

## BREAKING NEWS WOMAN SCAMMED FOR MONEY ON TINDER FINDS JUSTICE THROUGH DEBO RESCUE FOUNDATION

In a shocking incident of online romance turned deceitful, Khushi Patil (Name Changed), a young woman from Mumbai, fell victim to a scam after meeting a man named Asif Qureshi on the popular dating app Tinder. The footage of an attack on a team of DN Nagar police by the notorious Iranian gang members in Ambivali recently, proves again that criminals have no fear of the law. Many cops are injured and police vehicles damaged in such arrests. As per Mumbai police records, most of these fake cops, chain snatchers, and mobile snatchers are from Ambivali village, as was Firoz Fayyaz Khan, who posed as a fake cop in the complaint that DN Nagar police acted on recently.

In some cases the cops have had to return empty handed, "because women rain empty beer bottles and pett stones at us and our vehicles," said a police officer.

# MAN STABS 17-YEAR-OLD BROTHER-IN-LAW TO DEATH, CUTS HIS BODY INTO PIECES; ARRESTED

Police said that a case of murder and destruction of evidence was registered at RCF police station on Wednesday on the complaint of Lalit Putran, whose family had adopted the deceased.

A 33-year-old man was arrested in Mumbai for allegedly stabbing his 17-year-old brother-in-law to death and later cutting his body into five pieces and storing them in the kitchen. He later confessed to family members, police said.

According to police, the accused, identified as Shafi Sheikh, said that he killed his brother-in-law Ishwar Putran with a sickle in a fit of rage on Monday, after he misbehaved with his wife and 16-year-old sister-in-law.

Police said that a case of murder and destruction of evidence was registered at RCF police station on Wednesday on the complaint of Lalit Putran, whose family had adopted the deceased.

According to a police officer, Lalit, who runs a horse shed in Chembur, and his wife Reshma have five daughters. Around 12 years ago, when they found one minor boy loitering in their area. When the couple got to know that his



mother had died and father was married to another woman, they decided to adopt him. His name was Ishwar Marwadi but after adoption, he was given the name of Ishwar Lalit Putran.

"Since then Ishwar has been staying with us in our house at MHADA Colony... Four years ago, one of my daughters Amayra got married to Shaikh and there were constant quarrels between Shaikh and my adopted son Ishwar," said Reshma. Shaikh is a rickshaw driver by profession and has a child with Amayra. In his confession to police, Shaikh has alleged that around a year ago,

# GHAZIABAD LAWYER SHOT DEAD IN OFFICE, DESPITE HEAVY POLICE PRESENCE

The fact Monu Chaudhary's killers - two armed men - broke through a security cordon, murdered him and then escaped has led to questions being asked of the police.

New Delhi: A lawyer was shot dead at his office in Uttar Pradesh's Ghaziabad on Wednesday. The lawyer - Monu Chaudhary - was in his chambers, which is inside the district court complex, and eating when two men burst in and opened fire. Mr Chaudhary's blood-covered body was found slumped in the chair.

A case was filed with the Sihani Gate Police Station and the investigation is ongoing, as part of which a forensic team gathered evidence and the body has been sent for post-mortem.

In addition, security footage from CCTV cameras installed across the court premises are being secured, Nipun Agarwal, Deputy Commissioner of Police (City), told NDTV.

Preliminary information indicates Mr Chaudhary was shot dead at 2 pm. The attackers reportedly arrived on foot and fled after committing the crime.



The killing comes as legal practitioners across western UP went on a 24-hour strike today to protest the clash between lawyers and police in the state's Hapur region. In anticipation of further clashes police had been deployed at all court and tehsil complexes in the state.

However, the fact that armed men broke through this security cordon, murdered Mr Chaudhary and then escaped has led to questions being asked of the police.

After news of the gruesome murder, scores of lawyers gathered around the crime scene and soon protests broke out as Mr Chaudhary's colleagues demanded justice. At the time of the attack other lawyers were meeting to chalk out a

Bandra Police has arrested a hotel waiter for molesting a minor girl who had gone to dinner with her family.

According to the information given by the police, the 13-year-old girl had gone for dinner at Kobe Sizzlers Hotel in Bandra (West) on Monday.

Shahbad Khan (19), working as a waiter in the hotel, winked at the girl and wrote his mobile number on a paper and threw it towards the girl.

A police officer said that after throwing the paper, Khan went close to the girl, moved his hand on her thigh and passed away.

The victim girl told her family members about Khan's actions, after which the complaint was given to Bandra police station. Bandra Police arrested Shahbad Rafad Khan, who was working as a waiter at Hotel Kobe Sizzlers located on Hill Road.

A police officer said that on the complaint of the victim, the police have registered an FIR against Shahbad Khan under sections 354(Offence of outraging a woman's modesty), 509 (Word, gesture or act intended to insult the modesty of a woman) of IPC and POCSO(The Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012) and further investigation is being conducted.

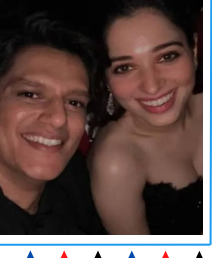

# "SEPTEMBER RAIN MAY MAKE UP FOR SHORTFALL OF 'DRIEST' AUGUST": OFFICIAL

Dr M Ravichandran, Secretary, Ministry of Earth Sciences, said the monsoon is expected to recover significantly after September 4.

India is likely to see the driest August since 1901, when the country began keeping weather records, but the monsoon is expected to recover significantly after September 4, a senior official has said.

Speaking to NDTV, Dr M Ravichandran, Secretary, Ministry of Earth Sciences, said rainfall in August has been far below normal and the intensifying El Nino conditions played a big role in that. El Nino is a weather phenomenon that occurs when ocean temperatures in the central and eastern Pacific Ocean rise above normal. This causes changes in atmospheric patterns, leading to a weakening of the monsoon circulation over the subcontinent. The monsoon tends to be weaker and less reliable during El Nino years.

Mr Ravichandran also attributed the below-normal rainfall this month to the Madden-Julian Oscillation (MJO) which is known to reduce convection in the Bay of Bengal and the Arabian Sea.

"In May itself, we had forecast normal rainfall in June and July.

# "LIKE TASTING COOKED VEGGIE": SCIENTIST ON CHANDRAYAAN CONFIRMING SULPHUR, OXYGEN ON MOON

Chandrayaan 3 confirms oxygen: Remote sensing is done from about 100km away but Chandrayaan 3s findings are straight from the ground, a scientist said.

Chandrayaan 3 on Tuesday confirmed the presence of sulphur and oxygen on the moon apart from many other elements like aluminium, calcium etc. Explaining the significance of the finding, scientist TV Venkateswaran told news agency ANI that it is like tasting cooked vegetable to confirm whether they are fully cooked. "We can see and tell if the vegetables are cooked from a distance. But we won't accept that. We will take a piece and taste it to see if it is properly cooked. In the same way, you need to land on the moon at least in a few places, look for this data and see whether this data matches the remote sensing data. If they match then our confidence in the remote sensing data will be very high," Venkateswaran said.

Chandrayaan 3 has confirmed the presence of sulphur, oxygen among several other elements on the moon.

Explaining the significance of the finding of the Chandrayaan 3 vis-a-vis remote sensing data which previous missions procured, Venkateswaran said, "This provides the ground routine.
