

## AT LEAST 10 VAISHNO DEVI PILGRIMS DEAD, 57 INJURED AS BUS FALLS DOWN FROM BRIDGE IN JAMMU

**THE BUS WAS REPORTED TO HAVE BEEN CARRYING PILGRIMS TO THE MATA VAISHNO DEVI SHRINE**

Ten Mata Vaishno Devi pilgrims, most of them from Bihar, were killed and 57 others were injured on May 30 as their double-decker bus fell into a gorge after skidding off the road and ramming into the railing of a bridge in Jammu district, officials said.

The death toll may go up as Government Medical College Hospital Principal Shashi Soodan said two of the injured admitted there are critical. Officials said the bus, which was on its way to Katra from Amritsar, met with the accident in Jhajjar Kotli area. Katra is a base for the pilgrims visiting the famous shrine atop the Trikuta hills. "The accident took place at Jhajjar Kotli bridge. Ten people have died. Rescue operation is almost complete," Jammu Senior Superintendent of Police Chandan Kohli told PTI. "We are investigating the reasons behind the accident." Local residents, CRPF and



police personnel rushed to the spot and launched the rescue operation. The fifty-seven injured have been admitted to the GMC hospital in Jammu and two of them are critical. "Two persons were brought dead in the hospital while others have died on the spot," said Mr. Soodan, the principal. A CRPF officer said 10 bodies have been recovered. The bus skidded off the Jammu-Srinagar National Highway and rolled the down the bridge over a nallah at Jhajjar Kotli between 6.30 a.m. and 7 a.m., the officials said. They said most of the travellers were from Bihar's Lakhisarai and were on pilgrimage to Mata Vaishno Devi for a religious

function of their child. They were members of an extended family. Ravinder Panday, one of the travellers, said they felt that something hit the bus. "It lost balance and rolled down. The vehicle was on its way from Amritsar to Katra carrying people who were going for pilgrimage to the cave shrine of Mata Vaishno Devi," he said. The accident site looked horrific with bodies trapped under the mangled remains of the bus.

Describing the accident, a witness said the bus was in the left lane, but it crossed over to the right side after the driver lost control, hit the railing of the bridge went down. The front wheels came off and got stuck in the parapet of the bridge. "We were hoping to pay obeisance to Mata Vaishno Devi temple and perform the parapat of our child. We were serval families together," said Ramesh Kumar.

**MUMBAI: RARE SURGERY HAS 71-YEAR-OLD BACK ON HIS FEET**  
A city doctor and his team have successfully removed stones from both knees of a 71-year-old male patient. Due to the deformity of the bones, the doctor also performed knee replacement surgery. The hospital claims that this is the fourth case in India and the ninth in the world where stones have been removed from both knees. Prahlad Pawar, 71, a resident of Pune, had been suffering from severe knee pain and progressively worsening leg deformity for nearly 10 years. He was barely able to walk due to the deformity and thus was brought to SL Raheja Hospital in Mahim. Dr Siddharth M Shah, a consultant-orthopaedics and joint replacement surgeon at the hospital, explained that after multiple tests, the patient was diagnosed with Synovial osteochondromatosis, a rare condition. Involvement of both knees in this condition is even rarer. The patient had an extensive manifestation of the disease, with multiple large stones in and around the knee, as well as severe knee arthritis and a tibial bone defect. Dr Shah said, "Surgery was the only option to relieve the patient from this condition, as there was damage to the tibial bone due to bone erosion. Instead of a standard total knee replacement, a complex knee replacement was required, involving the augmentation of the tibial bone defect with augments and additional support with a stem. The presence of stones close to important ligaments and blood vessels posed another challenge, as their removal required utmost care to avoid damage to these vital structures. Damaging the blood supply of the leg could result in amputation.

## MUMBAI NEWS: CHEMBUR MAN CRUSHED TO DEATH AS PARKING GARAGE COLLAPSES ON HIM

## MUMBAI SCHOOL WRESTLING COACH GETS 5-YR JAIL FOR 'SEXUALLY HARASSING' MINOR STUDENTS

Mumbai: A special POCSCO court in Mumbai on Monday sentenced a municipal school sports coach to five years of rigorous imprisonment for sexually assaulting minor girls during training sessions and when they had gone on a trip.

Special Judge S C Jadhav held the "lagori" coach guilty under section 10 (aggravated sexual assault) of the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, and relevant provisions of the Indian Penal Code for molestation.

Besides sentencing him to five years of rigorous imprisonment, the court also imposed a fine of ₹ 10,000 on the convict.

The informant never attended the practice on Sunday as her parents did not allow her to take part in the sessions. The coach also used to tell the girls he would teach them sports like wrestling and kabaddi.

## MUMBAI CRIME: MAN HELD FOR KILLING KANDIVLI BUSINESSMAN

The man who allegedly shot and killed a businessman in Kandivli, was arrested from Uttar Pradesh's Prayagraj on Monday. The 28-year-old businessman, Manoj Chauhan, who worked in the imitation jewellery industry, was shot dead on Sunday outside his residence.

