conducted a late-night raid on the Crazy Boys ladies' bar in Panvel and detained 23 persons, including 19 female waiters and 4 bar staff, who were allegedly engaged in making indecent gestures and obscene actions to entice customers to the bar. ## Islamabad High Court suspends Imran Khan's conviction and three-year sentence in Toshakhana case

A division bench comprising Islamabad High Court (IHC) Chief Justice Aamir Farooq and Justice Tariq Mehmood Jahangiri announced the much-anticipated reserved verdict. The Islamabad High Court on Tuesday suspended former Pakistan prime minister Imran Khan's conviction and three-year sentence in the Toshakhana corruption case. A division bench comprising Islamabad High Court (IHC) Chief Justice Aamir Farooq and Justice Tariq Mehmood Jahangiri announced the much-anticipated reserved verdict. On Monday, the IHC reserved the verdict on Khan's plea challenging his conviction in the Toshakhana corruption case. A trial court in Islamabad convicted and sentenced the 70-year-old Pakistan Tehreek-e-Insaf (PTI) chairman to three years in prison on August 5. The cricketer-turned-politician was sentenced on charges of unlawfully selling state gifts acquired by him and his family during his 2018-2022 tenure. He has also been barred from politics for five years, preventing him from contesting an upcoming election.

## KARNATAKA: BENGALURU POLICE ARRESTS ONE MORE IN TERROR SUSPECTS CASE

RT Nagar Police in Bengaluru have arrested another man linked to the terror suspects case being investigated by the crime branch on Monday, officials informed. As per the officials, the arrested accused is said to have been in constant touch with a man named Junaid, who is said to be in a Middle Eastern country (on the run) and handling the others. According to the police, a few weeks ago, 5 men were arrested for suspected terror activities, and guns and grenades were recovered from their possession. Cops who were on the lookout for their associates have arrested a man identified as Arshad from RT Nagar in Bengaluru, they said. Arshad is said to have tried to slit his own throat as cops tried to box him in. They have managed to get him to the hospital and save him, and he has been arrested, they added. Further investigation into the matter is underway.

But this time the cas... https://in a relief to consumers, the Union Cabinet on Tuesday reduced by ₹200 the price of a 14.2 kg LPG cooking gas cylinder as a gift for the women ahead of Raksha Bandhan. The move comes as the Centre faces increasing criticism over rising inflation.



"On the occasion of Raksha Bandhan and Onam, the government has decided to reduce the price of domestic cylinders by ₹200," said Union Information and Broadcasting Minister Anurag Thakur. "This is a gift from PM Narendra Modi to the women of the country." The reduction in price also applies to beneficiaries under the Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY).

subsidy under the PM Ujjwala scheme. "The government will also provide 75 lakh new LPG connections for free under the Ujjwala scheme," Thakur announced. At present, there are 9.6 crore beneficiaries of the scheme.

At present, a 14.2kg LPG (liquefied petroleum gas) cylinder in the national capital costs ₹1,103. Effective Wednesday, the price will come down to ₹903.

In July, oil marketing companies had hiked the price of domestic LPG cylinders by ₹50, following two increases in May.

For beneficiaries of the PM's Ujjwala scheme, the price will be ₹703. In March, government had extended a ₹200 per LPG cylinder

The subsidy for PMUY beneficiaries was introduced in May last year as the government had announced a series of relief measures amid surging global energy prices.

## ADITYA-L1, INDIA'S FIRST SOLAR MISSION, TO LIFT OFF ON SEPTEMBER 2

BENGALURU: As Vikram and Pragyan, the Chandrayaan-3 lander and rover continue to do science on the Moon, Isro has set the date for the launch of its solar mission on September 2.

Aditya-L1 is the first space-based observatory-class Indian solar mission to study the Sun. It is planned to be placed in a halo orbit around the Lagrangian point1 (L1) of the Sun-Earth system, which is about 1.5-million-km from Earth.

A satellite placed in L1 point has the major advantage of continuously viewing the Sun without any occultation/eclipse.

This will provide a greater advantage of observing the solar activities continuously.

The spacecraft will carry seven payloads to observe the photosphere, chromosphere, and the outermost layers of the Sun (the corona) using electromagnetic and particle detectors. Using the special vantage point.

## MORGAN STANLEY, PRAKHHYAT GROUP TO DEVELOP WAREHOUSE IN MUMBAI



The partners will invest Rs 300 crore in the 700,000 sq. ft warehouse, according to sources

A Morgan Stanley unit and the Prakhyat Group, a Mumbai-based industrial and logistics developer, have tied up to develop a warehousing project near Mumbai.

The group and a fund managed by Morgan Stanley Real Estate Investing (MSREI) will develop the 700,000 square foot project at K Square Logistics Park in Bhiwandi near Mumbai.

This marks MSREI's entry in the Bhiwandi sub-market of Mumbai. With this, MSREI, the global private real estate investment management arm of Morgan Stanley, has now invested in over 5.6 million square feet of logistics assets in India, MSREI said in a statement.

The partners will invest about Rs 300 crore in the project, according to people familiar with the plans.

The state-of-the-art project, branded One K-Square, will be built across 25 acres to international specifications. It will offer warehousing solutions to institutional customers from the e-commerce, third party logistics, consumer goods and consumer durables sectors, among others, it said.

## AS KOTA SUICIDES SURGE, SUPER 30 FOUNDER HAS A MESSAGE FOR STUDENTS



Two boys died by suicide in Rajasthan's Kota, India's coaching hub for aspiring engineers and doctors, within four hours on Sunday.

Anand Kumar, mathematician and founder of Super 30 coaching centre, has said he is "shaken" by two suicides on Sunday in Rajasthan's Kota, India's coaching district for aspiring engineers and doctors. In a post on X (formerly Twitter), Mr Kumar made an appeal to coaching centres to consider the students "as your children" and pay attention to all of them. He also told students that one test is not the measure of their talent. Nearly two dozen students have died by suicide this year in Kota, the highest ever recorded.

"The news of suicide of two children in Kota within just four hours has shaken me. I appeal to all the coaching operators that you should not make education only a source of income and pay attention to all the children considering them as your children," Mr Kumar said on social media.

"And I would like to explain to the students that any one test cannot define your talent. There is not one but many ways to be successful in life. At the same time, parents should not expect their children to fulfill their unfulfilled dreams," he added.

One of the students who died, 17-year-old Avishkar Shubhangi, was preparing for NEET, the common medical entrance exam. He was from Maharashtra.

The second boy named Adarsh Raj was from Bihar. Both died in two separate incidents on August 27.

While Avishkar jumped from the sixth floor of his coaching institute's building, Adarsh hanged himself at his rented apartment.

## NO PERMISSION FOR JALABHISHEK YATRA IN NUH, SECURITY STEPPED UP: DGP HARYANA

Internet services have been suspended in Nuh from 12 noon on August 26 to August 28 midnight and prohibitory orders under Section 144 of the CrPC imposed. Kherwadi police's search for a serial mobile-snatcher has opened a probe into an alleged nexus between the criminal and an assistant inspector from Mumbai police station. The city cops had sought Mumbai API Krupalpi Borse's help in catching accused Sabir Sher Ali Sayyed. But they ended up catching Sayyed on their own and to their surprise, Borse with him.
