'FORGED DOCUMENTS'': UPSC CONSIDERS CRIMINAL ACTION AGAINST 2 CANDIDATES

New Delhi: The Union Public Service Commission (UPSC) is considering criminal and disciplinary penal action against two candidates for allegedly claiming selection in the civil services examination, the results of which were declared on Tuesday, according to an official statement.

The case relates to Ayasha Makrani (from Madhya Pradesh) and Tushar (from Bihar) who fraudulently claimed that they have been finally recommended by the Commission in the civil services examination 2022 against two roll numbers of genuinely recommended candidates, it said.

"The claims of both persons are fake. They have forged the documents in their favour to buttress their claims." said the statement issued on Friday.

By doing so, both Ayasha Makrani and Tushar have acted in contravention of the provisions of the Rules of the Civil Services Examination, 2022 notified by the government of India (Department of Personnel and Training), it said.

Therefore, in accordance with the provisions of the Examination Rules, the UPSC is contemplating both criminal as well as disciplinary

INDIGO FILES FIR AGAINST 17 STAFF OF PVT COMPANY

MUMBAI: A tussle broke out between two factions of employees of a company, that handles IndiGo's ground operations,on Friday. The airline said that its operations were not hit.

"IndiGo is aware of the matter involving 17 employees of Agile at Mumbai airport who tried to sabotage the operations. An FIR has been filed and the matter is sub judice," said an IndiGo statement.

"We assure our operations are flawless and smooth with support of all our employees," the airline added.



The motorist, who allegedly ran over and killed a 57-year-old jogger at Worli in south Mumbai, has claimed that he had partied with friends hours before the accident, but had not consumed alcohol.

The accused, Sumer Merchant, made the claim in the statement given to the police, which is part of the chargesheet filed recently before a court here. The chargesheet, citing his blood sample report, stated that the alcohol content in Merchant's blood was 137 mg in 100 ml, which is way above the permissible limit.

Rajalakshmi Ramakrishnan, a tech firm CEO, was hit by a speeding car during her morning walk on the Worli seaface promenade on March 19. Merchant (23), in his statement, said that he had gone to America for work for

15 days and returned to India on March 15. After returning home, Merchant met his school and office friends and decided to have a party on March 18, and they had gone to a restaurant in Kamala Mills

area. The accused claimed that during the party some of his friends consumed

alcohol, but he didn't. 'Some of my friends there consumed alcohol, but I didn't feel like drinking

alcohol because I wasn't getting enough sleep. So I didn't drink alcohol," his statement read. Once the restaurant closed at 1.30 am (on March 19), the accused came home

with his friends



Murder accused Krishna Manbahadur Periyar, 25, had been arrested in 2013 for robbery by the Juhu police, and spent seven years in jail, but the cops haven't found any criminal records of him in the Crime and Criminal Tracking Network and System (CCTNS) of Maharashtra police. The company that employed him, has claimed that they completed his police verification through a law agency they hired, and the Sakinaka police had verified his records.

The Santacruz police are now checking whether the Sakinaka police did do Periyar's verification as claimed by the company. Periyar was hired as a caretaker by the Health Care at Home India company which is in Sakinaka, on May 1. The company officials claimed that they completed the police verification with the Sakinaka police through a law firm they had hired, and after completing it, they gave the job to Periyar.

Speaking to mid-day, an employee of the Health Care at Home India company said, "Before hiring anyone, we take their Aadhaar card and other relevant documents. We also get the police verification done through a law firm we have hired. Perivar was hired by us after completing his verification. We also informed the police about it."

'Nothing on CCTNS'

The investigation officer of Santacruz police told mid-day, "Periyar was arrested in 2013 and he also spent 7 years in jail and in 2020 December he was released. When we checked his records in the CCTNS, we didn't find anything. In the court records application also, we searched his name but didn't find anything. The Maharashtra police uses CCTNS to find the accused's criminal records. We are checking how his verification was done by the Sakinaka police as per the company that employed him, or whether it was done at all.

BANGLADESHI ARRESTED FOR TRYING TO FLY TO ROME WITH 'INDIAN' PASSPORT IN MUMBAI



A 32-year-old Bangladesh national, who claimed to be a Buddhist monk, has been arrested here for trying to travel to Rome on an Indian passport that he had obtained by providing fake documents, an official said on Friday.

Bipon Anil Barua, a resident of Bandarban in Bangladesh, was apprehended at Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj International Airport on Wednesday night, the official said.

Barua was to fly to Rome via Muscat from Mumbai in the early hours of Thursday. When an immigration officer keyed in his passport details in their system, he found

that a Look Out Circular (LOC) has been issued against him by the Foreigners Registration Office (FRRO), Mumbai, the official said.

An LOC is a notice which prevents a person from leaving the country.

According to remarks on the LOC, Barua is a Bangladeshi passport holder. He used fake papers to fraudulently acquire an Indian passport.

Barua told officials that he is a Buddhist monk and came to India from the neighbouring country via the Haridaspur border in 2015 to propagate Buddhism, he said.