According to the police, after committing the crime, the accused escaped to Prayagraj by boarding the Pawan Express from LTT Kurli. "Under the guidance of DCP Ajaykumar Bansal Zone XI, six teams were formed and sent to different locations in search of the accused. We scanned every possible angle, checked the call data record of the deceased's mobile, and drum data record of the tower location of the spot and finally zeroed in on one mobile number.

The location of that number matched that of the crime scene, Malad, railway station, and LTT," said a police officer.

"We scanned hundreds of CCTV footage files and finally found a couple.

## INDIA'S WOMEN WRESTLERS ARE FACING INSTITUTIONAL BETRAYAL



On Sunday, as a new parliament building was being inaugurated in New Delhi, wrestlers protesting against sexual harassment were dragged, manhandled and detained by the chief of the Wrestling Federation of India, a BJP MP. They were met with denial, silence, and little to no action by the authorities. The wrestlers have been sitting in protest at Jantar Mantar, at the height of the Delhi summer, demanding redressal of their grievances, accountability and the arrest of the WFI chief. The WFI has denied the allegations, dismissing them as politically motivated. It was only after the wrestlers moved the Supreme Court that an FIR, the first step in a criminal investigation, was filed. The wrestlers have also pointed out the hypocrisy of a government that campaigns to "save daughters" but remains silent and unresponsive to Olympic athletes protesting against sexual harassment.

The state's response to the wrestlers' allegations reflects the "architecture of intimidation" women in India commonly face when they report sexual assault at the workplace, which includes denial, silencing, harassment and even defamation cases.

## MUMBAI CRIME: TWO HELD FOR DUPING MASTERMIND, WHO WAS IN CHARGE OF MARKETING HER GOODS, PRESENTED AUTO DRIVERS, VENDORS TO HER AS COACHES



The Charkop police have arrested two for duping the owner of a sports uniform and equipment firm in Charkop West of Rs 2.45 crore by presenting auto-rickshaw drivers, vendors and real estate agents to her as acclaimed coaches or famous sports personalities.

The arrested accused have been identified as Rohan Wadkar, 45, and Sanjay Patil, 47. The cops are on the lookout for four accused, including Wadkar's wife.

According to police sources, Wadkar is the mastermind and she had come up with a fake marketing strategy and approached the r43-year-old complainant in 2018. The latter has a workshop in Borivli and an office located under the Charkop police's jurisdiction.

Wadkar told the complainant he was acquainted with many coaches and sports personalities and he would market her products and sell the gear and equipment. "The complainant knew Wadkar as he was a marketing agent at the Omtex Sports Equipment manufacturing company where she used to work," said an officer.

From the time he was hired till 2021, Wadkar secured 'orders' worth Rs 2.45 crore and he arranged for meetings with several people whom he introduced to the complainant as eminent sports personalities. "These people were auto drivers and real estate agents who had impersonated coaches," the officer said.

The FIR in this case was registered in February. "Under the guidance of Ajay Kumar Bansal, DCP (Zone XII), WAPI Anita Tonde began the probe and with the help of PSI Ramesh Waghchure, caught Wadkar on May 13 while Patil was arrested on Monday," said Senior Inspector Manohar Shinde of Charkop police station.

## EXCISE POLICY SCAM: DELHI HIGH COURT DENIES BAIL TO AAP LEADER MANISH SISODIA

The Delhi High Court has dismissed the bail plea of Manish Sisodia, the former Deputy Chief Minister of Delhi, in a CBI case related to alleged corruption in the implementation of the previous liquor policy in the national capital.

The bench of Justice Dinesh Kumar Sharma denied bail to Sisodia and said that the applicant (Sisodia) being a powerful person, there is the possibility of him influencing the witnesses.

During arguments, the CBI had opposed the bail plea moved by Manish Sisodia and stated, "The applicant (Sisodia) enjoys close nexus with the executive, offices and bureaucrats and his influence and clout is evident. His party colleagues holding high ranks continue to make factually wrong claims in order to influence the investigation and also claiming the applicant to be a victim of a political vendetta."

Earlier the Delhi HC had issued notice to CBI on a bail plea moved by Manish Sisodia challenging a trial court order denying bail to him in a CBI case related to Excise.

## "MANIPUR SITUATION WILL TAKE TIME TO SETTLE DOWN": CHIEF OF DEFENCE STAFF



New Delhi: The violence in Manipur is a result of a clash between two ethnicities and has nothing to do with counter-insurgency, Chief of Defence Staff General Anil Chauhan said on Tuesday.

The northeastern state has been witnessing ethnic clashes for over a month, sparked by the eviction of Kuki villagers from reserve forest land. The conflict has led to a series of smaller agitations, as tensions over land and political representation have boiled over. "The situation in Manipur has nothing to do with counter-insurgency and is primarily a clash between two ethnicities. It's a law and order kind of situation and we are helping the state government," General Chauhan said.

"We've done an excellent job and saved a large number of lives. The challenges in Manipur have not disappeared and it will take some time but hopefully, they should settle down," he added. Yesterday, Union Home Minister Amit Shah met the Governor of Manipur Anusuiya Uikey and Chief Minister N Biren Singh's council of ministers after he touched down in the state for a four-day visit. Mr Shah met with top army officials, civil society organizations, and influential community leaders to finalise a strategy to curb ethnic violence in the state.
