Police in Navi Mumbai has registered offences against 11 persons for allegedly gambling at a hotel and seized more than Rs 1.75 lakh from them

Police in Navi Mumbai has registered offences against 11 persons for allegedly gambling at a hotel and seized more than Rs 1.75 lakh from them, officials said on Monday.

They said that acting on a tip-off, local police Sunday conducted a raid at a room in the hotel located in Turbhe area of Navi Mumbai.

The police found seven persons playing 'teen-patti', a gambling game involving cards, and three



others serving them tea, coffee, etc, the official from Turbhe police station said.

The police seized Rs 1,05,230 from the gamblers and Rs 70,000 cash lying on the gambling table, he said.

An FIR was registered against the seven gamblers, three persons who were serving them beverages and the hotel manager under provisions of the Maharashtra Prevention of Gambling Act, the official said.

Earlier in the day, Navi Mumbai police registered a case against a man for allegedly raping a 14-year-old girl repeatedly following which she became pregnant.

The police said the accused, from Kamothe in Navi Mumbai, and the victim, resident of Turbhe area, got in touch with each other through social media platform Instagram in January 2021 and had an affair.

The accused allegedly raped the girl repeatedly at his residence following which she became pregnant in May 2023, an official from Kamothe police station said.

The man's mother was aware of everything.

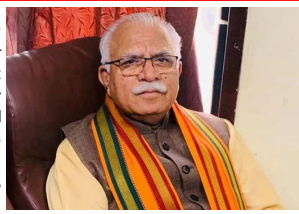

The Colaba police have apprehended three men for allegedly trying to kill a man. The incident came to light on July 31, when the victim approached the police station to register his complaint.

According to the FIR, the victim who is identified as Imran Namakwala had gone out with his friends for dinner in a hotel in south Mumbai. After Namakwala and his friend left the place and reached Regal Cinemas, some unknown people beat him up and fled from the scene. "We had no lead in this case. However, with a lot of technical investigation and with inputs from reliable sources, we apprehended one of the accused from Sewri," said Senior Police Inspector Vijay Hastikar.

One of the alleged accused identified as Salim Shaikh (23) was apprehended by police from Sewri.

The police then received a tip-off that another accused Lokesh Rawat (28) was hand in gloves with the accused and hence he was arrested from Virar. The duo had confessed that they had received "supari" from Imran's brother. Subsequently, the police arrested Imran's brother Irfan Namakwala (45).

"Both brothers had disputes due to which Irfan planned to kill his brother. Imran was severely injured and had 17 stitches on his face. He is unable to talk," said the police official.

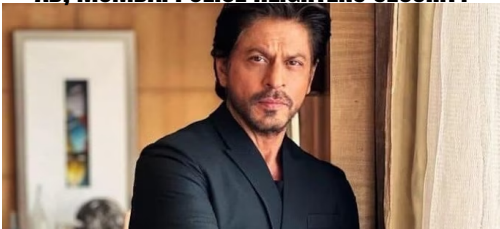

## NO PERMISSION FOR JALABHISHEK YATRA IN NUH, SECURITY STEPPED UP: DGP HARYANA

Internet services have been suspended in Nuh from 12 noon on August 26 to August 28 midnight and prohibitory orders under Section 144 of the CrPC imposed. Amid call by the Hindu outfits to hold Jalabhishek Yatra in Nuh on August 28, Haryana Director General of Police Shatrughan Kapur on August 26 said the permission for the procession was denied and all necessary arrangements were made to maintain law and order in view of the inputs that the organisers had given a call for the people to reach Nuh from neighbouring States. He was presiding over a meeting of senior police officers of States bordering Haryana through video conferencing in Panchkula. Mr. Kapur called for a co-ordinated effort to effectively deal with the situation. Shares of Vedanta, which have fallen 16 per cent in the last one month, will be in focus on Monday after The Anil Agarwal-led company won an arbitration award against a demand for a higher payout from its Rajasthan oil and gas fields after a disallowance worth \$1.16 billion or Rs 9,545 crore in certain costs. The stock would also be in news amid a Reuters report that suggested Vedanta was considering listing all or some of its businesses, which range from metals and mining to oil & gas and potentially chipmaking.
