a political crisis as armed forces chief General Abdel-Fattah Burhan and the head of the Rapid Support Forces (RSF) paramilitary group, General Mohammed Hamdan Dagalo are fighting to take control of the resource-rich nation. A ceasefire for 72 hours agreed between both military factions largely appears to be holding, the BBC said. The news agency pointed out that doubts remain regarding the warring factions' commitment to a lasting peace. Harun confirmed on Tuesday that he and other of 46 million people. # WOMAN JUMPS OFF RAPIDO BIKE TO ESCAPE MOLESTATION BID BY THE RIDER IN BANGALURU

A YOUNG WOMAN JUMPED OFF A MOVING RAPIDO BIKE TO ESCAPE A MOLESTATION BID BY THE RIDER, POLICE SAID ON WEDNESDAY.



A young woman jumped off a moving Rapido bike to escape a molestation bid by the rider, police said on Wednesday.

According to police, the incident took place late on April 21 in the limits of Yelahanka New Town police station here. Twenty-seven-year-old Deepak Rao, a resident of Thindlu and a native of Andhra Pradesh, was arrested.

Police explain that the woman had booked a Rapido bike at about 11 p.m. to reach a friend's place in Indiranagar on April 21. The accused took her mobile on the pretext of getting OTP and started harassing her sexually while moving.

He had also taken a deviation from the route and headed towards Doddaballapur Road instead of Indiranagar. On being questioned by the woman, he started to speed.

Shocked by this, the woman jumped off from the vehicle near BMS College in Nagenahalli near Yelahanka. The security staff at the college gate rushed to her help. The accused, after seeing this, escaped from the spot.

The girl had suffered injuries in her hands and legs. As she was wearing a helmet, she escaped without major injuries to her head and face. The victim then borrowed a mobile from them and informed her family and friends about the incident.

Later, the police were informed. The police obtained the CCTV footage of the incident and arrested the accused and sent him to judicial custody.

Preliminary investigations revealed that the accused was inebriated during the incident. An investigation is underway.

# 10 COPS, DRIVER KILLED IN BLAST BY MAOISTS IN CHHATTISGARH'S DANTEWADA

CHHATTISGARH MAOIST ATTACK: THE POLICEMEN WERE RETURNING FROM AN ANTI-MAOIST OPERATION THAT WAS LAUNCHED AFTER INTELLIGENCE INPUTS, OFFICIALS SAID.

Raipur: Ten policemen and their driver were killed on Thursday when their minivan was blown up by an improvised explosive device (IED) in the Bastar district of Chhattisgarh, officials said.

The policemen were returning from an anti-Maoist operation that was launched after intelligence inputs, they said.

The policemen belonged to the District Reserve Guard (DRG), a special force of the Chhattisgarh police that comprises mostly local tribals who have been trained to combat Maoists.

The DRG has been instrumental in several successful operations against the rebels in Bastar, a hotbed of left-wing extremism.

Union Home Minister Amit Shah spoke with Chhattisgarh Chief Minister Bhupesh Baghel following the attack and assured all possible help.

"The news of the martyrdom of our 10 DRG jawans and a driver due to an IED blast targeting the DRG force which had arrived for anti-Naxal operation on the information of the presence of Maoist cadre under Arampur police station area of Dantewada is very sad. We share the grief of their families. May their soul rest in peace," Mr Baghel tweeted. The Maoists, also known as Naxals, have waged an armed insurgency against.
